Banking & Finance

1. SBI, Axis Bank, ICICI Bank, others buy stakes in fintech firm IBBIC

SBI, Axis Bank, Indian Bank, Yes Bank and IDBI Bank picked up 5.55% stake each, representing 50,000 shares in IBBIC, for cash at Rs 5 lakh each.

Apart from these lenders, ICICI Bank bought 49,000 shares (5.44 per cent) for Rs 4.9 lakh. Incorporated in May this year, IBBIC platform offers distributed ledger technology (DLT) solutions to the Indian financial services sector.

2. SBI tops list of PSBs writing off bad loans in FY21, Union Bank of India holds second spot

State Bank of India topped the list of public sector banks writing off loans in FY21 followed by Union Bank of India. While SBI removed Rs 34,402 crore from its balance sheet, the Union Bank of India wrote off Rs 16,983 crore during the last fiscal. Prudential or technical write-off does not result in waiver of liabilities of borrowers to repay.

3. DBS clinches global accolade for innovation in digital banking

RBI said the statutory inspection of the company revealed non-compliance with the statutory directions on submission of credit information to CRILC and submission of credit data to credit information companies

11. RBI Maintains Key Lending Rate At 4%, Retains GDP Growth Target At 9.5%

Reserve Bank maintained the key interest rates unchanged for the seventh straight time and retained the GDP growth target at 9.5 per cent. The repo rate would be unchanged at 4 per cent and the reverse repo rate would remain at 3.35 per cent. RBI Governor Shaktikanta Das said the policy stance continues to be "accommodative"

12. SIDBI launches Swavalamban Challenge Fund to promote entrepreneurship

Small Industries Development Bank of India (SIDBI) in partnership with Foreign, Commonwealth & Development Office, UK (FCDO UK) has launched 'Swavalamban Challenge Fund' (SCF) to lend a helping hand to the entrepreneurs.

A challenge fund is a fund support mechanism to allocate funds for specific purposes using competition among organizations. Under this fund, applications are invited in two categories: Pilot and Scale-up category

17. NSE to allow trading in US-listed stocks in NSE-IFSC platform

NSE International Exchange (NSE IFSC), a subsidiary of the National Stock Exchange of India Ltd (NSE), has announced trading in select US stocks will be facilitated through its platform. The proposed framework will make US stocks affordable to Indian retail investors. The offering will be in the form of unsponsored depositary receipts. NSE IFSC Limited launched trading on June 5th, 2017.

18. Deutsche Bank gets nod to set up IFSC banking unit at GIFT City

Deutsche Bank will set up its IFSC banking unit at India's first global financial centre in Gujarat. The bank has received approval from the GIFT SEZ Authority to set up an IFSC banking unit at India's first International Financial Services Centre (IFSC) at GIFT City, Gujarat. The International Financial Services Centre in GIFT City was set up in 2015.



19. Indian Bank signs Memorandum of Understanding with Paralympic Committee

Public sector Indian Bank has signed a MoU with Paralympic Committee of India (PCI) as one of the banking partners of the Paralympic Games scheduled to commence from August 24 in Tokyo, Japan. The bank, through its year-long association with PCI, will provide financial assistance to paralympic athletes. The President of Paralympic Committee of India is Deepa Malik.

20. Central Bank of India enters into strategic co-lending partnership with Dhanvarsha Finvest

Central Bank of India has entered into a strategic co-lending partnership with Dhanvarsha Finvest Ltd (DFL) to offer loans against gold ornaments under priority sector to Micro, Small and Medium Enterprise (MSME) borrowers at competitive rates.

Under this partnership, DFL will originate and process loans against gold ornaments as per jointly formulated credit parameter

21. SIDBI unveils Digital Prayaas lending platform

Small Industries Development Bank of India(SIDBI) has launched 'Digital Prayaas', an App based end to end digital lending platform, whereby loan sanction will be accorded to aspiring entrepreneurs from the bottom of the pyramid.

Further, to cater to the aspiring youth in urban areas, SIDBI tied up with a major aggregator, BigBasket, to on board its delivery partners in India

22. ADB to finance water supply project in Jharkhand with Rs 831 cr loan

Multilateral funding agency Asian Development Bank (ADB) has approved an over Rs 831 crore (USD 112 million) loan to finance water supply infrastructure in Jharkhand. The project will cover four towns in the state.

The project supports the Jharkhand Vision and Action Plan 2021 to improve the quality of life of its urban residents through better quality urban infrastructure Cost of the project is USD 160 million, of which USD 48 million will be given by the state

23. National Fisheries Development Board signs pact with Punjab National Bank to pump liquidity into fisheries sector

National Fisheries Development Board (NFDB) under the Ministry of Fisheries, Animal Husbandry & Dairying, Government of India has entered into a MoU with Punjab National Bank to extend financial assistance to the fisheries sector.

The Government created the Fisheries and Aquaculture Infrastructure Development Fund (FIDF) in 2018-19 with a total fund of Rs 7522.48 crore NFDB Chief Executive: Dr.Suvarna Chandrappagari PNB MD and CEO: CH S S Mallikarjuna Rao

24. RBI cancels license of Raigad based Karnala Nagari Sahakari Bank

Reserve Bank of India (RBI) has cancelled the licence of Karnala Nagari Sahakari Bank of Maharashtra. Consequently, the bank ceases to carry on banking business, with effect from the close of business. The RBI said the bank does not have adequate capital and earning prospects and failed to comply with the requirements of various sections of the Banking Regulation Act, 1949.

