Banking

News: Most Important

1. Bimal Jalan panel to recommend transfer of RBI reserve surplus

Bimal Jalan panel that was set up to review the economic capital framework of the Reserve Bank of India (RBI) has decided to recommend transfer of surplus reserves to the government in a staggered manner over **3-5 years** based on a predetermined formula.

2. *SIDBI introduces web-based application system for contribution from Fund of Funds for Start-ups*

SIDBI has introduced a web-based application system for contribution from Fund of Funds for Start-ups to improve the turnaround time and increase transparency. SIDBI is the implementing agency for FFS with a corpus of Rs 10,000 crore.

3. Andhra Bank unveils Al chatbot ABHi

Andhra Bank launched its Artificial Intelligence interactive assistant — **ABHi**. The Bank's AI powered chatbot uses latest Artificial Intelligence & Natural Language Processing (NLP) algorithm to understand the customer query and fetch the relevant information in a matter of milliseconds.

4. RBI names Deputy Governor B.P. Kanungo to run monetary policy

RBI had assigned deputy governor B.P. Kanungo to run the monetary policy portfolio after the resignation of fellow deputy governor Viral Acharya. He would become the sixth member of the Reserve Bank of India's Monetary Policy Committee.

5. NPCI ties up with JCB for global RuPay card

NPCI & JCB International, with domestic banks, have launched RuPay JCB Global Cards. Banks including SBI, PNB, Axis Bank, Union Bank, Central Bank of India, Andhra Bank, CUB & TJSB Bank will issue cards, which will be accepted at all POS terminals & ATMs.

6. Maharashtra tops in ATM frauds: RBI data

According to the RBI data, Maharashtra topped in ATM frauds in 2018-19 with 233 cases. Delhi grabbed the second spot followed by Tamil Nadu. Assam, Arunachal Pradesh & Tripura were the only 3 states that didn't report a single incident.

7. ICICI Bank launches digital banking platform 'InstaBIZ' for MSMEs

ICICI Bank has launched the digital platform called 'InstaBIZ' for MSME & self-employed customers to enable them to undertake business banking transactions digitally & instantly. They can get instant sanction of an overdraft facility up to **₹10 Lakh**.

8. HDFC Bank, CSC launch credit card for small traders, village entrepreneurs

HDFC Bank & CSC launched a co-branded 'Small Business MoneyBack Credit Card' for small traders & village level entrepreneurs. It is designed for CSC's VLEs, VLE-sourced customers & will give users easy access to credit for their day-to-day business expense.



9. RBI slaps Rs 7 crore fine on SBI for violating norms

RBI slapped a penalty of Rs 7 crore on SBI.The penalty has been imposed on SBI for noncompliance of income recognition & asset classification norms, code of conduct for opening & operating current accounts and reporting of data on (CRILC).

10. RBI to release Currency Identification App for Visually Challenged

The Reserve Bank of India will come out with a mobile application to help visually challenged people in identifying currency notes as cash still remains a dominant mode of transaction.

11. India to be first recipient of AIIB local currency funding

India is set to be the first recipient of local currency financing by the Asian Infrastructure and Investment Bank. Local currency financing provides more options to borrowers India is the second-largest shareholder of Beijing-based AIIB with a **7.5%** stake.

12. PNB Housing Finance raises around ₹690 crore from IFC

PNB Housing Finance Ltd has raised \$100 million (around 690 crore) from International Finance Corporation to finance the purchase of affordable housing projects. The investment was made under the central bank's automatic route in the revamped ECB framework.

13. Postal dept decides to convert India Post Payments Bank into SFB

The Postal Department has decided to convert the India Post Payments Bank (IPPB) into a small finance bank (SFB), enabling it to offer small loans to customers. The department also looks to open one crore accounts for IPPB in 100 days.

14. Aditya Birla Payments Bank shuts operations 18 months after launch

Aditya Birla Payments Bank, a venture between Idea Cellular and Aditya Birla Nuvo, has shut down its operations. The payments bank that was only 18-month old asked its customers to transfer their balances before July 26.

15. RBI eases end-use norms for external commercial borrowings by corporates,

NBFCs

RBI relaxed norms for end-use of money raised through ECBs. ECBs with a minimum average maturity period of 7 years can be availed for repayment of rupee loans availed domestically for capital expenditure as also by NBFCs for on-lending for the same purpose.

16. Wilful defaults exceed \$21 billion in India for the year 2018-19, SBI holds the highest

The state-owned banks in India stated that ₹1.50 trillion (\$21.76 billion) worth of loans as wilful defaults in 2018-19. SBI holds the highest number of wilful defaults, worth around ₹ 461.58 bn, while PNB ranked second at Rs.250.9 bn and Bank of India at Rs.98.9 bn.



17. *India* Received Highest-Ever FDI Of Over \$64 Billion In 2018-19

Acc. to a report by Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade, India received \$64.37 bn in investments in 2018-19 under the foreign direct investment policy liberalization & reforms. FDI worth \$286 bn has been received in last 5 years.

1. Co-operative Bank in K'taka offers ₹5,000 incentive for rainwater harvesting

Moodbidri Cooperative Service Bank Ltd., a cooperative bank in Dakshina Kannada is offering ₹5,000 as incentive to its members who carry out rainwater harvesting, to re-charge open wells in two villages nearby during the ongoing monsoon season.

2. Yes Bank launches Smart Edge, a lending program for MSMEs

Yes Bank has announced a surrogate lending program 'Smart Edge' through which an MSME can avail secured working capital limits from ₹ 1 - 3 Crore in the form of Overdraft, Letter of Credit & Financial Bank Guarantees.

3. Repco MFI wins award from NABARD for SHG linkage in TN

Repco Micro Finance has received NABARD's award for outstanding performance in terms of self-help group linkage in Tamil Nadu for 2018-19. It has provided SHG loans worth ₹3600 Cr to over 12 L individual beneficiaries through 60,000 SHGs.

4. NABARD to raise Rs 55,000 crore from market in FY20

Nabard has planned to raise about ₹ 55000 Cr from the market in the current fiscal to fund its business growth & support various agricultural & rural development schemes of the govt. Nabard has raised ₹ 12000 Cr in the 1st quarter of the current FY.

