1. RBI to issue new ₹100 banknote

The Reserve Bank of India will issue ₹ 100 denomination banknotes in the

2. RBI cancels licence of Alwar Urban Co-operative Bank

The RBI cancelled the licence of Alwar Urban Co-operative Bank in Alwar, Rajasthan as it is not in a position to pay its depositors in full as and when their claims accrue, among other reasons.

3. Cabinet approves extension of Scheme of Recapitalization of Regional Rural Banks up to 2019-20

The Union Cabinet has approved the extension of the scheme of recapitalization of Regional Rural Banks (RRBs) for the next three years i.e. up to 2019-20. This will enable the RRBs to maintain the minimum prescribed Capital to Risk Weighted Assets Ratio (CRAR) of 9 percent.

4. Reserve Bank makes it compulsory to incorporate purchaser's name on the face of payment instrumentalities to prevent money laundering

The Reserve Bank has made it compulsory to incorporate the purchaser's name on the face of demand draft, pay order, banker's cheques and other instruments, in order to address the concerns arising out of the anonymity and to prevent money laundering.

5. Banks, financial institutions sign an agreement to speed up resolution of bad loans

Banks and Financial Institutions, including SBI and LIC, have signed the intercreditor agreement (ICA) framework to speed up the resolution of stressed assets which are under the 500-crore rupee bracket. The framework is part of the **Project Sashakt**, the report on bad bank drafted and submitted by the committee headed by **Sunil Mehta**, Non-executive Chairman of PNB.

6. RBI grants licence to Bank of China to set up branch in India

The RBI has issued licence to Bank of China to set up its first branch in India. Bank of China is one of the very few state-owned commercial banks in China.

7. Finmin approves Rs 11,336 crore capital infusion in 5 PSU Banks

The government has approved capital infusion of Rs 11,336 crore in five public sector banks, to help them meet regulatory capital requirements.

8. India becomes EBRD's newest shareholder

India became the 69th shareholder of the European Bank for Reconstruction and Development (EBRD), paving the way for more joint investment with Indian companies across the bank's regions of operation.

9. SBI organised outreach programme for farmers

The Country's largest lender State Bank of India organised a nation-wide Kisan Mela as an outreach programme for farmers and to impart financial literacy. As part of Kisan Mela, bank also offers farmers with Kisan Credit Card (KCC) an enhancement of 10 per cent to their credit limit on renewing the account.

10. YES Bank receives SEBI approval to launch Mutual Fund Business

Private lender YES Bank has received final regulatory approval from the Securities & Exchange Board of India (SEBI) to start mutual fund business.

11. MoU on Defence Salary Package signed between Indian Army and State Bank of India

A Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) was signed between the Indian Army and State Bank of India on the Defence Salary Package.

12. Federal Bank gets RBI nod to enter Bahrain, Kuwait, Singapore

South-based private sector lender Federal Bank has received the regulatory nod to open offices in Bahrain, Kuwait and Singapore.

13. NABARD launches first ever centre for climate change in Lucknow

National Bank for Agriculture and Rural Development has launched the centre for climate change, the first its kind in South East Asia, in Lucknow for accelerating concerted climate action by various stakeholders in government, private, financial and non-government sectors.



14. All-Women J&K Bank branch inaugurated

The first 'All-Women Branch of Jammu and Kashmir Bank' was e—inaugurated by First Lady Usha Vohra. The special schemes also launched, which included Pink Gold Saving Scheme, Pink Platinum Saving Scheme, Special Loan Facility for Women Entrepreneurs, Pink Gold Debit Card and Pink Platinum Credit Card.

15. SEBI proposes using UPI to reduce public issue timeline

Capital market regulator Securities and Exchange Board of India proposed Unified Payments Interface (UPI)-based payments for retail investors investing in initial public offerings (IPO). The move will help cut down the time taken between closing of an IPO and listing of the security from current six days to just three days.

16. Panel to review third party motor cover costs

Insurance regulator IRDAI has constituted a 16-member committee to examine motor third party insurance pricing aspects and make recommendations on the premium rates for 2019. The committee is headed by P J Joseph, IRDAI member – Non-Life.

<u>News – Others</u>

1. SBI and NABARD tie-up for credit in Telangana

State Bank of India and National Bank for Agriculture and Rural Development have joined hands to provide collateral-free credit through Joint Liability Groups in Telangana. The two signed an MoU, along with seven NGOs from Nizamabad, Medak and Warangal districts, for the promotion and credit linkage of 2,000 JLGs during the current year.



2. ICICI Bank aims to grow home loan book to Rs 2 trillion by FY20

ICICI Bank is the largest private player in the mortgage loan portfolio segment. It crossed the Rs 1.5-trillion milestone in this segment. The lender is targeting to grow it to Rs 2 trillion by FY20.

3. HDFC Bank most valuable bank in the emerging market outside China

HDFC Bank has become the most valuable bank in the emerging market outside China. There are four lenders from India that now rank among the world's 500 most valuable companies. HDFC Bank is followed by Housing Development Finance, Corporation (HDFC), Kotak Mahindra Bank and State Bank of India.

4. IFC invests \$100 million in Mahindra Finance

World Bank Group Member International Finance Corporation (IFC) has invested \$100 million in Mahindra & Mahindra Financial Services Ltd. (Mahindra Finance) to augment its growth by extending loans to individuals along with financing small and medium enterprises.