25. RBI imposes '1 crore penalty on Coperatieve Rabobank U.A

RBI imposed a monetary penalty of '1 crore on Coperatieve Rabobank UA. Its Mumbai Branch is a part of the Netherlands-based Rabobank Group. The penalty has been imposed for contravention of certain provisions of the Banking Regulation Act, 1949 and directions related to 'transfer to reserve funds'. A penalty of Rs 5 lakh has been imposed on Village Financial Services, Kol.

26. IDFC FIRST Bank signs up with Indian Navy to offer Honour FIRST banking solutions

IDFC FIRST Bank announced the signing of a MoU with the Indian Navy to offer Honour FIRST, a premium banking solution, to serving personnel and veterans of the Indian Navy. Account-



holders of Honour FIRST are supported by a dedicated team of defence veterans. The MoU for Honour FIRST was signed at the Naval Headquarters in New Delhi

27. RBI to levy penalty on ATMs that run out of cash

RBI has asked banks and white label automated teller machine (ATM) operators to put in place a robust system that will allow them to monitor the availability of cash in ATMs.

The central bank has introduced a 'scheme of penalty for non-replenishment of ATMs', wherein banks and white label ATM operators will be penalised, in the event of cash-outs beyond the permissible time

28. RBI to introduce 'Regulatory GAAR' for round tripping

Some of the largest Indian companies, startups and multinationals with an India presence have put their outbound investment, fundraising and restructuring plans on hold as the RBI looks to introduce fresh regulations around 'round tripping.' The central bank is looking to tweak the existing regulations and has come up with draft rules around round tripping.

29. BLS's subsidiary, Starfin empanelled as National Business Correspondent for Bank of Baroda

The subsidiary of BLS International, Starfin India signed a contract with Bank of Baroda to support the financial inclusion mission of Govt of India.

Under the contract, the company is the official National Business Correspondent (NBC) to deliver last mile banking services in rural and urban areas across India.

Starfin is already empanelled as the NBC of SBI.

30. Citibank becomes first US bank to set up unit in IFSC at GIFT City

Citibank, headquartered in the USA and has a strong international presence, received a license from the IFSC Authority to set up its banking unit at India's first International Financial Services Centre at GIFT City, Gujarat.

With this, Citibank will become the first US-based bank to set up a branch in GIFT-IFSC. Citibank will be serving both Indian & global customers.

31. RBI Introduces Financial Inclusion Index

Reserve Bank of India has constructed a composite Financial Inclusion Index (FI-Index) to capture the extent of financial inclusion across the country.

The FI-Index has been conceptualised as a comprehensive index incorporating details of banking, investments, insurance, postal as well as the pension sector in consultation with Government and respective sectoral regulators.

32. RBI to put in place a 'PRISM' to strengthen compliance by lenders

The Reserve Bank of India is putting in place a Platform for Regulated Entities for Integrated Supervision and Monitoring (PRISM), a web-based end-to-end workflow automation system, to strengthen compliance by supervised entities (SEs).

This is aimed at helping supervised entities to strengthen their internal defences and resilience and bringing focus on root cause analysis

33. Ujjivan Small Finance Bank chief Nitin Chugh steps down due to personal reasons

Ujjivan Small Finance Bank's managing director and chief effective officer Nitin Chugh has tendered his resignation.

The resignation will come into effect from September 30, 2021. Ujjivan Small Finance Bank had roped in Chugh from HDFC Bank in May 2019, he took over the baton from predecessor Samit Ghosh in December 2019. RBI had approved the appointment for three years

34. The Reserve Bank of India issues revised guidelines for hiring of locker facility provided by banks

Taking into consideration the various developments in the area of banking & technology, nature of consumer grievances & feedback received from banks, RBI has issued revised guidelines for locker/safe custody facility. It is now mandatory for banks to maintain a branch-



wise list of vacant lockers as well as a wait-list for the allotment of lockers. The new guidelines will be effective from 1st January 2022.

35. USAID, DFC join hands with Kotak Mahindra Bank to support MSMEs

US Agency for International Development & US International Development Finance Corporation (DFC) would jointly sponsor a \$50 mn. loan portfolio guarantee to Kotak Mahindra Bank to support increased financial access to women borrowers, and MSMEs in India.

Under the program, Kotak Mahindra Bank will provide loans to NBFCs operating in the MSME and Microfinance (MFI) space.

36. Honda Cars partners with Canara Bank to offer finance options to customers

Honda Cars India Ltd (HCIL) has joined hands with Canara Bank to offer retail finance schemes to customers.

The partnership facilitates HCIL customers to avail easy financing options and hassle free car loans from Canara Bank for purchase of models like Amaze, City, Jazz and WR-V.

37. 'BADLAAV Humse Hai': AU Bank unveils mega Brand Campaign and launches AU 0101, its Digital Bank & Credit Card

AU Small Finance Bank, India's Largest SFB has unveiled a mega Brand Campaign, aptly titled 'BADLAAV Humse Hai'.

This is the first integrated marketing communication campaign from AU Bank since its inception 'a creative endeavor that will showcase the bank's passion for innovation.

38. RBI imposes Rs 27.5 lakh penalty on Dhanlaxmi Bank for rule violations

The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) imposed a monetary penalty of Rs. 27.50 lakh on Kerala-based private sector lender Dhanlaxmi Bank for various rule violations.

The examination of the Risk Assessment Report and Inspection Report pertaining to the same revealed violation of certain provisions of the Depositor Education and Awareness Fund Scheme. Dhanlaxmi Bank Headquarters: Thrissur; Founded: 1927

39. RBI extends scope of tokenisation to laptops, wearable devices

The Reserve Bank extended the scope of 'tokenisation' to several consumer devices, including laptops, desktops, wearables like wristwatches and bands, as well as Internet of Things devices.