1. LIC to lend ₹25,000 crore to NHAI to fund highways projects

Life Corporation of India (LIC) will lend as much as ₹25,000 crore to National Highways Authority of India (NHAI) in the ongoing financial year to fund highway projects. NHAI plans to raise ₹75,000 crore from the markets in the 2019-20 financial year.

2. Corporation Bank ink pact with Bajaj Allianz

Corporation Bank has entered into a MoU with Bajaj Allianz General Insurance Co Ltd for providing insurance cover for accidental death to the specified saving bank account holders of the bank under the group personal accident insurance policy.

1. Edelweiss Tokio Life ties up with MobiKwik to offer insurance solutions

Edelweiss Tokio Life Insurance has tied up with MobiKwik to offer mobile-based group insurance solutions. Through the partnership, the company will offer life insurance in the variants of ₹1 Lakh, ₹3 Lakh & ₹5 Lakh via MobiKwik's wallet app & website.

2. Digit Insurance to enter health insurance segment

Private sector general insurer Digit Insurance will soon be entering the health insurance segment. The company that currently sells motor insurance, international travel insurance, home insurance and mobile insurance will sell medical policies as well.

Economy

News: Most Important

1. HDFC Bank de-listed GDRs from Luxembourg Stock Exchange

HDFC Bank announced that it has terminated and de-listed its global depository receipts (GDRs) from the Luxembourg Stock Exchange due to low trading volume. As many as 22 GDRs have been de-listed.

2. Govt cuts interest rate on General Provident Fund (GPF)

The interest rate on the general provident fund (GPF) has been cut by 10 basis points (bps) to 7.9 per cent from 8 per cent with effect from July 1. It was announced by the Ministry of Finance.

3. GST Council Lowers Tax Rate on Electric Vehicles to 5% from 12%

The Goods and Services Tax Council lowered tax on electric vehicles to 5 percent from 12 percent earlier. It also reduced the tax rate on the EV chargers or charging stations to 5 percent from 18 percent.

4. IMF cuts India's FY20 growth forecast by 30 bps to 7%

International Monetary Fund cut its annual growth forecast for India to 7% in the year ending 31 March 2020 and 7.2% for FY 2020-21. The downward revision of 0.3% point for both years reflects a weaker-than-expected outlook for domestic demand.

5. ADB cuts India's GDP growth forecast to 7% for 2019

As per Asian Development Bank's Asian Development Outlook report, India is expected to grow by 7% in 2019 (FY20) and 7.2% in 2020 (FY21), slightly slower than projected in April because the fiscal 2018 outturn fell short.

6. AIIB to provide \$100 million to L&T Infra for clean energy play

Asian Infrastructure Investment Bank will give a \$100-million loan to L&T Infrastructure Finance Company for wind and solar infrastructure projects in India. This is the first time AIIB is extending a loan to a non-banking finance company.



7. Inflation rises marginally to 3.18% in June

According to the data released by the Central Statistics Office, Retail inflation increased marginally to 3.18% in June due to the rise in food prices. The retail inflation based on the Consumer Price Index stood at 3.05% in May & 4.92% in June last year.

8. India lifted 271 mn people out of poverty between 2006 and 2016: UN

India lifted 271 million people out of poverty between 2006 & 2016, recording the fastest reductions in the multidimensional poverty index values during the period.

News: Others

1. India's current account balance deficit grew to \$68bn in 2018-19: IMF

According to the International Monetary Fund, India's current account balance deficit grew to \$68 billion in 2018-19 from \$49 billion. India's overall international reserves stood at \$411.9 billion at the end of March 2019.

2. IFCI aims to mobilise up to Rs 2,000 crore from sale of non-core assets

IFCI expects to mobilize ₹ 1500-2000 Cr from sale of non-core assets during the current FY to fund business growth. The company is looking at a recovery of bad loans under Insolvency & Bankruptcy Code. Currently, IFCI holds 2.4% stake in NSE & 4% in CCIL.

3. FDI inflow registered growth of 79% during last 6 years

Foreign Direct Investment inflow has increased to 64.38 bn USD in 2018-19, registering a growth of 79%. The intent is to make the FDI policy more investor-friendly & remove the policy bottlenecks that have been hindering investment inflow into the country.

4. India could lose 34 million jobs in 2030 due to global warming: ILO

A UN reports say India is projected to lose 5.8% of working hours in 2030 due to global warming, particularly impacting agriculture and construction sectors. India is expected to lose the equivalent of 34 million full-time jobs in 2030 in productivity.

News: Most Important

1. UP becomes No. 1 in implementation of Pradhanamntri Suraksha Bima Yojana

Uttar Pradesh has become No.1 in implementation of PM Suraksha Bima Yojana. 1.95 Cr people have been given insurance cover under the scheme till 31 Mar 2019. People can get accidental insurance cover of ₹ 2 L by paying a nominal premium of ₹ 12 annually.



2. Gujarat tops in solar rooftop installations

As per the data from central government, Gujarat has stood first in the country with total 261.97 MW of installed rooftop solar capacity. Maharashtra & Tamil Nadu have solar rooftop installations at 198.52 MW & 151.62 MW respectively.

3. In a first, Andhra Pradesh reserves 75 percent private jobs for locals

Andhra Pradesh became the first state to reserve 75% of jobs in private industrial units and factories for locals. The reservation would be implemented irrespective of whether the private entities get financial or any other help from the government.

4. Lucknow to host DefExpo India 2020

India's mega defence exhibition 'DefExpo' will be held for the first time at Lucknow in 2020. The main theme of the event will be **'India: The Emerging Defence Manufacturing Hub' and it will focus on 'Digital Transformation of Defence'.**

5. Chhattisgarh Gets India's 1st 'Garbage Cafe' For Ragpickers

India's first garbage cafe has launched in Ambikapur, Chhattisgarh. Under the program, any person fetching a kilo of plastic waste to the garbage cafe will be assured of full meal & for collecting at least 500 gm will benefit from a substantial breakfast.

6. Kerala to set up India's first space tech park in Thiruvananthapuram

The Kerala government will set up the country's first space tech park at Thiruvananthapuram's Knowledge City. The move is aimed at making the city a manufacturing hub for space-related technology.

7. WEF Centre, Telangana govt set to send medical supplies via drones

Telangana govt and the World Economic Forum's Centre for the Fourth Industrial Revolution Network are set to launch an innovative project to deliver emergency medical supplies such as blood and vaccines via drones.