5. Airtel Payments Bank gets RBI nod to resume enrolling customers

Airtel Payments Bank Ltd has received requisite approvals from the Reserve Bank of India (RBI) and the Unique Identification Authority of India (UIDAI) to start onboarding customers using Aadhaar based e-KYC norms.

6. Jana Small Finance Bank launches commercial operations

The Bengaluru based Jana Small Finance Bank announced the commercial launch of its banking operations, the last microfinance company to convert itself into a small finance bank (SFB), three years after the Reserve Bank of India (RBI) gave its in-principle approval.

7. HDFC securities enable MF transactions through Facebook messenger

HDFC securities announced the launch of Mutual Funds transactional capabilities on Facebook Messenger through their virtual assistant, Arya.

8. YES BANK to address India's Urban Development Challenges

YES BANK launched the 7th edition of Transformation Series to address India's Urban Development Challenges through 'Collaboration as a service' (CAAS) to bring together global brands, students from premier educational institutes and the Government to work on identifying solutions for pressing issues faced by Smart Cities, thereby helping accelerate their development.

9. Tougher entry into India for investors from 25 nations in 'high risk' list

The global custodians have recognised 25 countries including Mauritius, Cyprus and United Arab Emirates (UAE) as 'high-risk jurisdictions'. Currently, the KYC requirements of FPIs are based on the category they fall under. Category I and II FPIs, who are considered low-risk investors, need to provide minimum documentation while Category III FPIs who are unregulated entities are subject to additional disclosures.

10. Allahabad Bank to close lone foreign branch in Hong Kong

State-owned Allahabad Bank has announced that it proposes to close its only foreign branch in Hong Kong as part of rationalization of its overseas operations. The step is in the compliance with the government's directives under PSBs' reform agenda.

1. India fastest growing economy in Asia - ADB

Asian Development Bank projected India's growth rate by 7.3 per cent and further accelerating to 7.6 per cent in 2019, as measures taken to strengthen the banking system and tax reform boost investment.

2. India's GDP to grow around 7.5% - FICCI

Despite short-term challenges, India's economic growth story remains intact and the country's GDP is expected to grow around 7.5 per cent in the current financial year, industry body FICCI.

IMF trims India's economic growth forecast to 7.3% in 2018, 7.5% in 2019

The IMF has forecast India will grow by 7.3 per cent in 2018-19 against the earlier estimate of 7.4 per cent. The economy was projected to grow 7.8 per cent by 2019-20 by the Fund earlier, but now the projection stood at 7.5 per cent, according to the World Economic Outlook (WEO) Update.

4. India to grow over 7% - OECD

India's economic growth is poised to rise to 7.4% in 2018 and 7.5% in 2019 as the economy has been able to navigate through growth obstacles due to demonetisation and impact of GST rollout.

India becomes world's sixth biggest economy, pushes France to 7th place in World Bank ranking

India has become the world's sixth-biggest economy, pushing France into seventh place, according to updated World Bank figures for 2017.

1. HCL Technologies seeks govt nod to set up SEZ in Andhra Pradesh

HCL Technologies has set up a new IT special economic zone (SEZ) in Vijayawada, Andhra Pradesh, with a proposed investment of Rs 408.48 crore.

2. Reliance Industries becomes India's largest tax payer in private sector

Reliance Industries is the India's largest payer of Goods and Services Tax (GST), Excise and Customs Duty, and Income Tax in the private sector.

1. Happiness curriculum in Delhi govt schools

The Delhi government launched a "happiness curriculum" in state-run schools. The curriculum will be taught to around eight lakh students from nursery up to Class 8 of all Delhi government schools from the new academic session.

Animals are 'legal persons', all citizens their parents, orders Uttarakhand HC

Uttarakhand High Court accorded the status of a "legal person or entity" to animals in the state, they have a distinct persona with corresponding rights, duties and liabilities of a living person.



3. Haryana launches plantation drive in Gurugram

Haryana launched the 'Paudhagiri' campaign, aimed at increasing the green cover in the state. Under this campaign, 22 lakh students from class 6 to 12 of all government and private schools in Haryana will plant a sapling each during three months of monsoon -- July, August and September.

4. Bihar to get world's cheapest clean drinking water

Bihar launched the cost-effective innovative water project to provide the cheapest drinking water in the world. With the help of this project, the people will easily be able to get pure and clean water only in 50paisa/litre. The project `Sulabh Jal`was launched in Darbhanga. It will convert contaminated pond water into safe drinking water.

5. "I Am Not Afraid of English" Campaign Launched in Haryana Schools

The Haryana Education Department has launched "I am not afraid of English" initiative to promote English language right from Class 1 in the state's primary schools. The initiative is aimed at capacity building of teachers to enable them to help the students to learn, read, write and speak English.

6. Mumbai's Elphinstone Road Station To Be Renamed As Prabhadevi

The name of Mumbai's suburban Elphinstone station was renamed as Prabhadevi. The Station code for Prabhadevi would be PBHD.



7. Asian Development Bank approves 503-million US Dollar project of lining of Son canal in Bihar

Asian Development Bank (ADB) has approved 503-million US Dollar lining project of the Son canal in Shahabad-Bhojpur region of Bihar which would benefit the agriculture sector immensely in the region.

8. Andhra Pradesh government launches 'Anna Canteens'

The Andhra Pradesh government launched 'Anna Canteens' in various parts of the state. The setting up Anna canteens, where breakfast, lunch and dinner would be offered at ₹5 each.

