#### **Towards Tax Justice And Wealth Redistribution In India**

The World Inequality Lab has released a follow-up paper to its previous study, "Income and Wealth Inequality in India, 1922-2023: The Rise of the Billionaire Raj," published in March 2024. This new study suggests a tax package for the ultra-wealthy that could generate revenue between 2.5% and 5% of India's GDP. The proposed revenue should be invested in social sectors like health and education to facilitate redistribution.

# Trends in Inequality

- Post-Independence: Inequality declined.
- Since the 1980s: Inequality began rising.
- Since the 2000s: Inequality has skyrocketed.

# Income Inequality

- The top 1% of earners take home 22.6% of the total pre-tax national income, up from 7.3% in 1980.
- The bottom 50% of earners receive only 15% of the total pre-tax national income.

## Wealth Inequality

- The top 1% control over 40% of the total wealth, up from 12.5% in 1980.
- The bottom 50% hold only 6.4% of the total wealth.

# **Proposed Tax Package**

#### Wealth Tax:

- 2% annual tax on net wealth exceeding Rs. 10 crores.
- 4% annual tax on net wealth exceeding Rs. 100 crores.

#### Inheritance Tax:

- 33% tax on estates valued over Rs. 10 crores.
- 45% tax on estates valued over Rs. 100 crores.

- In addition to this, budget provision for procurement operations has also been increased and Rs. 15,053
  crore is sanctioned for PM-AASHA implementation. The scheme henceforth is a reflection of Government's
  commitment and dedication to our 'Annadata'.

#### Component:

- Price Support Scheme (PSS)

    - Armament: Equipped with anti-aircraft guns and torpedo launchers.
  - **Technology:** Features early warning and fire control radars.
  - Warfare Capability: Can operate in nuclear, biological, and chemical warfare conditions.
  - Material: Built using indigenously developed high-strength warship-grade steel, type DMR 249A.
- Design and Construction:
  - Design: Created by the Indian Navy's Directorate of Naval Design.
  - Construction: Built by Garden Reach Shipbuilders & Engineers (GRSE) in Kolkata.

# **RBI Imposes Penalty On ICICI Bank And YES Bank For Rule Violations**

- The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) has imposed penalties on ICICI Bank and Yes Bank for various regulatory violations. ICICI Bank has been fined Rs 1 crore for non-compliance with loan-related norms. Yes Bank has been penalized Rs 91 lakh for breaches related to customer service and unauthorized internal account operations.
- > RBI discovered that ICICI Bank had approved term loans for specific entities as substitutes for budgetary resources without properly assessing the projects' viability and ensuring the revenue streams were adequate for debt servicing.
- For Yes Bank, the RBI identified that the bank imposed charges on certain savings accounts with insufficient or zero balances for not maintaining the minimum balance. Additionally, Yes Bank opened and operated internal accounts under customers' names for unauthorized purposes such as parking funds and routing transactions.