8. World Bank, Centre and Kerala sign \$250-m loan pact

GoI, Kerala govt & World Bank signed a loan agreement of \$250 million for the First Resilient Kerala Programme to enhance the state's resilience against the impact of natural disasters and climate change.

9. BSE, Haryana govt sign pact to facilitate MSMEs raise capital

BSE has inked a pact with Haryana to encourage and support state's MSMEs to raise capital. By getting listed on the BSE's SME platform, the enterprises will get equity financing opportunities to grow their business from expansion to acquisition.

10. Arunachal CM launches state-wide tree plantation programme

Arunachal Pradesh CM Pema Khandu launched the state-wide tree plantation programme 'Clean-Green Arunachal Campaign 2019' in Itanagar. The campaign under the State Forest department will plant 1-lakh tree saplings in the next 24 hours.



11. TN CM announces formation of two new districts

Tamil Nadu Chief Minister Edappadi K Palaniswami announced the creation of two new districts carved out from Kanchipuram and Tirunelveli. This will take the total number of districts in the State to 35.

12. Meghalaya becomes 1st state to ensure water conservation

Meghalaya became the 1st state to ensure conservation of water & have water policy. The aim of policy is to spot water resources as common pool resource, to provide safe & hygienic water for drinking, sanitation & livelihood development to all residents.

13. APDCL opens online single window clearance system for Solar Rooftop installations

Assam Power Distribution Company Limited (APDCL) has come up with a single window clearance system for accelerating deployment of Grid Connected Solar Rooftop installations in Assam.

14. PepsiCo India to invest Rs 514 crore to set up snacks plant in Uttar Pradesh

Food and beverages major PepsiCo India is planning to invest Rs 514 crore over the next three years to set up a greenfield snacks manufacturing plant in Uttar Pradesh. PepsiCo is committed to growing its food and beverage business sustainably in India.

1. Odisha Secretariat renamed as 'Lok Seva Bhawan'

Odisha Chief Minister Naveen Patnaik announced that the Sachivalaya or Secretariat building in Bhubaneswar will now be called 'Lok Seva Bhavan'. The Odisha secretariat building was inaugurated on Nov 12, 1959, by Home Minister Govind Ballabh Pant.

2. Film Divisions to launch documentary film club in Mumbai

A documentary film club 'KSHITIJ' was launched by the Ministry of Information & Broadcasting in association with Indian Documentary Producer's Association (IDPA). The acclaimed documentary film 'Secret Life of Frogs' by Ajay & Vijay Bedi was screened.

3. Chandrakant Kavlekar to be Deputy CM of Goa

Chandrakant Kavlekar, is to be designated as Deputy Chief Minister of Goa. Michael Lobo,Chandrakant Kavlekar, Jeniffer Monserratte & Philip Neri Rodrigues were given portfolios as Goa Ministers.

4. Agri-Business Incubation Centre started in Chhattisgarh

An Agri-Business Incubation Centre has started in Chhattisgarh. It is set up under National Agriculture Development Scheme- RAFTAAR which aims to make farming a remunerative economic activity by strengthening farmer's effort & promoting agribusiness.



5. Pink City Jaipur enters UNESCO World Heritage Site list

Pink City Jaipur, known for its iconic architectural legacy and vibrant culture, has made its entry into the UNESCO World Heritage Site list. The decision was taken at the 43rd session of the World Heritage Committee of UNESCO at Baku in Azerbaijan

National

News: Most Important

1. India's 7th Economic Census begins from Tripura

India's seventh Economic Census began from Tripura and a similar task would be launched in other States and Union Territories across the country next month. The ITenabled economic census would be done by the Common Service Centres in each gram panchayat.

2. India has achieved its 2022 target of tiger population in the country

India now has 2,967 tigers & growth in the 4th cycle of the Tiger Census has been a 33%. PM Modi released All India Tiger Estimation Report 2018 emphasising that India has achieved the target of doubling tiger population 4 years before deadline. Madhya Pradesh saw the highest number of tigers at 526.

3. MoU signed to eradicate TB by 2025

Union Health Ministry has signed an MoU with Ministries of Ayush, Defence and Railways to strengthen the efforts towards a TB-Free India by 2025. Around 28 lakh people contract the disease every year in the country and four lakh people die every year.

4. Govt approves Rs 206.8 crore for Implementation of Agriculture Export Policy scheme

The government has approved an outlay of Rs 206.8 crore for 2019-19 for a central sector scheme titled 'Implementation of Agriculture Export Policy'. The policy seeks to double farm exports to \$60 billion by 2022.





5. 10th Jagran Film festival inaugurated in New Delhi

Prakash Javadekar inaugurated the 10th Jagran Film festival at Siri Fort Auditorium in New Delhi. JFF is an initiative towards creating a culture of cinema appreciation & creating a platform that connects great content with audiences across the country.

6. Central government launches 'LaQshya'

Government of India has launched 'LaQshya' (Labour room Quality improvement Initiative) to improve quality of care in labour room and maternity operation theatres in public health facilities. It's a multipronged approach focused at Intrapartum and immediate postpartum period.

7. Govt constitutes committee for regulation of medical devices

The Union health ministry has constituted a committee which will advise the Central Drugs Standard Control Organisation (CDSCO) regarding strengthening of medical devices regulations in the country and also examine issues relating to their implementation.

8. Govt sets target for installation of Solar projects of 40,000 MW by 2022

The government has set a target for the installation of Rooftop Solar projects of 40000 MegaWatt by 2022 in the country. The New and Renewable Energy Ministry is implementing Grid Connected Rooftop Solar programme.

9. GoM on sexual harassment at workplace reconstituted

Govt has reconstituted the GoM looking after the issues of how to prevent sexual harassment at workplace & strengthen legal frameworks with Amit Shah, replacing Rajnath Singh. Members are Nirmala Sitharaman, Ramesh Pokhriyal 'Nishank' & Smriti Irani.

10. Cabinet approves merger of National Institute of Miners' Health with ICMR-NIOH

Cabinet has approved the merger of National Institute of Miners' Health with ICMR -National Institute of Occupational Health. It would help them in terms of enhanced expertise in the field of occupational health besides efficient management of public money.

11. Lok Sabha passes Companies (Amendment) Bill

Lok Sabha gave its nod to the Companies (Amendment) Bill which seeks to tighten corporate social responsibility compliance and reduce the load of cases on the National Company Law Tribunal (NCLT).