9. Gujarat CM launches special drive against malnutrition

Gujarat launched 'Poshan Abhiyan', a state-wide mission to eradicate malnutrition among children by providing them nutritious food through Anganwadi centres. Gujarat also launched '**Purna' project** to eliminate malnutrition among girls in the age group of 14 to 18. Purna' stands for Prevention of Under Nutrition and Reduction of Nutritional Anaemia among Adolescent Girls.

10. Chhattisgarh CM Raman Singh launches online pension system

Chhattisgarh Chief Minister Dr. Raman Singh launched an online portal and mobile app called 'Aabhaar-Aapki seva ka' by the online pension management system for the pensioners of the state.

11. MP govt to appoint girls as district Brand Ambassador

Madhya Pradesh government will appoint girls as a district Brand Ambassador who have recorded significant achievements in any field under the Beti Bachao-Beti Padhao scheme.

12. UNESCO to set up a 'Design University for Gaming' in Visakhapatnam

United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organisation (UNESCO) will be setting up a 'Design University for Gaming' in Visakhapatnam. UNESCO delegation entered into an agreement with Andhra Pradesh Economic Development Board (APEDB) for the establishment of 'Gaming Digital Learning Hub'.

13. Seema darshan: Gujarat government to invest additional money to develop infrastructure

The Gujarat government is planned to invest additional Rs 39 crore to develop infrastructure for state's "Seema Darshan" or border tourism project at Nadabet near Suigam in Banaskantha district.

14. Patnaik releases first-ever tribal atlas of Odisha

The first-ever tribal atlas of Odisha has released. It has a set of maps and statistics highlighting the tribal demography of the state.

15. West Bengal to launch Ayushman Bharat under joint banner

The West Bengal government signed an agreement to implement the Centre's health insurance scheme under the joint banner "**Ayushman Bharat** - **Swasthya Sathi**". Under the agreement, the state government is expected to expand the number of beneficiaries under its existing health scheme to provide more than 11 million families with health cover of Rs 5 lakh each.

16. Odisha launches 'Green Mahanadi Mission'

Odisha government launched the 'Green Mahanadi Mission', a plantation drive under which 2 crore saplings will be planted along the Mahanadi river and its tributaries.

17. NRL becomes 1st oil PSU to introduce online legal compliance

Numaligarh Refinery Ltd (NRL) in Assam has become the first oil public sector undertaking (PSU) to adopt an online legal compliance system by introducing 'Legatrix'.

1. Union Cabinet gives approval to rename Agartala airport

Union Cabinet approved to rename the Agartala Airport in Tripura as **Maharaja Bir Bikram Manikya Kishore Airport**, Agartala. The decision comes for paying tribute to Maharaja Bir Bikram Manikya Kishore.

2. Doorstep ration introduced in New Delhi

Delhi Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal approved the doorstep ration delivery system and directed the Food Department to implement it immediately.

3. Gujarat Government grants religious minority status to Jews

The Gujarat Government granted Religious Minority Status to Jews living in the state. Gujarat became the third state in India to grant religious minority status to Jews after West Bengal and Maharashtra.

4. Odisha constitutes Heritage Cabinet

The Odisha government constituted 'Heritage Cabinet,' headed by Chief Minister Naveen Patnaik, aiming at protection of ancient monuments, temples and archaeological sites in Odisha and take steps to preserve the states culture, language and literature.

5. Odisha: Record number of crocodile nesting sites found in Bhitarkanika

The Bhitarkanika national park, Odisha has become the largest habitat of the endangered estuarine crocodiles in the country with a record number of their nesting sites spotted in it.

6. Himachal govt announces MIS for apple procurement

The Himachal government has approved implementation of Market Intervention Scheme (MIS) for procurement of apple. Under the scheme, 279 procurement centres will be opened as per demand of the fruit growers.

7. Government of Karnataka and NASSCOM launch Centre of Excellence for Data Science in Bengaluru

National Association of Software and Services Companies (NASSCOM) has launched a Centre of Excellence for Data Science and Artificial Intelligence (CoE – DSAI) in collaboration with the Government of Karnataka, in Bengaluru.



8. T-Hub to host country's 1st Defence incubator

The country's first Defence incubators will come up in Hyderabad, which is India's missile development centre and fast emerging the hub for aerospace industries. The incubator will be housed at T-Hub.

<u>News – Most Important</u>

1. Jharkhand to set up country's first Khadi mall

The First Khadi mall of the country has set up in Jharkhand. The land in the Heavy Engineering Corporation (HEC) campus will be made available to the Khadi Board to develop the country's first Khadi mall.

2. Bengaluru to get India's first e-waste plant

The country's first e-waste recycling unit will come up in Bengaluru, Karnataka. The unit, to be set up by the ministry, is likely to be ready in four months, and is in keeping with the Swachh Bharat Abhiyan drive.



3. Train 18: Made-in-India 160 kmph train to run from September

The indigenously manufactured semi high-speed train, code-named Train 18 built by Integral Coach Factory (ICF) of Chennai to promote Make in India, is capable of running at a speed of 160 km per hour. It is expected to be rolled out in September.

4. PAN-Aadhaar linking deadline extended till March 2019: CBDT

The Central Board of Direct Taxes extended the deadline for the PAN-Aadhaar linking to March 21, 2019.

5. Supreme Court upholds Chief Justice of India as 'Master of Roster'

The Supreme Court has upheld 'Chief Justice of India' (CJI) as the 'Master of Roaster'. The Chief Justice of India is an individual judge and not the powerful collective of five senior- most judges of the Supreme Court called the 'Collegium'.