Tokenization, which aims at improving the safety and security of the payment system, refers to the replacement of actual card details with a unique alternate code called the 'token'.

40. State Bank of India (SBI) has opened a floating ATM on Dal Lake in Jammu and Kashmir's Srinagar

SBI has opened a floating ATM on a Houseboat at Dal Lake in Jammu and Kashmir's Srinagar for the convenience of locals and tourists. The floating ATM was inaugurated by SBI Chairman Dinesh Khare.

SBI also inaugurated a floating ATM in Kerala in 2004. SBI has over 60,000 ATMs in India, the largest network in the country.

41. RBI imposes Rs 15 lakh penalty on Baghat Urban Co-operative Bank, Solan

The RBI has imposed a penalty of Rs 15 lakh on The Baghat Urban Co-operative Bank Limited, Solan, for violation of certain norms, including, those related to NPA classification.

RBI has imposed a penalty of Rs 1 lakh on Delhi Nagrik Sehkari Bank Limited, New Delhi, for non-compliance with certain directions issued by the central bank.

42. Indo-Nepal Remittance Facility: RBI enhances transaction ceiling 4-fold to '2 lakh

RBI has made enhancements to the Indo-Nepal Remittance Facility Scheme, whereby the ceiling per transaction has been increased 4-fold to '2 L & the cap of 12 remittances in a year per remitter has been removed. Under the scheme, the beneficiary receives funds in Nepalese

1. CII enters into agreement with SII to speed up vaccination program in partnership with industry including health care providers

Confederation of Indian Industry, CII, has entered into an agreement with Serum Institute of India (SII) to speed up the vaccination program in partnership with industry including health care providers. CII and SII partnership will ensure to connect hospitals and corporates to fast track vaccination which is necessary for post pandemic growth of the country. Serum Institute of India CEO: Adar Poonawala

2. RBI imposes fine over Rs 50 lakh on Janalaxmi Co-operative Bank for non-compliance

RBI has imposed a penalty of Rs 50.35 lakh on Janalaxmi Co-operative Bank, Nashik for non-compliance with certain regulatory requirements.

The penalty on Janalaxmi Co-operative Bank has been imposed for non-compliance with directions issued by RBI on Placement of Deposits with Other Banks by Primary (Urban) Co-operative Banks and Membership of Credit Information Companies

3. IndusInd Bank gets empanelled as Agency Bank to RBI

IndusInd Bank has been empanelled by the RBI to act as an 'Agency Bank' to facilitate transactions related to government businesses.

The announcement comes after a recent RBI guideline that authorises scheduled private sector banks as agency banks of the regulator for the conduct of government business. RBI also empanelled Karnataka Bank to act as an 'agency bank".

4. Centre introduces bill to scrap retrospective tax law

Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman introduced The Taxation Laws (Amendment) Bill, 2021 in the Lok Sabha that finally puts an end to the government's pursuit of taxing indirect transfers through retrospective amendments. The Bill proposes to relax this retrospective tax impact for income arising from indirect transfer of Indian assets undertaken before 28 May 2012.

5. Govt cuts Mudra loans target in FY22, rules out fresh PSB merger proposal

The government has set the loans disbursement target under the PM Mudra Yojana (PMMY) at Rs 3 trillion for the current financial year as compared to Rs 3.21 trillion sanctioned in FY21.

Out of the Rs 3.21 trillion worth loans sanctioned under the PMMY in the last financial year, Rs 3.12 trillion were disbursed to entrepreneurs. Under PMMY, credit up to Rs 10 lakh is given by banks/nbfc for entrepreneurial activities

6. Bajaj family to buy out JV partners in Mukand

One of India's oldest manufacturing joint ventures that had the blessings of Mahatma Gandhi is finally getting unstuck. The Bajaj family has decided to buy out its partners, the Shah brothers Suketu and Rajesh, from the 84-year old steel venture Mukand Ltd. The Shah family will be cashing out of the business, transferring their residual 16.5% stake to their partners

7. Gift City, India Insurtech ink pact to promote fintech in insurance sector

GIFT City, the country's first international financial services centre (IFSC) has collaborated with the India InsurTech Association (IIA) to promote financial technology in the insurance sector. The two entities will collaborate on building thought leadership in the field of insurance and creating awareness about Gift City among Indian and foreign insurance companies GIFT City: Gujarat International Finance Tec-City

8. Tata Motors collaborates with Bank of Maharashtra for car loan scheme

Tata Motors has joined hands with Bank of Maharashtra to offer car loan facilities for its New Forever range of passenger vehicles.

Under the collaboration, Bank of Maharashtra will provide loans to Tata Motors' customers at an interest rate starting from as low as 7.15 per cent linked with Repo Linked Lending Rate (RLLR), subject to certain conditions.



9. IIFL Home Finance Limited inks pact with Asian Development Bank

Zydus Cadila has received the Emergency Use Authorization (EUA) from the Drug Controller General of India (DCGI) for ZyCoV-D, the world's first Plasmid DNA vaccine for the Covid-19. The ZyCoV-D is a three-dose vaccine. With this approval, India now has its first Covid-19 vaccine for adolescents in the 12-18 age group, besides the adult population.

85. Prime Minister lays foundation stone of multiple projects in Somnath, Gujarat

Prime Minister virtually inaugurated and laid the foundation stone of various projects in Somnath, Gujarat. The projects inaugurated include the Somnath Promenade, the Somnath Exhibition Centre, and the reconstructed temple precinct of Old Somnath. The Prime Minister also laid the foundation stone of Shree Parvati Temple during the event.