12. Hyderabad airport launches Face Recognition system for entry on pilot basis

Rajiv Gandhi International Airport has initiated Face Recognition system on a trial basis for passengers for entry into the aerodrome by adding over 180 passengers enrolled voluntarily for the trials at the airport.



13. National Museum of Indian Cinema's news bulletin launched

A fortnightly bulletin of the National Museum of Indian Cinema, brought out by the Films Division, was launched, with veteran film maker Jahnu Barua hoping that it will become a platform for movie buffs and other stakeholders.

14. Reliance Jio Becomes India's Top Telecom Services Provider

Reliance Jio Infocomm Ltd. won more subscribers to become India's biggest telecom operator, as companies prepare for the planned rollout of a 5G network next year. Reliance Jio's subscriber base grew to 331.3 million in the quarter ended June.

15. Cabinet approves ISRO Technical Liaison Unit at Moscow

Cabinet has given nod to the setting up of ISRO Technical Liaison Unit (ITLU) at Moscow in Russia. ITLU will also support the ongoing bilateral programmes of cooperation in space technology and act on behalf of ISRO.

16. Motor Vehicles Bill gives govt power to regulate Uber, Ola

The Parliament approved amendments to the Motor Vehicles Bill, expected to give the Centre power to regulate app-based taxi-hailing services such as Ola & Uber. It aims to address issues such as road safety, reducing deaths due to road accidents, etc.

17. Nasscom, NSDC launch global Cloud computing challenge

To develop a sustainable workforce for disruptive technologies, IT industry's apex body Nasscom, is organising 'WorldSkills India's International Cloud Computing Challenge 2019' in partnership with the National Skill Development Corporation (NSDC).

18. Lok Sabha passes Consumer Protection Bill

Lok Sabha passed the Consumer Protection Bill that seeks to establish the Central Consumer Protection Authority (CCPA) to protect and enforce consumer rights. The CCPA will take immediate action after a complaint is filed by consumers.

News: Others

1. Inter-Ministerial Committee recommends ban on crypto currencies in India

An Inter-Ministerial Committee has recommended a ban on the cryptocurrencies in India & imposing fines and penalties for carrying on any activities connected with it. The panel was constituted in Nov 2017 to study the issues related to virtual currencies.

2. Cabinet approves Rs 1,600 cr for Dibang Multipurpose Project in Arunachal

The Cabinet has approved ₹ 1600 Cr for Dibang Project in Arunachal Pradesh. It is a storage-based hydro-electric project with flood moderation. Also, it approved the doubling of a railway line connecting Guwahati with New Bongaigaon at a cost of ₹ 2042 Cr.

3. HRD Minister releases UGC guide to student induction programme

HRD Minister Ramesh Pokhriyal Nishank released the UGC Guide to Student Induction Programme - Deeksharambh in New Delhi. The guide will help new students to build bonds with fellow students and faculty members in the new environment.



4. Amit Shah to head panel on Air India disinvestment

Government reconstituted a GoMs tasked with working out the modalities for sale of Air India. It will be headed by HM Amit Shah including FM Nirmala Sitharaman, commerce & railway minister Piyush Goyal & civil aviation minister Hardeep Singh Puri.

5. Public awareness campaign launched to accelerate vector control measures

A three-day public awareness campaign to accelerate vector control measures got underway in Delhi. A three-day public awareness campaign to accelerate vector control measures got underway in Delhi.

6. Northeast Frontier Railway zone introduces 'pink coaches' for women

Indian Railways' Northeast Frontier Railway zone has started a unique initiative to earmark a special portion of the SLR coach with pink colour which is done to specially help the women passengers with better safety and security.

7. Railways speeds up 261 trains & added 49 new trains

Railways has speeded up 261 trains as part of Mission Raftaar, by up to 110 minutes over different zones. New trains, which have already been introduced, have been added in new timetable including Vande Bharat Express train, 34 Humsafar Express among others.

8. Ola Electric races to unicorn status

Ola Electric Mobility Pvt. Ltd has raised about \$250 million from SoftBank Group Corp., thus becoming the second company founded by Bhavish Aggarwal to join the coveted unicorn club of start-ups valued at more than \$1 billion.

9. Railways to install CCTV cameras in over 7,000 train coaches by 2021: Govt

The railways have set a target to install CCTV cameras in more than 7,000 coaches of mainline passenger trains by March 2021. The cameras have also been installed in 1,300 coaches of mainline passenger trains.

International

News: Most Important

1. Boris Johnson take over as Prime Minister of Britain

Boris Johnson took over as Prime Minister of Britain. He succeeded Theresa May who resigned recently. He is expected to use the opportunity to increase the number of women in full cabinet positions and boost the representation of ethnic minorities.

2. European Commission elects first female president

German Defence Minister Ursula von der Leyen has been elected as the European Commission's first female president. She will replace Jean-Claude Juncker. Her nomination was approved by 383 votes, 9 votes more than required to secure an absolute majority.



3. Russia launched a space telescope in Kazakhstan

Russia launched a space telescope from the cosmodrome in Baikonur, Kazakhstan, in a joint mission with Germany. A video posted on the website of Roskosmos, showed a Proton-M rocket carrying the Spektr-RG taking off from Baikonur.

4. Indian origin Priti Patel appointed as Britain's Home Secretary

British PM Boris Johnson has appointed Indian origin Priti Patel as Home Secretary. She had been a member of the 'Back Boris' campaign for the Conservative Party leadership. Former Home Secretary Sajid Javid appointed as the Finance Secretary/Chancellor.

5. Vikas Swarup has been appointed as Secretary, Overseas Indian Affairs

Swarup, a 1986-batch officer of the IFS, is at present India's High Commissioner in Ottawa. He has been appointed as the Secretary, (consular, passport, visa and Overseas Indian affairs) in the External Affairs Ministry.

6. Google India's 'Internet Saathi' programme to empower rural women

Google India's 'Internet Saathi' programme aimed to empower rural women on how to use the Internet has added two more states -- Punjab & Odisha. The programme launched as a pilot project in 2015, along with Tata Trusts. It focuses on educating women on how to use the Internet.

7. London named world's best student city in new rankings

London has been named as the world's best city for students for the 2nd consecutive year, beating international cities like Tokyo & Melbourne that came 2nd & 3rd respectively. The 'QS Best Student Cities Ranking' compiled by QS Quacquarelli Symonds.