6. Samsung opens world's largest mobile phone factory in Noida

The World's Biggest mobile manufacturing plant of Samsung is located in Noida. It was Inaugurated by South Korean President Moon Jae-in and Prime Minister Narendra Modi. Another plant of Samsung is located in Sriperumbudur, Chennai.

7. First ever 'India Tourism Mart' to be hosted in New Delhi

The first India Tourism Mart will be organized in New Delhi from 16th of September to create a global tourism mart for India on lines of major international travel marts.



8. HRD grants 'Institutions of Eminence' status to six public and private institutes

The HRD Ministry granted "Institutions of Eminence" status to three public and three private institutes, enabling them to get full autonomy and special incentives to project them as "world class universities".

Public Sector - IIT-Delhi, IIT-Bombay and Indian Institute of Science (IISc),
Bangalore

Private Sector - Manipal Academy of Higher Education, BITS Pilani and Jio Institute by Reliance Foundation.

9. Net neutrality gets the okay from Telecom Commission

The Telecom Commission (TC), the highest-decision making body within the DoT approved the new neutrality rules. It was recommended by TRAI. Internet access in India will remain unfettered.

10. First-ever metal craft exhibition inaugurated in Leh

The first-ever metal craft exhibition was held in Chilling, Leh to promote and preserve the metal craft tradition of Ladakh.

11. India's first private UAV factory to come up in Kota

India's first private sector unit for manufacturing unmanned air vehicles (UAV) and light bullet proof vehicles (LBPV) will be set up by DCM Shriram Industries Group in Kota.

12. Railways launched its first consolidated Bridge Management System

The Railways has launched its first consolidated Bridge Management System, a web-enabled IT application to store data on its one lakh 50 thousand bridges.



13. ASI issues order to permit photography within the premises of centrally protected monuments/sites.

The Archaeological Survey of India has issued an order allowing photography within the premises of all centrally protected monuments or sites, except at Ajanta Caves, Leh Palace and Taj Mahal.

14. The most advanced System of Air Quality and Weather Forecasting (SAFAR) at ChandniChowk in Delhi

Union Minister Dr Harsh Vardhan unveiled a state-of-the-art Air Quality and Weather Forecast System– SAFAR (System of Air Quality and Weather Forecasting) in New Delhi. The giant true colour LED display gives out real-time air quality index on 24x7 basis with colour coding along with 72-hour advance forecast. SAFAR is implemented in four cities of India – Delhi, Pune, Mumbai and Ahmedabad as an operational service.

15. Union Home Minister to launch Student Police Cadet Programme

The Student Police Cadet (SPC) Programme launched in Haryana. The programme seeks to build a bridge between the Police and the larger community through school. The programme focuses on students of class 8 & 9.

16. Ministry of Women and Child Development organises POSHAN Abhiyaan

Ministry of Women and Child Development, Government of India has organized 2nd meeting of National Council on India's Nutrition Challenges under POSHAN Abhiyaan in New Delhi under the Chairmanship of Vice Chairman, NITI Aayog Dr. Rajiv Kumar. The month of September will be celebrated as National Nutrition Month every year.



17. Foundation stone of skill training institute laid in Odisha

India's first National Skill Training Institute will set up in Odisha. Foundation stone laid by Dharmendra Pradhan.

18. IIT Madras Unveils Rs. 40 Crore Microscope To View Atoms Of A Material

The Indian Institute of Technology-Madras launched a Rs 40 crore remotely operable microscope 'Local Electrode Atom Probe (LEAP)', claimed to be the world's first of its kind, that would enable precise view of atoms of a material.

19. IIT Kanpur unveils online tool to help deal with mental health issues

The Indian Institute of Technology (IIT), Kanpur, has developed an online tool, TreadWill, to help people cope with issues related to their mental health. TreadWill is a website designed to help people deal with stress, low mood, lethargy and other depressive symptoms through different online exercises, questionnaires and games.

20. Government Launched MicroDot Technology To Check Vehicle Thefts

The Indian Government has announced the launch of a new MicroDot technology to help check vehicle thefts.

21. Cabinet approves Revitalising Infrastructure and Systems in Higher Education (RISE) by 2022

The Cabinet Committee on Economic Affairs has approved the proposal for expanding the scope of Higher Education Financing Agency (HEFA) by enhancing its capital base to Rs. 10,000 crore and tasking it to mobilise Rs. 1,00,000 Crore for Revitalizing Infrastructure and Systems in Education (RISE) by 2022.



22. Govt forms panel to upgrade norms for state, district level economic data collection

The government has set up a 13-member committee to upgrade the norms for computation of economic data at states and districts level in the backdrop of plans to revise the base year for National Accounts or GDP calculation. The committee is headed **by Ravindra H Dholakia**, a retired professor of IIM Ahmedabad. The base year **to 2017-18 for** the calculation of GDP and IIP numbers from the current 2011-12 with an aim to capture changes in the economy.

23. Government sets up task force on ways to reduce import

The government has set up a high-level task force to identify various items and policy interventions to reduce dependence on import. It would suggest ways to cut import of those items which can be manufactured or explored in the country. It is headed by Cabinet Secretary **P K Sinha**.