86. National Monetisation Plan: India Unveils Road Map For Up To Rs 6 Lakh Crore Worth Of Asset Sales

FM Nirmala Sitharaman to launch the National Monetisation pipeline(NMP), which will list out the govt's infrastructure assets to be sold over the next four-years.

India just got its first 'highest' herbal park at Mana in Uttarakhand's Chamoli district. The park, situated at a height of 11000 ft, was inaugurated at Mana Village, which is situated close to the Indo-China border.

According to Chief Conservator of Forests Sanjiv Chaturvedi, the park will help conserve various medicinally and culturally important alpine species.

90. Social Justice And Empowerment Minister Flags Off 'Operation Blue Freedom' To Create A World Record At Siachen Glacier

This will provide a premium of Rs 2.90/qtl for each 0.1% increase in recovery over and above 10%, and reduction in FRP by Rs 2.90/qtl for every 0.1% decrease in recovery.

1. Roche launches Evrysdi, the only approved drug to treat Spinal Muscular Atrophy

Swiss drug major Roche launched Evrysdi (risdiplam), the first and only approved drug in India for Spinal Muscular Atrophy (SMA), a progressive rare neuromuscular disease. Evrysdi, a breakthrough orally administered treatment for SMA patients, was first approved by the USFDA in 2020 and is made available in India within 11 months of US approval

2. Regular freight train service starts between India and Bangladesh on the revived Haldibari-Chilahati rail route

In a significant boost to connectivity btw India and Bangladesh, a goods train loaded with stone chips arrived at Chilahati in Bangladesh from India through the Haldibari-Chilahati route. The train was dispatched from the Damdim station of the Northeast Frontier railway. This rail route has been revived 56 years after being discontinued during the India-Pakistan war of 1965 Haldibari-Chilahati rail line was inaugurated last year during a summit btw both the PMs.

3. World's largest star sapphire cluster found in a Sri Lankan backyard

World's largest star sapphire cluster has been found in Ratnapura, Srilanka. The stone is pale blue in colour. It was found by labourers while digging a well in a gem trader's home. Ratnapura is known as the gem capital of the country. The sapphire cluster weighs around 510kgs or 2.5 million carats. It has an estimated value of up to \$100 million in the international market

4. Germany becomes 5th country to sign International Solar Alliance Framework Agreement

Germany became the 5th country to sign the International Solar Alliance Framework Agreement after amendments to it entered into force on 8th January this year, opening its Membership to all Member States of the United Nations. ISA is an alliance of over 124 nations that have been initiated by India. Its headquarters is located in Gurugram, New Delhi Ambassador of Germany to India: Walter J. Lindner

5. India-Bhutan hydropower project bags prestigious Brunel Medal

The 720 MW Mangdechhu hydroelectric project, an India-Bhutan venture, has been awarded the prestigious Brunel Medal for excellence in civil engineering by the UK-based Institute of Civil Engineers. This was jointly inaugurated by the PM of the two countries in August 2019. The GoI has constructed four hydropower projects in Bhutan and Three more are under construction. Kholongchhu is the first joint venture model project between the two sides

6. Myanmar forms caretaker gov't with Min Aung Hlaing as prime minister

Myanmar formed a Republic of the Union of Myanmar Caretaker Government, according to an order by the State Administration Council. Under the order, the new caretaker government will be led by Commander-in-Chief of Defence Services Sen-Gen Min Aung Hlaing as prime minister and Vice Sen-Gen Soe Win as deputy prime minister

7. South Africa grants patent to an artificial intelligence system

South Africa grants a patent relating to a 'food container based on fractal geometry' to an artificial intelligence (AI) system called DABUS. DABUS (which stands for 'device for the autonomous bootstrapping of unified sentience') is an AI system created by Stephen Thaler, a pioneer in the field of AI and programming. The system simulates human brainstorming

8. UNICEF India, Facebook collaborate to make a safer digital world for children

Facebook is launching a one-year joint initiative with UNICEF India on ending violence against children with a special focus on online safety. The partnership seeks to create a safe environment for children online as well as offline, and aims to improve the 'resilience' and 'capacity' of children to access the digital world safely as well as increase skills of communities.



9. 28th ASEAN Regional Forum Ministerial Meeting

The Minister of State for External Affairs Dr. Rajkumar Ranjan Singh led India's delegation to the 28th ASEAN Regional Forum (ARF) Foreign Ministers Meeting. The Meeting was held under the Chairmanship of Brunei Darussalam. The ARF member countries exchanged views on international and regional issues, as well as future direction of the ARF The ARF adopted a Joint Statement on Promoting the Youth, Peace and Security Agenda

10. India, Sri Lanka, Maldives meet identifies terrorism, trafficking among 4 areas of concern

Terrorism and radicalisation, marine safety and security, trafficking and organised crime, and cyber security were identified as the 'four pillars' of cooperation in a trilateral security meeting held between Sri Lanka, India and Maldives.

The decision to establish Colombo Security Conclave was made in November 2020 at the NSA-level meeting of India, Lanka and Maldives.