8. IFC to invest \$200 million in Shriram Transport Finance to fund CV purchases

International Finance Corporation (IFC), a member of the World Bank Group, will channel \$200 million into Shriram Transport Finance to primarily fund purchases of commercial vehicles and support micro, small, and medium enterprises (MSMEs).

9. UK's Go Global programme expansion to boost Indian start-ups

The UK government has expanded its Go Global initiative to India with the aim of giving the country's most innovative and cutting-edge start-ups the skills. India build links with the UK's digital sector and pave the way for future economic partnerships.

10. New Zealand bans single-use plastic bags

New Zealand has banned single-use plastic shopping bags & introducing hefty fines for businesses that continue to provide them. Plastic pollution is a growing global concern, with a million birds & 100,000 plus marine mammals injured or killed every year.

11. French lawmakers approve 3% tax on online giants

French parliament approved a small, pioneering tax on internet giants like Google, Amazon and Facebook & hopes that other countries will follow the suit. The bill foresees a 3% tax on the French revenues of digital companies with revenue of 750 mn+ Euros.



12. Duty Free shops at Dubai airports to accept Indian currency

The Indian Rupee will now be accepted for transaction at all airports in Dubai. The Indian currency is now acceptable at all three terminals of the Dubai International Airport and at Al Maktoum Airport.

13. Kyriakos Mitsotakis sworn in as Greece's new prime minister

Kyriakos Mitsotakis has been sworn in as Greece's new PM, after New Democracy party won a landslide over leftist Syriza. Results showed New Democracy gaining 39.85% of the vote in snap election.

14. ISA's First Joint Security Exercise named 'ISALEX19' held in Abu Dhabi

The first edition of the joint security exercise of International Security Alliance (ISA), ISALEX19 held in Abu Dhabi, UAE. ISA was launched in 2017 & comprises 9 countries, UAE, France, Italy, Bahrain, Morocco, Spain, Senegal, Singapore & the Slovak Republic.

15. Japan officially resumes commercial whaling after more than 30 years

Japan resumed commercial whaling for the 1st time in more than 3 decades after Tokyo's controversial decision to withdraw from the International Whaling Commission. With this, Japan joined Iceland & Norway as the only nations to allow commercial whaling despite the IWC moratorium.

16. WHO launches its first guidelines on self-care interventions for health

World Health Organization has introduced its first guideline on self-care interventions for health named "WHO Consolidated Guideline on Self-Care Interventions for Health". Its first volume has focused on sexual and reproductive health and rights.

17. World's largest burn and plastic surgery institute inaugurated in Dhaka,

Bangladesh

World's largest burn and plastic surgery institute named Sheikh Hasina National Burn & Plastic Surgery Institute started its functioning in Dhaka, Bangladesh. It will provide advanced treatment to burn patients. It was built at a cost of over 500 crores Taka.

18. Nigeria to host 2020 FIFA women U-20 World cup

Federation of International Football Federation has awarded FIFA Women Under 20 World Cup hosting right to Nigeria after 10 years in 2020. The last FIFA event held in Nigeria was the 2009 FIFA U-17 World Cup.

19. Ancient Babylon city named a World Heritage Site

Ancient Mesopotamian city of Babylon has been declared a Unesco World Heritage Site. Iraq has been lobbying since 1983 for the 4,000-year-old site to be added to the UN's prestigious list. The city was famous for its Hanging Gardens.

1. Apple buys Intel's smartphone modem unit for \$1 billion

Apple Inc took a major step toward supplying its own smartphone chips by purchasing the majority of Intel Corp's modem business in a deal valued at \$1 billion. It is Apple's second-largest ever after its \$3.2 billion purchase of Beats Electronics in 2014.

2. SoftBank plans to launch second Vision Fund with \$108bn

SoftBank Group announced will launch its second Vision Fund with participation from Apple, Foxconn, Microsoft and other tech companies and investors. Called the Vision Fund 2, the fund will focus on AI-based technology.

3. Japan's space probe first to capture material beneath asteroid surface

Japan's Hayabusa2 spacecraft has become the first ever space probe to gather material from beneath the surface of an asteroid. The asteroid mission first reached Ryugu in June 2018 & its first touchdown on the surface in February 2019.

4. WHO declares Sri Lanka a 'measles-free' nation

WHO declared that measles disease has been eradicated in Sri Lanka. The country's success demonstrates its commitment, and the determination of its health workforce & parents to protect children against measles.

5. Tropical Storm Barry hits Louisiana in US

In the US, Tropical Storm Barry began hitting Louisiana with wind and rain, building towards hurricane strength. Utility repair crews with bucket trucks have been moved into position in the region.

1. India, Mozambique sign two MoU in field of Hydrography

India & Mozambique have signed two Memoranda of Understanding on sharing white shipping information & co-operation in the field of Hydrography. The agreement will further strengthen the ongoing Indo-Mozambican Defence co-operation and their relations.

2. Sri Lanka signs agreement with India to upgrade railway lines

Sri Lanka has signed an agreement with India to upgrade tracks in a key railway segment connecting the north and south at a cost of \$ 91.26 million. It is the first that the 130 km-long-tracks, running from Maho town to Omanthai, are being upgraded.

3. India, Italy to set up fast-track mechanism to facilitate investment

India & Italy have decided to set up a fast track mechanism to facilitate investors & companies. The main aim of the system in India will be to pave the way to identify & solve problems faced by Italian companies & investors with their operations in India.



4. Argentina extends assistance to boost India's agricultural productivity

Argentina within the strategic partnership with India, has decided to be a partner for the development of the agricultural sector in India and further cooperate in this sector through technological exchanges that can boost the productivity.

5. India, Russia sign Rs 1,500 crore deal for air-to-air missiles to be used by Su-30

India has signed a deal worth around ₹ 1500 Cr to acquire R-27 air-to-air missiles from Russia to be equipped on the Su-30MKI combat aircraft. They have been acquired under 10-I projects which mandate the 3 services to maintain critical weapon systems.

6. Ola gets green light for London taxi business

India's ride-hailing platform Ola Cabs, run by ANI Technologies Pvt. Ltd, has received approval from London's transport regulator to start PHV in London. Ola UK Pvt. Ltd has received a 1-yr carriage licence from TFL to operate PHV vehicles across London.