24. MCA has constituted a 10-Member Committee to review the offences under the Companies Act, 2013

The Ministry of Corporate Affairs (MCA) has constituted a 10 Member Committee for review of the penal provisions in the Companies Act, 2013. The Committee shall submit its report within thirty days to the Central Government for consideration of its recommendations. The committee is headed **by Mr Injeti Srinivas**, The Secretary of Ministry of Corporate Affairs.



25. Committee set up to synergise NCC and NSS

The Government has decided to set up a committee to suggest measures to strengthen National Cadet Corps (NCC) and National Service Scheme (NSS). The Committee will deal with on issues like expansion, strengthening training infrastructure, rationalizing resources, reducing manpower deficiency affecting NCC and NSS. The Committee will also submit recommend for building synergies between these two institutions viz. NCC and NSS and further strengthen them for empowering the youth. It will be headed by Shri **Anil Swarup**.

26. Centre forms panel to tackle pollution near Taj Mahal days after Supreme Court's criticism

The Centre set up a committee to address the matter of industrial pollution affecting the Taj Mahal. It will be led by Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change Secretary **CK Mishra**.

27. Centre constitutes high-level committees to deal with mob violence, lynching

In order to formulate appropriate measures to prevent incidents of mob violence and lynching, Government has set up a high-level committee chaired by the Union **Home Secretary Rajiv Gauba** to deliberate in the matter and make recommendations.

28. UGC to suggest reforms in higher education institutions

The University Grants Commission (UGC) has formed a committee to suggest examination reforms in institutions of higher learning. The committee is chaired by **M Salunkhe**, former vice chancellor, Central University, Rajasthan.



29. Panel to regulate fee charged by medical colleges formed: UGC

The UGC has constituted a committee to regulate the fees chargeable by selffinanced deemed-to-be universities in medical and dental courses in view of the exorbitant fees being charged by them. The committee is chaired by **R C Deka**.

30. Minimum Support price on Paddy and Sugarcane

The Union Cabinet has approved a hike in minimum support prices (MSPs) for kharif crops so that they are 50% higher than the cost of production, not including land costs.

This includes a **₹200 per quintal** increase in the MSP for paddy, which is likely to inflate the food subsidy bill by over cost the government more than **₹15,000** crore.

The government decided to increase the minimum price sugar mills pay to cane growers by **Rs 20 per quintal to Rs 275 per quintal** for the next marketing year starting October. The decision to increase the Fair and Remunerative Price (FRP) of sugarcane for the 2018-19 marketing year.

31. Wholesale Inflation

India's wholesale inflation grew 5.77 percent in June, a four-and-half year high, driven by some food items and fuel prices.

5. NITI Aayog Reveal 'Breathe India' Plan to Reduce Air Pollution, Delhi, Agra on Focus

NITI Aayog has developed a 15-points action plan, titled 'Breathe India', for top 10 most polluted cities in India to combat rising air pollution. The cities that have been identified are Kanpur, Faridabad, Gaya, Varanasi, Patna, Delhi, Lucknow, Agra, Gurgaon and Muzaffarpur.

6. Steel CPSE Employees Pension Scheme Announced

Ministry of Steel has agreed to the proposal received from various CPSEs like SAIL, RINL, MSTC, FSNL, MECON and KIOCL to introduce the pension scheme. The pension scheme will benefit over 94,000 serving and 56,000 retired employees of CPSEs.

7. Manoj Sinha inaugurates Ghazipur Regional Rail Training Institute

The Regional Rail Training Institute (RRTI) has set up at Ghazipur, Uttar Pradesh to strengthen the expertise and capabilities of the employees of North-Eastern Railways.

Flipkart has launched a video advertisement platform, Shopper Audience Network, in partnership with Hotstar as a part of its broader strategy to generate more revenue from the booming video advertising business.



13. Behdienkhlam festival at Jowai, Meghalaya

International

1. UN Security Council adopts resolution to protect children in armed conflict

The UN Security Council has adopted a resolution 2427 aimed at a framework for mainstreaming protection, rights, well-being and empowerment of children throughout the conflict cycle.



2. China launches two remote sensing satellites for Pakistan

China launched two remote sensing satellites for Pakistan, marking the first international commercial launch for the Long March-2C rocket in about 19 years. The satellites - PRSS-1 and PakTES-1A - were launched from the Jiuquan Satellite Launch Centre in northwest China.

3. UN Secretary-General Appoints High-Level Panel on Digital Cooperation

UN Secretary-General António Guterres has established a High-level Panel on Digital Cooperation, to inform on the benefits of digital technology and investigate how to protect against unwanted impacts and negative externalities. The panel, announced is to be co- chaired by Melinda Gates, Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation, and Jack Ma, Alibaba Group, and is comprised of 20 members representing industry, civil society and academia.

4. First land-based communication link between Pakistan and China open

An optical fibre cable project that would be the first land-based communication link between China and Pakistan has been launched. It has been completed in two years and will help develop the telecom sector in Gilgit-Baltistan region.

5. NASA releases online toolkit to increase commercial use of satellite data

NASA has launched an online toolkit to make it easier for users to find, analyse and utilise the most relevant satellite data for their research, business projects or conservation efforts. The "Remote Sensing Toolkit" provides a simple system that quickly identifies relevant sources based on user input.



6. China to launch 300 satellites to provide worldwide low-orbit communications

China has planned to launch 300 low-orbit satellites to provide worldwide communication services, with the first in the series to be launched later this year. The constellation will be built in three stages.