11. Afghan President Ashraf Ghani resigns & leaves country

Afghan President Ashraf Ghani has left the country. It is now confirmed that Taliban insurgents entered Afghanistan's capital Kabul. Meanwhile, official sources confirmed that President Ashraf Ghani has left the city for Tajikistan capping the militants' lightning push for the power. Diplomats from the various countries have already evacuated their embassies

12. Bangladesh to sign MoU with China for COVID vaccine co-production

Government of Bangladesh will sign an MoU for the co-production of the COVID 19 vaccine with China. Health Minister Zahid Maleque, Foreign Minister Dr A K Abdul Momen & the Chinese Ambassador to Bangladesh Li Jiming are scheduled to attend the MoU signing ceremony in Dhaka. The MoU will be signed between the Chinese company Sinopharm and the local company Incepta Pharma Ltd

13. Resolution reintroduced in US Congress to award Congressional Gold Medal to Mahatma Gandhi

Mahatma Gandhi would be the first Indian to receive a Congressional Gold Medal, an honour bestowed upon great figures as George Washington, Nelson Mandela, Martin Luther King Jr, Mother Teresa, and Rosa Parks.

The prestigious Congressional Gold Medal to Mahatma Gandhi is given posthumously in recognition of his promotion of peace and nonviolence. The medal is the highest civilian award in the United States

14. Malaysia's PM Muhyiddin Yassin resigns as political crisis escalates

Malaysia's Muhyiddin Yassin has stepped down as prime minister after months of political turmoil culminated in the loss of his majority. 1. Shuttler P V Sindhu bags bronze medal in Tokyo Olympics, becomes the first Indian woman to win two Olympic medals

Indian shuttler P V Sindhu won the bronze medal in the women's single match in Tokyo Olympics today. PV Sindhu defeated He Bing Jiao of China by 21-13 and 21-15 in the bronze medal match and became the first Indian woman to win two Olympic medals. Sindhu won silver at Rio 2016. Wrestler Sushil Kumar is the first and only other Indian to win two Olympic medals. Chen Yu Fei won the gold, while Tai Tzu-Ying settled for the silver.

2. Italy's Marcell Jacobs wins men's 100m gold at Tokyo Olympics 2020

Marcell Jacobs claimed a stunning upset victory in the Olympic 100 metres final, becoming the first Italian to take the most coveted title in athletics and doing it with a huge European record of 9.80 seconds. American Fred Kerley took silver in a personal best 9.84 with Canada's Andre de Grasse repeating his bronze of 2016 in 9.89, also a new best. Jamaica's Elaine Thompson won gold & Shelly-Ann Fraser-Pryce won bronze in women's 100m.

3. Alexander Zverev wins gold in men's singles tennis beating Karen Khachanov who takes silver

Germany's Alexander Zverev beats Russian Karen Khachanov 6-3 6-1 to win the men's singles gold at the Tokyo Olympics. He became the first German man to win singles Olympic gold. Belinda Bencic of Switzerland won the women's tennis gold in singles.

Israel's Artem Dolgopyat won his country's first gold medal at the Tokyo Olympics in the men's individual floor exercise event

4. USA beats Mexico 1-0 to win CONCACAF Gold Cup

Miles Robinson scored on a goal in the 117th minute to win the CONCACAF Gold Cup. The U.S. won its 7th Gold Cup title, its first since 2017, matching Mexico for the most in the 15 tournaments. Canada won in 2000. The Gold Cup is the main association football competition of the men's national football teams governed by CONCACAF, determining the continental champion The Gold Cup is held every two years

5. Esteban Ocon wins Hungarian GP, Lewis Hamilton takes F1 lead

Frenchman Esteban Ocon won a chaotic Hungarian Grand Prix while Lewis Hamilton finished third to take the Formula One championship lead from Max Verstappen. Sebastian Vettel lost his second-place finish in Hungarian Formula One Grand Prix after being disqualified by stewards for a fuel irregularity. Verstappen placed 10th after being taken out early in the race

6. Sri Lanka all-rounder Isuru Udana retires from international cricket

Sri Lanka left-arm seam bowling all-rounder Isuru Udana announced his retirement from international cricket with immediate effect, drawing curtains to a career spanning over a decade. Udana had a very modest international career with sporadic appearances over 12 years in which he played only 21 ODIS and 35 T20 Internationals with just 45 wickets to show for his efforts

7. India win bronze medal in Tokyo, first Olympic medal in hockey since 1980

India men's hockey team defeated Germany to win the bronze medal at the Tokyo Olympics. This is India's first Olympic medal in hockey since they won the gold medal in the 1980 Olympics in Moscow. This is India's fourth-medal in Tokyo so far. The captain of the team is Manpreet Singh, while the coach is Graham Reid. After 41 years Indian Hockey team won a medal in the Olympics

8. Tokyo Olympics: Boxer Lovlina Borgohain bags Bronze Medal in welterweight category

In Tokyo Olympic Boxer Lovlina Borgohain has bagged a Bronze Medal in welterweight 69 kilogram category. This is the third medal for the country. Earlier, PV Sindhu won a Bronze Medal in Badminton while Mira Bai Chanu lifted a Silver Medal in weightlifting. She is only the



third Indian boxer to win an Olympic medal, after Vijendra Singh(2008) and Mary Kom(2012). She is the first female boxer from Assam to qualify for the Olympics

9. Labhanshu Sharma wins Bharat Kesari Wrestling Dangal for Uttarakhand

Indian Wrestler Labhanshu Sharma won the Bharat Kesari Wrestling Dangal 2021 organised in Tamil Nadu. 20 years since the formation of Uttarakhand, Labhanshu is the first to win the title of Bharat Kesari for the state. With 15 gold medals at the state level and 10 medals at the national level and 2 gold medals and 1 silver medal in the International Wrestling competitions

10. India's ace grappler Ravi kumar Dahiya wins Silver Medal in Tokyo Olympics

Indian wrestler Ravi Kumar Dahiya clinched an Olympic silver medal after losing his 57 kg final to Russian two-time defending world champion Zavur Uguev. The ROC wrestler registered a 7-4 win against Dahiya. There were expectations that the 23-year-old Dahiya would become India's youngest Olympic champion but the Russian defended well to win comfortably

11. PM renames Rajiv Gandhi Khel Ratna award after Dhyan Chand

Prime Minister Narendra Modi announced the renaming of the Rajiv Gandhi Khel Ratna Award, the country's highest sporting honour, after hockey wizard Major Dhyan Chand.