7. India has handed over 250 prefabricated houses to Myanmar

India had taken up the project under its Rakhine State Development Programme under which 25 mn \$ are allocated for a period of 5 years. 22 other proposals which include solar power related projects are under consideration.

8. India, Myanmar sign MoU on defence co-operation

India and Myanmar inked a Memorandum of Understanding on defence cooperation aimed at enhancing military.

9. India, Benin sign 4 MoU on export credit

India and Benin signed 4 MoUs on Cooperation in the field of Export Credit and Investment Insurance, e-VBAB network project, Cultural Exchange Programme and visa requirement for holders of diplomatic, official/service passports.

1. Israel inks USD 50 mn deal with India to supply complementary Naval MRSAM systems

Israel Aerospace Industries has inked a deal worth USD 50 million to supply complementary Naval MRSAM systems to the Indian Navy and the Mazagon Dock Shipbuilders. The IAI would provide complementary systems for the air defence system (ADS).

2. India, Uzbekistan agree on effective information sharing mechanism to counter terror

India and Uzbekistan decided to expand counter terror partnership and strengthen information sharing and capacity building mechanism against the menace. The 8th meeting of India-Uzbekistan Joint Working Group on Counter Terrorism was held in New Delhi.

1. India jumps 5 places to 52nd rank in global innovation index 2019

India improved its ranking in the global innovation index by five places to 52nd in 2019. The GII rankings are published by Cornell University, INSEAD and the WIPO and GII Knowledge Partners. Switzerland retained its number-one spot on the index. 2019 theme of index is Evaluating the Medical Innovation Scenario of the Next Decade.

2. Bengaluru tops list of most digitised cities, reports highest card payments

Bengaluru has topped the list of 'most digitised cities' accounting for highest card payments in a study conducted by Razorpay. The top five digitised states as per the report are Karnataka, Maharashtra, Tamil Nadu, Andhra Pradesh and New Delhi.

3. India's renewable energy cost lowest in Asia Pacific: report

According to the report by Wood Mackenzie, India's renewable energy cost is the lowest in the Asia Pacific. The levelised cost of electricity (LCOE) using solar photovoltaic has fallen to \$38 per MWh. It was 14% cheaper than coal-fired power.

4. Bhubaneswar most affordable city for homebuyers: RBI survey

According to a report by the Reserve Bank India, Bhubaneswar remains the most affordable city for homebuyers, while Mumbai remains the least affordable one in India. RBI has been conducting a quarterly residential asset price monitoring survey (RAPMS).



5. Money in Swiss banks: India ranked 74

India has moved down one place to 74th rank in terms of money parked by its citizens and enterprises with Swiss banks while the U.K. has retained its top position, as per data released by the central banking authority of Switzerland.

6. NITI Aayog launched Agricultural Marketing and Farmer Friendly Reforms Index 2019

NITI Aayog released its "Agricultural Marketing and Farmer Friendly Reforms Index"2019. It ranks states and UTs based on the implementation of seven provisions proposed under the model Agricultural Produce Market Committee Act. Maharashtra was ranked first for implementing most of the marketing reforms

1. Indian cities contribute between 59% & 70% of India's GDP: IDFC report

IDFC institute, a think-tank, Indian cities are more urban than recognised and contribute between 59% and 70% of India's gross domestic product. The report pegs India's urbanisation rate to be anywhere between 47% and 65%.

2. Japan and Singapore top the 2019 Henley Index list of world's most powerful passports

The Henley Passport Index is based on data provided by IATA and covers 199 passports and 227 travel destinations. Japan and Singapore have held onto their position as the world's most travel-friendly passports, with South Korea dropping into second place.

3. Overall Homicide Rate Declines by 10% in India: UN Report

Acc. to a UN report, the overall homicide rate in India has decreased by 10% over a period of six years till 2015 but the trend increased "noticeably" in some northern states.

4. 75% of children with disabilities don't attend schools in India: UNESCO

The 2019 "State of the Education Report for India: Children with Disabilities" took into account the 2011 census. 3/4th of the children with disabilities at the age of 5 years and 1/4th between 5-19 years do not go to any educational institution.

1. Veer Chotrani wins U-19 Asian Squash title

In Squash, India's Veer Chotrani beat Yash Fadte to win the Under-19 title at the Asian Junior Championship in Macau, China. He became the third Indian to win the Asian trophy after Ravi Dixit and Vela Senthilkumar.

2. Sai Praneeth enters top 20 in World Badminton Rankings

B. Sai Praneeth has jumped 4 places to enter in the top 20 players in the latest World Badminton Rankings. He is now World No.19 in Men's Singles badminton ranking. Kidambi Srikanth & Sameer Verma retained his 10th & 13th position respectively.

3. Indian pro boxer Vaibhav Yadav wins WBC Asia title

Indian pro boxer Vaibhav Yadav became the World Boxing Council (WBC) Asia silver welterweight champion after defeating Thailand's Fahpetch Singmanassak in the title bout held in Pattaya, Thailand.



4. Max Verstappen wins Austrian Grand Prix 2019

In Formulae 1 Austrian Grand Prix 2019, Red Bull's Red Bull's Max Verstappen won the race while Ferrari's Charles Leclerc was placed second and Mercedes' V. Bottas stood at the 3rd position.

5. Poznan Athletics Grand Prix: Hima Das wins Gold in women's 200 metres

Indian sprinter Hima Das won the women's 200m gold in the Poznan Athletics Grand Prix in Poland. It was Hima's first competitive 200m race of the year. Also, Short putter Tajinder Pal Singh Toor bagged a bronze.

6. Mexico beats US to lift 8th Gold Cup

Mexico's men's soccer team have won their record eighth Gold Cup by defeating the United States in the final. The loss for the US men came hours after the women's team lifted its second consecutive World Cup title.

7. 4th World Wealth Yoga Championship: Para-athlete Toran Yadav wins 3 silver medals

Para-athlete Toran Yadav from Chhattisgarh has won 3 silver medals at 4th World Wealth Yoga Festival & Championship in Europe. The 19-year-old started yoga at the age of 9 and soon was selected to represent India.

8. Mirabai claims another gold

S. Mirabai Chanu totalled 191kg to claim the women's 49kg title in the Commonwealth weightlifting championships. Jhili Dalabehera & S. Bindyarani Devi among women and Ch. Rishikanta Singh among men were the other Indians to win golds in the elite division.