7. UNEP partners with Google for monitoring impact of human activity on global ecosystem

The UN Environment Programme has entered into a partnership with Google to monitor the impacts of human activity on global ecosystems by using sophisticated online tools. The aim of the partnership is to develop a platform to enable governments, NGO's and the public to track specific environment-related development targets with a user-friendly Google front- end.

8. Facebook to launch internet satellite Athena

Facebook is working on a low Earth orbit (LEO) satellite named Athena that will provide internet coverage. The company aims to launch in 2019.

9. Google Is Being Fined a Record \$5 Billion by the EU and Ordered to Alter Android Model

Google was fined 4.3 billion euros (\$5 billion) by the European Union and ordered to change the way it puts search and web browser apps on Android mobile devices, setting a global record for antitrust penalties.

10. Tokyo Unveils World's First All-Digital Psychedelic Art Museum

The world's first digital art museum opened its doors to the public in Tokyo, Japan allowing patrons to step all the way into the artworks.

1. Europe, Japan sign massive free trade deal in 'clear message' against protectionism

The EU and Japan signed a sweeping free trade deal 'clear message' against protectionism in Tokyo. This is the biggest ever negotiated by the EU and creates a free trade zone covering nearly a third of the world's GDP.

2. Pakistan gets its first woman chief justice of high court

Pakistan has got its first-ever woman Chief Justice of a high court. Justice Tahira Safdar was named as the Chief Justice of the Balochistan High Court by Chief Justice Mian Saqib Nisar.

3. Tata Steel clinches JV with Thyssenkrupp, to launch new European steel giant

Tata Steel and German Steel giant Thyssenkrupp AG have signed a definitive agreement to create a 50:50 joint venture. Thyssenkrupp Tata Steel BV would be the second-largest steelmaker in European steel sector after Lakshmi Mittal's ArcelorMittal.

4. Google-owned YouTube to invest \$25mn in countering fake news

Google-owned video-sharing platform YouTube will invest \$25 million to fight fake news -- especially for the urgent coverage of breaking news.

1. Victorian Gothic and Art Deco Ensembles of Mumbai Inscribed as UNESCO World Heritage Site

The iconic cluster of Victorian Gothic and Art Deco buildings in Mumbai was inscribed in the list of UNESCO World Heritage Site. This is the third such honour for the metropolis after the Elephanta Caves and the majestic Victoria Terminus, rechristened Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj Terminus railway station.

2. India becomes the Vice Chair of the Asia Pacific Region of World Customs Organisation (WCO)

India has become the Vice-Chair (Regional Head) of the Asia Pacific Region of World Customs Organisation (WCO) for a period of two years.

3. Invest India and Business France Sign MoU to Promote Investment

Invest India and Business France have signed an MoU to promote investment facilitation and cooperation between start-ups of India and France. The goal will be to facilitate direct foreign investment by providing practical investment information to enterprises and support the companies pursuing those opportunities which contribute positively to economic growth of the two countries.



4. India, US to enhance cooperation

India and the United States resolved to enhance cooperation in areas like counter-terror, immigration and aviation security. The Homeland Security Dialogue focused on issues relating to security cooperation, customs and immigration, aviation security, capacity building.

5. China, India clinch deal to reduce tariffs on Indian medicines, anti-cancer drugs

China has clinched a deal with India on the reduction of import duties on Indian medicines including anti-cancer drugs, which are highly expensive in the country. Beijing, which earlier announced a cut on import duties on over 8,500 Indian items.

6. Myanmar joins International Solar Alliance, becomes 68th member

Myanmar has joined the India-initiated International Solar Alliance (ISA), becoming the 68th member of the grouping that is aiming at optimum utilisation of solar energy.

7. India and Sri Lanka

India would operate Sri Lanka's loss-making Mattala Rajapaksa International Airport in Hambantota. It is dubbed the "world's emptiest airport" due to a lack of flights. PM Modi also launched a countrywide emergency ambulance service for Sri Lanka.



8. India, Ghana ink 2 MoUs

India and Ghana signed two agreements in an effort to enhance the bilateral cooperation between the two countries. The two MOUs on Cultural Exchange Programme and on cooperation between Bureau of Indian Standards and Ghana Standards Authority were signed.

9. India, UK signed MoU for enhancing bilateral cooperation in legal affairs.

India and UK signed a MoU for enhancing bilateral cooperation in legal affairs which provides a framework for promoting greater co-operation between the judicial and legal professionals in both countries through exchange of expertise and training.

10. India signs revised travel agreement with Bangladesh

India signed a revised travel agreement with Bangladesh to ease visa restrictions for citizens from the neighbouring country. Also, A new integrated state-of-theart integrated Indian Visa Application Centre (IVAC) was inaugurated at Dhaka's Jamuna Future Park, by Home Minister Rajnath Singh and his Bangladeshi counterpart Asaduzzaman Khan.



11. India and South Korea

India and South Korea have set a target of increasing bilateral trade to \$50 billion by 2030 from \$20 billion and speedily conclude negotiations to upgrade the bilateral Comprehensive Economic Partnership Agreement (CEPA). India and South Korea signed five MoUs in the field of Science & Technology. They signed three MoUs for (i) Programme of Cooperation 2018-21, (ii) Establishment of Future Strategy Group, (iii) Cooperation in Biotechnology & Bio economy.

Two other MoUs were signed between Council of Scientific & Industrial Research (CSIR), and South Korean National Research Council for Science & Technology and IIT Mumbai and Korea Institute of Science & Technology, to further accelerate future-oriented cooperation in their respective sectors. The MoUs were signed at the conclusion of the 4th India-Korea Science & Technology Ministers Steering Committee Meeting.