Prime Minister said the 'exceptional performance' of the men and women hockey teams in the Tokyo Olympics will rekindle interest in the game across India. Rani Rampal is the third hockey player to be given the Khel Ratna (2020)

12. The 'golden throw' of 87.58 m by Neeraj Chopra earns a historical gold for India

Neeraj Chopra has won a historical gold medal in the men's javelin throw at Tokyo 2020 Olympic with a throw of 87.58 m. And With this, the 23-year-old has become the first Indian athlete to win a gold medal in track and field events. Chopra finished on the top spot in the qualification rounds with a stunning throw of 86.65 m. He has also won gold at the 2018 Asian Games and the 2018 Commonwealth Games

13. Bajrang Punia wins wrestling Bronze At Tokyo Olympics

Wrestler Bajrang Punia beat Kazakhstan's Daulet Niyazbekov to win the bronze medal in the men's 65kg Freestyle category. It was India's sixth medal at the ongoing Tokyo Olympics, equaling the country's best-ever haul that was achieved at the 2012 London Games.

14. James Anderson surpasses Anil Kumble, becomes 3rd highest wicket-taker in Test cricket

James Anderson overtook Anil Kumble's tally of 619 Test wickets to become the third-highest wicket-taker in the Test cricket. He achieved this huge feat after KL Rahul knocked one to wicket-keeper Jos Buttler. His current wickets tally stands at 621 from 163 Tests.

Anderson is currently the highest wicket-taker among the fast bowlers and is the only pacer in the 600 club He achieved milestone with the wicket of KL Rahul on the 3rd day of the Nottingham test

15. France 2024: Olympics closing ceremony features celebrations from next host city

For the first time ever, the closing ceremony of the Olympic Games featured "live and spectacular" celebrations from the next host city of the mega sporting event. At the Closing Ceremony of the Tokyo Olympics, flag-bearers of all countries entered the stadium to mark the end of 17-days of the Games, which saw the participation of athletes from over 200 countries. India won 4 bronze, 2 silver & 1 gold in Olympics 2020 making it the most successful one

1. Eutelsat Quantum Launched a Revolutionary Reprogrammable Satellite 'Chameleon'

A sophisticated telecommunications satellite that can be completely repurposed while in space has launched. Developed under an ESA Partnership Project with satellite operator Eutelsat and prime manufacturer Airbus, Eutelsat Quantum has pioneered a new generation of satellites with the European space industry. The satellite was launched from Europe's Spaceport in French Guiana

2. Russia's Nauka multi-purpose lab module docks to space station

Russia's Multipurpose Laboratory Module (MLM), named "Nauka" ("Science" in Russian), docked to the space station, eight days after its more-than-decade-long delayed launch. The 20-tonne MLM is connected with the orbiting complex, using an open port that was recently vacated by the Pirs docking compartment on the Earth-facing side of the Zvezda service module.

6. Chandrayaan-2 orbiter detects water molecules on lunar surface

India's ambitious Chandrayaan-2 moon mission may have made a hard landing on the lunar surface in 2019, but the orbiter accompanying it has been providing useful information to scientists back on Earth. And earlier this week, a research paper revealed that the Chandrayaan-2 orbiter confirmed the presence of water molecules and hydroxyl on the surface of the moon.

7. ISRO Launches GSLV-F10/EOS-03 Mission But Faces Setback Due to Performance Anomaly in Cryogenic Stage

ISRO's second mission of the year to place an earth observation satellite by a GSLV rocket faced a setback as the mission could not be accomplished fully due to a performance anomaly in the cryogenic stage of the rocket. About seven minutes into its launch at 5.43 a.m. the Indian rocket GSLV-F10 encountered problems in its cryogenic engine-the third and last engine Geosynchronous Satellite Launch Vehicle: GSLV Indian Space Research Organisation: ISRO

8. Bharat Biotech's nasal Covid-19 vaccine advances into the next stage of trials.

Indian vaccine maker Bharat Biotech's nasal COVID-19 vaccine candidate has received regulatory approval for mid-to late-stage trials. Early-stage trials of the vaccine candidate, BBV154, have been completed in subjects aged 18 to 60 years, and the doses were found to



be well tolerated. BBV154 Covid Vaccine is the first intranasal vaccine being developed in the country. COVAXIN, Bharat Biotech's Covid-19 vaccine is administered through an injection.

9. DBT's Institute of Bioresources and Sustainable Development Sets up a Science Museum

10. IIT Delhi researchers develop modified cotton fabric which absorbs air pollutants


Researchers at the Indian Institute of Technology Delhi have developed a modified cotton fabric capable of adsorbing harmful air pollutants.

This is the maiden attempt of the Indian Navy and Cochin Shipyard to indigenously design and build an Aircraft Carrier Vikrant is 262m long, a maximum of 62m wide and 59m high.