9. Dutee Chand wins 100m gold at World University Games

Ace Indian sprinter Dutee Chand has won the gold medal in women's 100-metre sprint at the 30th Summer University Games in Napoli, Italy becoming the first Indian to win do so. She clocked 11.32s in the final.

10. *G. Sathiyan, Anthony Amalraj win bronze at World Tour Platinum Australian Open*

In Table Tennis, the Indian pair of G. Sathiyan and Anthony Amalraj won the bronze at the World Tour Platinum Australian Open after they lost to top seed Korean pair of Jeoung Youngsik and Lee Sangsu in Geelong near Melbourne.

11. Ellyse Perry becomes first cricketer to reach 1000 runs, 100 wickets in T20Is

Australia all-rounder Ellyse Perry became the first cricketer of either gender to reach the rare milestone of scoring 1000 runs &taking 100 wickets in the T20 format. Bangladesh's Shakib al Hasan (1471 runs & 88 wickets) stands next in line to join Perry.

12. Hima Das wins gold in Tabor Athletics Meet

Indian sprinter Hima Das clinched her fourth gold in a fortnight as she won the 200m race with a creditable timing of 23.25 seconds in the Tabor Athletics Meet in Czech Republic. In men's 400m, Muhammad Anas won in 45.40 seconds.



13. Sarabjot Singh wins India's ninth gold in ISSF Junior World Cup

India's Sarabjot Singh shot a 239.6 to bag the men's 10 metres air pistol gold. 14-yearold Esha Singh also won a silver in the women's 10 m air pistol event. India remains on top of the medal standings with 9 gold, 9 silver & 4 bronze medals.

14. Vinesh Phogat wins gold at Yasar Dogu International

Vinesh Phogat won her second consecutive gold in 53kg, winning the Yasar Dogu International in Istanbul. She defeated Russia's Ekaterina Poleshchuk. It was the third gold in the women's competition for India.

15. Amir khan wins WBC international welterweight title

Amir Khan clinched the WBC international welterweight title after knocking out Australian Billy Dib in the fourth round. He was knocked out by WBO welterweight champion Terence Crawford in his last bout in April.

16. Hima Das wins 5th gold of the month after successful return to 400m

Hima Das won the gold medal in the final of the women's 400m at the IAAF World U20 Championships in Tampere, Finland. It was Hima's fifth gold medal in July.

17. Mary Kom, Simranjit Kaur win gold in President's Cup Boxing Tournament

6-time world champion Mary Kom in 51kg category and Simranjit Kaur in 60kg category grabbed a gold each in 23rd President's Cup Boxing Tournament in Labuan Bajo, Indonesia. Indian boxers finished their campaign in the Tournament with nine medals.

18. India drops two places in FIFA rankings

Indian football team slipped 2 places to 103rd in the FIFA rankings. The team lies at 18th among Asian countries. Iran (23) is at the top among Asian countries, followed by Japan (33). Belgium leads the chart, followed by Brazil, France, England & Uruguay.





19. Table Tennis: India tops medal tally with seven gold at Commonwealth C'ships

India topped the medal tally with 7 gold, 5 silver & 3 bronze medals at the 21st Commonwealth Championships, Cuttack. Harmeet Desai& Ayhika Mukherjee won the men's & women's singles titles. Anthony Amalraj & Manav Thakkar claimed the men's doubles gold.

20. John Isner Makes History with Fourth Newport Title

John Isner of the United States has become the first player to win four titles in Newport. He defeated seventh-seeded Kazakh Alexander Bublik in the final. It was his first ATP tour title of the year.

21. P V Sindhu loses to Akane Yamaguchi in Indonesia Open final

In Badminton, P V Sindhu was defeated by Akane Yamaguchi in the finals of Indonesia Open BWF Tour Super 1000 tournament in Jakarta. Taiwan's shuttler Chou Tien-Chen won the men's singles title after defeating Denmark's Anders Antonsen.

22. Shiva Thapa becomes India's first gold-medallist in Kazakhstan President's Cup

Four-time Asian medallist Shiva Thapa became India's first gold-medallist in the new 63kg category at the President's Cup boxing tournament in Astana, Kazakhstan. Sweety Boora (81kg) and Duryodhan Singh Negi (69kg) ended the tournament with a bronze.

23. Shooting Junior World Cup: Aishwarya Pratap Singh clinches gold in rifle 3position event

In the Shooting Junior World Cup, Aishwarya Pratap Singh Tomar clinched gold with a junior world record in the final of rifle 3-position event in Suhl Germany. He defeated Zalan Pekler of Hungary for the gold.

24. Max Verstappen clinches German Grand Prix

Red Bull's driver Max Verstappen clinched the rain-hit German Grand Prix at Hockenheim while Ferrari driver Sebastian Vettel claimed the second spot and Russian Daniil Kvyat achieved the third spot for Toro Rosso.

25. Lifter Ajay Singh wins gold at Commonwealth Championships

Ajay Singh has won Gold in 81 kg category at Commonwealth Championships in Apia, city of Samoa. Papul Changmai clinched the silver medal by lifting a total of 313kgs in the same event. P Anuradha lifted 221kg to grab the 1st place in men's 87kg category.

26. A 10-year old Karate Girl, Arinjeeta Dey wins a silver medal for India in World Youth Cup 2019

A 10-year old Karate girl, Arinjeeta Dey (Barasat, West Bengal) has won a silver medal in the under 12 age categories in the World Youth Cup 2019 which was held in Umag, Croatia (from July 1 to July 5, 2019).



27. Former athlete PT Usha nominated for IAAF's Veteran Pin

PT Usha has been nominated for the International Association of Athletics Federation's 'Veteran Pin' for her outstanding service to the sport. She won 5 gold medals and a bronze medal in the Asian Games which were held at Jakarta in 1985.

28. Novak Djokovic beats Roger Federer in five sets to win Wimbledon

Novak Djokovic beat Roger Federer 7-6(5), 1-6, 7-6(4), 4-6, 13-12(3) to lift his fifth Wimbledon Men's title. Simona Halep won her second Grand Slam singles title, defeating Serena Williams in the final, 6-2, 6-2.

29. England defeats New Zealand in astonishing Cricket World Cup final

England became only the 3rd team after India and Australia to win the World Cup on their home soil defeating New Zealand in final. England reached the final of the World Cup for the first time since 1992.