India **ranks 11 in the** 2018 AT Kearney FDI Confidence Index due to teething troubles in the implementation of the goods and services tax and the government's demonetisation decision in 2016.

2. Global Innovation Index ranks India the 57th most innovative nation

Global Innovation Index (GII) has ranked India as **the 57th most** innovative nation in the world. The GII is being developed jointly by Cornell University, the Paris-based business school Insead and the World Intellectual Property Organisation (WIPO) in Geneva.

News - Most Important

1. India's longest-range ballistic missile, Agni-5 missile flight tested

India's longest-range ballistic missile, Agni-5 missile was flight tested from Dr APJ Abdul Kalam Island off the Odisha coast. It is developed by DRDO and can carry nuclear warhead weighing 1.5 tonnes to a distance of over 5,000 km and is the longest missile in India's arsenal capable of reaching most parts of China.

2. ISRO carried out Crew Escape System flight test

The Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO) carried out a flight test for a newly-designed Crew Escape System, meant for saving lives of astronauts in an exigency.

3. First-ever warship to enter port of Sabang in Indonesia.

Indian naval ship INS Sumitra became the first-ever warship to enter port of Sabang in Indonesia. It was received by traditional dancers and Indonesian traditional band & was welcomed by Indian Ambassador to Indonesia PK Rawat. The warship was deployed in Malacca Straits.

INS Tarangini Visited Sunderland to Participate in Tall Ship Races – 2018.

INS Tarangini visited Sunderland in the UK, during her Lokayan-18 voyage and also to participate in the prestigious 'tall ship races - 2018'. The ship is part of the first Training Squadron based at Kochi, under the Southern Naval Command of the Indian Navy. It is the first ship of the Indian Navy to have circumnavigated the globe in the year 2003-04

5. India and Pakistan to commence a multi-nation counter-terror exercise India and Pakistan will be part of a multi-nation counter-terror exercise in Russia in September, along with China and several other countries. The military exercise will take place under the framework of Shanghai Cooperation Organisation (SCO).

6. Supersonic cruise missile BrahMos test fired from the ITR

Supersonic cruise missile BrahMos was test fired from the Integrated Test Range (ITR) at Chandipur. It is a joint venture between DRDO and the NPOM of Russia. The highly versatile BrahMos has been operationalised in the Indian Army, Indian Navy and Indian Air Force.



7. ISRO roped partners to help assemble 27 satellites

The Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO) has roped in three partners to help it assemble 27 satellites at a quick pace over the next three years. ISRO's nodal satellites division URSC (U.R. Rao Satellite Centre) signed separate threeyear contracts with Alpha Design Technologies P Ltd and its six consortium members; with defence public enterprise Bharat Electronics Ltd; and with Tata Advanced Systems Ltd, Hyderabad.

8. Indian Air Force participates in 'Pitch Black 2018' for first time in Australia.

An Indian Air Force contingent comprising of four Su-30 MKI, 01 X C-130 and 01 X C-17 aircraft, participated in 'Pitch Black 2018' along with Royal Australian Air Force. The exercise involves over 100 aircraft from around the globe and will provide a unique opportunity to the air-warriors to operate in a dynamic warlike environment.

News - Others

1. BEL signed a MoU with Saab, Sweden

Defence public sector undertaking BEL has signed a memorandum of understanding (MoU) with Saab, Sweden for jointly marketing the L-Band 3D Air Surveillance Radar, RAWL-03, co-developed by BEL and Saab. It is a costeffective L Band three-dimensional radar and helps for early detection and tracking of air and surface targets.



2. INS Trikand reached Sri Lanka in a goodwill visit

India's latest frontline warship INS Trikand has reached Sri Lanka in a goodwill visit. INS Trikand is a state-of-the-art warship of the Indian Navy equipped with a versatile range of weapons and sensors capable of addressing threats in all three dimensions – air, surface and sub-surface.

3. SES-12 launched to help support India's growing DTH Market

The SES-12 was launched to help support India's growing direct-to-home (DTH) TV market, as more and more consumers in rural India embrace the medium. The satellite will be able to help accelerate the country's push towards a Digital India.

4. ISRO conducted a ground test of Vikas Engine

ISRO conducted a ground test of its high thrust version of the Vikas Engine in Mahendragiri in Tirunelveli district of Tamil Nadu. It would improve the payload capability of the space agency's launch vehicles.

Agreements

News - Most Important

1. National Stock Exchange of India (NSE) signed an agreement with Nasdaq

The National Stock Exchange of India (NSE) have signed an agreement with Nasdaq to deliver a customized real-time clearing, risk management and settlement technology to one of the world's largest stock exchanges. Nasdaq has also signed an agreement with NSEIT to utilize NSEIT's capability in implementations and project augmentation globally.



2. NSG signed an agreement with IRCTC

National Security Guard (NSG) has signed an agreement with Indian Railway Catering and Tourism Corporation (IRCTC) to eliminate the need for carrying railway warrants by the NSG Personnel. The NSG is the first central paramilitary force to opt for e – ticketing instead of railway warrant.

3. NASSCOM signs MOU with NITI Aayog

NASSCOM signed a Memorandum of Understanding with NITI Aayog to collaboratively foster applied research, accelerating adoption and ethics, privacy and security.