7. BRO constructs highest motorable road in the world in Eastern Ladakh

Border Roads Organisation (BRO) has constructed and black-topped the highest motorable road in the world at 19,300 ft at Umlingla Pass in Eastern Ladakh, creating a record in highaltitude road construction. It has constructed a 52-km long tarmac road through Umlingla Pass, bettering the previous record of a road in Bolivia connecting to its volcano Uturuncu at 18,953 ft The Khardung La Pass in Leh is at an altitude of 17,582 ft

Environment

1. Four sites of India added to the Ramsar list as wetlands of international importance.

Thol and Wadhwana from Gujarat and Sultanpur and Bhindawas from Haryana are added to the Ramsar list as wetlands of international importance. While Haryana gets its first Ramsar sites, Gujarat gets three more after Nalsarovar which was declared in 2012. The total number of Ramsar sites in India is 46. The Ramsar Convention on Wetlands is named after the city of Ramsar in Iran.

2. Single-use plastic items are to be prohibited from July 2022.

The government has notified Plastic Waste Management Amendment Rules, 2021, prohibiting identified single-use plastic items by 2022. With effect from 30th September 2021, the thickness of plastic carry bags has been increased to 75 microns from 50 microns and to 120 microns with effect from the 31st December 2022. The provisions will not apply to commodities made of compostable plastic.

3. Rare orchid species found in India for the first time

A rare orchid species, Cephalanthera erecta var. oblanceolata, has been found for the first time in India in Uttarakhand's Chamoli district at an altitude of 1870 metres.

Uttarakhand has around 250 recorded orchid species.

Cephalanthera represents a small group of terrestrial orchids with about 19 taxa, mainly distributed in Europe, North America and temperate parts of Asia

The scheme will screen those above 45 years of age and others with infirmities through routine door-to-door check-ups and detect non-communicable diseases

2. Tamil Nadu Govt in consultation with Germany to sign MoU to procure 2,500 buses for public transport

The Tamil Nadu Government is in consultation with Germany to sign a Memorandum of Understanding to procure 2,500 buses for public transport. At least nine lakh women in the state have been benefited in the free travel scheme. The Minister said that an additional allocation of 150 crore rupees was allocated for the Transport Department

3. TN govt forms 7-member panel for study of hydrocarbon projects

The Tamil Nadu government has constituted a seven-member committee to study the exploration of hydrocarbon projects which will be headed by Sultan Ahmed Ismail, part-time member, State Development Policy Council.

The committee constituted will have freedom to conduct the study in areas other than the protected agricultural zone as the terms of reference have been revised.

Telangana

1. Greater Hyderabad Municipal Corporation (GHMC) holds special drive to tackle mosquito breeding

The innovative 'Every Sunday 10 minutes at 10 am' programme was held in parts of the city by GHMC.

Under the programme, stagnant water inside the houses and surroundings were emptied as they could turn into mosquito breeding spots.

The GHMC staffers explained to people the need to empty stagnant water in order to curb malaria & dengue.



Tripura

1. FM Nirmala Sitharaman inaugurates 'My Pad, My Right' project in Tripura

In Tripura, Union Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman inaugurated a project called 'My Pad, My Right' initiated by NABARD and NABFOUNDATION at Killa village in Gomati district on the second and concluding day of her visit to the state.

The project aims to bring livelihood and menstrual hygiene closer to rural women by way of grant, wage support and capital equipment.

Uttar Pradesh

1. Uttar Pradesh : Dr. Akhilesh Mishra named new chairman of Child Protection Committee

The lead journalist Dr. Akhilesh Kumar Mishra has been appointed Chairman of the Juvenile Justice Committee and the Child Protection Committee (CWC) on behalf of the Uttar Pradesh Government's Ministry of Women's and Child Development. He succeeded Kamlesh Singh. The committee consists of a chairman and four members.

2. Faridabad Smart City 'ropes in' comic book icon Chacha Chaudhary to aid mission

Faridabad Smart City Limited has roped in an unlikely collaborator to help promote its initiatives on social media 'comic hero Chacha Chaudhary.

The social media campaign's objective will be to promote the steps taken by the agency. It will involve releasing 'excerpts of 'Talking Comics', with each social media post depicting Chacha Chaudhary and his sidekick, Sabu.

3. UP government renames 'conspiracy' to Kakori Train Action, pays tribute to martyrs

The Uttar Pradesh government has renamed a landmark freedom movement event as Kakori Train Action while paying tributes to the revolutionaries who were hanged for robbing a train at Kakori to buy weapons in 1925.

The new name was used in official communications to refer to the event, usually described as the 'Kakori train robbery' or the 'Kakori train conspiracy'.

4. Ganga Expressway: UP govt gets approval letter for ' 5100 crore loan from PNB

The Uttar Pradesh government received the sanction letter of '5100 crore loan for the 594-kilometre-long Ganga Expressway project from the Punjab National Bank (PNB) in the presence of Union finance minister Nirmala Sitharaman and chief minister Yogi Adityanath at an event in Lucknow.

This expressway will be the longest in north India and the second longest in the country. The project's estimated cost is '36,230 crore. SS Mallikarjuna Rao: MD and CEO of PNB

5. Union Home Minister Amit Shah lays foundation stone of Uttar Pradesh State Institute of Forensic Sciences

The Union Home Minister launched several development projects in the State. He laid the foundation stone for the Vindhyachal Corridor Project and inaugurated a ropeway in Mirzapur. He also laid the foundation stone of Uttar Pradesh Institute of Forensic Sciences, (UPIFS) in Piparsand area at Sarojini Nagar in Lucknow. CM of Uttar Pradesh: Yogi Adityanath

Uttarakhand

1. Uttarakhand Becomes First State To Launch Earthquake Alert App

Uttarakhand becomes the first state to launch an earthquake alert app named 'Uttarakhand Bhookamp Alert'. Uttarakhand Chief Minister Pushkar Singh Dhami launched the app, available for download on both Android and iOS platforms. The app was developed by the Uttarakhand State Disaster Management Authority and the Indian Institute of Technology-Roorkee This app will send early warning messages to people before the earthquake



West Bengal

1. West Bengal transport agency rolls out CNG buses in Kolkata

West Bengal Transport Corporation (WBTC) introduced CNG-fuelled buses in Kolkata. Transport Minister Firhad Hakim inaugurated the first such vehicle. BGCL, a joint venture of GAIL (India) Ltd and Greater Calcutta Gas Supply Corporation Ltd, signed an agreement with the WBTC for the supply of CNG to its depots.

2. Kolkata: Dhriti Banerjee appointed first woman director of Zoological Survey of India

For the first time a woman, Dhriti Banerjee has been appointed as the director of the Zoological Survey of India. She has been an eminent scientist conducting research in zoogeography, taxonomy, morphology among others. Started in July 1916, the ZSI is headquartered in Kolkata with 16 regional centres under the ministry of environment and forests and climate change

3. West Bengal receives four SKOCH awards for its schemes under Ease of Doing Business initiative

The WB Govt has received four SKOCH awards for its schemes under the Ease of Doing Business initiative.

The State scheme Silpasathi-the online single window portal won the platinum award while the Auto Renewal of Certificate of Enlistment through online system for urban areas has received the gold award. Online issuance of trade licences and the E-Nathikaran won two silver

Delhi

1. Delhi CM Arvind Kejriwal launches initiative to make Delhi a 'global city'

Delhi chief minister Arvind Kejriwal launched an initiative that aims to support partnerships of the government with corporates and citizen groups to work towards policies and strategies for the city's development. The initiative has been named 'Delhi@2047', which is in line with the Aam Aadmi Party's vision document incorporated in the state budget 2021-22

2. DIAL signs MoU with Medanta to set up COVID-19 care centre for Delhi airport employees

The Delhi International Airport Limited (DIAL) has signed a memorandum of understanding with Medanta hospital to set up a COVID-19 care centre at the Delhi airport for its employees and their family members.

The Covid Care Centre, which is being established at the airport in anticipation of "the third wave of the COVID-19 pandemic", is expected to be operational by Sept.

3. Arvind Kejriwal inaugurates India's first smog tower in Delhi

Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal inaugurated India's first smog tower in Delhi's Connaught Place that will purify 1,000 cubic metres of air per second within a radius of around 1 km.

The tower has been set up as a pilot project and initial trends will be available within a month. If the pilot project is successful, more smog towers will be installed in the national capital.

Jammu and Kashmir

1. J&K: LG Manoj Sinha inaugurates 'Bungus Awaam Mela' at Bungus Valley

In the Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir, Lieutenant Governor, Manoj Sinha inaugurated the 'Bungus Awaam Mela' at Bungus Valley in north Kashmir's Kupwara district amidst grand arrangements for village games, exhilarating local performances, and other activities to celebrate the 75th year of Independence Day at Bungus valley

2. J&K: 8.5 Km Qazigund-Banihal tunnel open to traffic for trial

In the Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir, the 8.5 kms long tunnel between Qazigund and Banihal has been opened for traffic on a trial basis. The tunnel will reduce travel time between Jammu and Srinagar by about one & half hours and 16 kilometres. Built at 5,800 feet above sea level, the Tunnel replaces Jawahar Tunnel and will provide all weather connectivity



Lakshadweep

1. Lakshadweep to get Maldives-style water villas

In a first, India's popular island destination Lakshadweep will soon have three premium Maldives-style water villas. The three premium projects will come up at Kadmat, Minicoy, and Suheli islands. Around INR 800 crore will be used in this ambitious project, and the administration has already floated global tenders recently

Puducherry

1. Puducherry celebrates its De Jure Transfer day

Puducherry on 16th August celebrated its De Jure Transfer day. Speaker of the Puducherry Assembly, R. Selvam, paid floral tributes at the memorial in Kizhur, a remote hamlet in Puducherry, where the transfer of power took place on the same day in 1962. De Jure Transfer Day is the day it really got independence. The then Pondicherry was under French control well after 1947.

Ladakh

1. Ladakh launches 'Pani Maah' to raise awareness about clean water; awards for 'Har Ghar Jal' villages too

'Pani Maah' or water month has been launched in Ladakh to inform villagers about the importance of clean water. The Ladakh govt has announced a reward of Rs 2.5 million for the first block in each district that achieves the status of 'Har Ghar Jal'. The campaign will adopt a three-pronged approach, focussing on water quality testing, planning and strategizing water supply.





Committees

1. Govt. forms panel to suggest ways to boost production, exports of handlooms

The government has set up an eight-member committee to suggest a roadmap for doubling production and quadrupling exports of handlooms in three years.

The panel would also put forth ways for collaboration of handloom weaver agencies with the designers, buying houses and institutions, organizations, and exporters; and suggest measures for quadrupling exports. The committee, chaired by Fashion Design Council of India (FDCI) Chairman Sunil Sethi.

2. RBI Expert Committee suggests setting up of Umbrella Organisation and 4-tier structure to regulate UCBs

The RBI committee under the chairmanship of N S Vishwanathan, former RBI Deputy Governor. said that urban cooperative banks (UCBs) can be split into four categories -- Tier-1 with deposits up to Rs 100 crore; Tier-2 with deposits between Rs 100-Rs 1,000 crore, Tier-3 with deposits between Rs 1,000 crore to Rs 10,000 and Tier-4 with deposits of over Rs 10,000 crore. The number of borrowers of UCBs is estimated at 67 lakh.