4. Infosys signs an MoU with BMRC

Infosys Foundation signed a Memorandum of Understanding to contribute Rs 200 crore to the Bengaluru Metro Rail Corporation Ltd for construction of Konappana Agrahara Metro Station and metro railway track.

5. Vice president signs MoU with Rwanda senate

M. Venkaiah Naidu became the first Chairman of Rajya Sabha to sign an MOU with Senate of Rwanda representing Rajya Sabha. They agreed to promote dialogue, capacity building and cooperation.

6. Facebook & NSDC partners

Facebook and the National Skill Development Corporation (NSDC) have entered into strategic partnership to train youth and entrepreneurs in the country on digital skills.

7. Rajasthan signs MoU with Microsoft

Rajasthan has emerged as the first State to sign a memorandum of understanding with Microsoft to provide digital training to 9,500 students of government colleges. It will also train 500 faculty members.



8. CSIR- NPL has signed a MoU with HPCL.

CSIR- National Physical laboratory (NPL) has signed a MoU with Hindustan Petroleum Corporation Limited (HPCL) for indigenous development of petroleum certified reference materials (CRMs) under trade name of Bhartiya Niredeshak Dravyas (BNDTM).

9. A Statement of Intent (SoI) signed between NITI Aayog and Lupin Foundation

A Statement of Intent (SoI) was signed between NITI Aayog and Lupin Foundation to collaborate in Aspirational Districts Programme. It will facilitate indicators like education, health & nutrition, financial inclusion and skill development along with agriculture and water resources.

10. Oxigen and Fincare Small Finance Bank

Oxigen and Fincare Small Finance Bank signed an agreement to roll out the Branchless Banking services, using Oxigen's flagship Point of Sale device called the Oxigen Micro ATM Super PoS.

11. Ola, Haryana government sign MoU to create 35,000 jobs

Cab-hailing firm Ola has signed a memorandum of understanding (MoU) with the Haryana government's department of employment to create 35,000 entrepreneurial opportunities in the state. The MoU is part of the state's Saksham Haryana initiative which was rolled out early last year to empower the youth through various skill development initiatives.

1. Bombay Stock Exchange (BSE) entered into an agreement with BME.

Bombay Stock Exchange (BSE) has entered into an agreement with Bombay Metal Exchange (BME) for the development of commodity derivatives markets in the non-ferrous metals complex. They will work jointly on initiatives to deepen the understanding of commodity market among stakeholders.

2. MORTH signs a MoU with UK-based Transport for London (TFL)

The ministry of road transport & highways has signed a memorandum of understanding with UK-based Transport for London (TFL), to improve public transport in India. It will help mainly in sharing information and areas of cooperation like improving the public transport system with an augmentation of passenger capacity, services, data analysis, induction of electric vehicles, new technologies, ticketing and the provision of passenger information, urban transport planning and policy.

3. IIT Delhi and the All India Institute of Ayurveda (AIIA) signed an agreement

IIT Delhi and the All India Institute of Ayurveda (AIIA) have signed an agreement to give "scientific validation" to the ancient medical science and integrate it with technology. The projects would be funded by the Ayush Ministry.

4. Five PSUs signed a joint venture

Five central oil PSUs (IOCL, ONGC, GAIL OIL and NRL) signed a joint venture agreement for executing the North-East Natural Gas Pipeline Grid as a step towards the Urja Ganga Gas Pipeline Project.

News - Most Important

1. A new method of microscopy to help view proteins under human cells.

A team of scientists at the University of Warwick have produced a new method of microscopy to help view proteins under human cells. The tagging device is called 2FerriTag, the device uses electron microscopy to allow proteins to be viewed at a precise scale.

2. Ways to turn asteroids into giant, autonomous spacecrafts assisted by NASA

NASA is set to provide financial assistance to a California-based 3D printing company for finding ways to turn asteroids into giant, autonomous spacecrafts, which could fly to outposts in space. The name of the Project is RAMA (Reconstituting Asteroids into Mechanical Automata).



3. Silk-based hydrogel that emulates the process of hair growth

Scientists from IIT Delhi have developed a silk-based hydrogel that emulates the process of hair growth, an advance that may help screen novel drugs for treating hair loss without using animal tests.

1. The first ever 3D colour X-ray on humans

2. Injection Voveran Banned

1. 4 species added to recovery programme by Wildlife Board

The National Board for Wildlife (NBWL) has given its nod to include four diverse species named Northern River Terrapin (riverine turtle), Red Panda, Clouded Leopard and Arabian Sea Humpback Whale in the recovery programme for critically endangered species. The species recovery programme of the Union Environment Ministry is implemented under Integrated Development of Wildlife Habitats.

2. Oldest colours in the geological record discovered

Scientists from ANU and overseas have discovered the oldest colours in the geological record, 1.1 billion-year-old bright pink pigments extracted from rocks deep beneath the Sahara Desert in Africa.

1. Rising sea levels could cost the world \$14 trillion a year by 2100

A study led by the UK National Oceanographic Centre (NOC) found flooding from rising sea levels could cost \$14 trillion worldwide annually by 2100, if the target of holding global temperatures below 2 degrees Celsius above pre-industrial levels is missed.

2. Seven new wasp species discovered in the Amazon forests

Researchers have discovered seven new wasp species belonging to the genus Clistopyga from Peru, Venezuela and Colombia. The new wasp species are: Clistopyga crassicaudata, C.kalima, C.panchei, C.taironae, C.nigriventri, C.splendida. C.isayae.