30. Abhay, Tanvi win Bengal Open squash titles

Abhay Singh of Tamil Nadu and Asian Games medallist Tanvi Khanna clinched the men's and women's titles respectively in the sixth Bengal Open squash tournament in Kolkata. Singh defeated Abhishek Pradhan while Tanvi defeated TN's Aparajitha Balamurukan.

31. ICC suspends Zimbabwe Cricket with immediate effect

ICC has suspended Zimbabwe Cricket with immediate effect over violation of global body's constitution which doesn't allow any government intervention. Croatia, Morocco & Zambia Cricket Union have also been suspended for continuing to be non-compliant.

32. Lewis Hamilton wins record sixth British Grand Prix after Sebastian Vettel crash

Mercedes driver Lewis Hamilton beat his teammate Valtteri Bottas to take another win of the season. In fact, this is Hamilton's 6th win at Silverstone as he edges further towards the world title with a lead of 39 points.

33. Vijayveer wins his 3rd gold at Junior Shooting World Cup

Vijayveer Sidhu won the gold medal at the ISSF Junior World Cup in Suhl, Germany, combining with Rajkanwar Singh Sandhu and Adarsh Singh in the men's 25m pistol event. India maintained its top spot at the medal standings with 7 gold medals.

11. Former Delhi CM Sheila Dikshit passed away

15. Former Chinese premier known as 'Butcher of Beijing' dies aged 90

Former Chinese Premier Li Peng has died at the age of 90. He was best known as the 'Butcher of Beijing' for his role in the Tiananmen Square crackdown on pro-democracy protesters in 1989. He was the first Premier of the People's Republic of China.

16. 'Blade Runner' actor Rutger Hauer passes away at 75

Dutch actor Rutger Hauer, who specialized in menacing roles, including a memorable turn as a murderous android in 'Blade Runner' opposite Harrison Ford, has died. He was 75. He won a supporting-actor Golden Globe award in 1988 for 'Escape from Sobibor.'

News: Most Important

1. Gaganyaan: ISRO teams up with Russian company to train Indian astronauts

ISRO has signed a contract with a Russian company Glavkosmos for selection support, medical examination & space training of Indian astronauts for the country's proposed maiden manned space mission 'Gaganyaan'.

2. India signs ₹200 crore anti-tank missile deal with Russia

India signed a deal to acquire Strum Ataka anti-tank missile from Russia for its fleet of Mi-35 attack choppers. Deal for missiles is around ₹200 cr in order to give an added capability to the Mi-35 attack choppers to take out enemy tanks/armoured element.

3. Indian Army to buy American howitzer ammo for long-range accurate strikes

To acquire the capability to hit enemy positions close to populated areas without causing collateral damage, the Indian Army is in the process of acquiring Excalibur guided long-range artillery ammunition which can strike targets more than 50 km away.

4. Two new heavy-lift Chinook helicopters for IAF arrive in Gujarat

Boeing announced the arrival of two new heavy-lift Chinook helicopters for the IAF at the Mundra port in Gujarat. It has been battle-tested in diverse, extreme conditions throughout the world, and can operate in a wide range of Indian conditions.

5. INS Tarkash reaches Morocco for overseas development programme

To establish India's credentials as a net security provider in the Indo-Pacific region, INS Tarkash reached Tangier in Morocco, for a 3-day visit. It is part of an ongoing overseas deployment by the Indian Navy to the Mediterranean Sea, Africa and Europe.

6. DRDO conducted 3 tests of Nag Missile in a day in Pokhran, Rajasthan

The Defence Research and Development Organisation (DRDO) successfully carried out 3 successful test firings of Nag missiles in one day (day & night) in Pokhran, Rajasthan. It is in the final stage to be inducted in the Indian Army.



7. *INS Tarkash reached Tangier in Morocco as part of a visit for overseas development programme*

INS Tarkash reached at Tangier in Morocco as part of a visit for overseas development programme. It seeks to strengthen the bonds of friendship between India and Morocco.

8. Indian Airforce receives four Apache helicopters

According to US Aerospace company Boeing the first four of 22 AH-64E Apaches helicopters ordered by India had been received by the Indian Air Force at the Hindon Station near New Delhi. An additional four Apaches will arrive in the coming week.

9. India's first space war drill, IndSpaceEx, kickstarts

The Indian armed forces conduct the country's first-ever stimulated space warfare exercise named 'IndSpaceEx'. It aims to assess 'imminent threats' to the nation beyond earth. It also plans on drafting a joint space doctrine for future battles.

10. World Media hails India's successful launch of Chandrayaan - 2

International Media have hailed India's successful launch of its 2nd moon mission Chandrayaan-2. It aims to become the 1st mission to conduct a surface landing on the lunar south pole region, where it will collect crucial info about the moon's composition.

1. Russia Launches Soyuz Carrier Rocket with 33 Satellites from Vostochny Spaceport

Russia successfully launched its Soyuz-2.1a carrier rocket with a hydrometeorological satellite and 32 small satellites. The rocket blasted off at 8.41 a.m. (local time) from the Vostochny spaceport in the Far Eastern Amur Region.

2. Kalyani JV gets missile kits order for \$100mn

News: Most Important

1. New gene linked to schizophrenia discovered by Indian and Australian scientists

Scientists from the University of Queensland in Australia and a team of Indian researchers led by R Thara, have discovered a new gene directly linked to schizophrenia. They identified a gene called NAPRT1 which encodes an enzyme involved in vitamin B3 metabolism.

2. A new human atlas initiative named 'Manav' launched for holistic understanding of human biology

Manav, a new human atlas initiative has been launched by the Department of Biotechnology (DBT) and Persistent Systems, a biotechnology company towards improving knowledge on human biology. DBT has invested ₹ 13 Crore shared between two institutions NCCS & IISER.

3. IIT Madras students develop 'Agricopter' to eliminate manual spraying of pesticides

IIT Madras have developed a 'smart agricopter' to eliminate manual spraying of pesticides in agricultural fields & help identify crop health by using an imaging camera. It will be allowing spraying pesticides 10 times faster with 100% precision.

4. Plastic-like Jute material developed in Bangladesh

Scientists in Bangladesh have developed a method to convert Jute fibre into low cost biodegradable cellulose sheets named Sonali . It can be used in garments & food packaging work & they are not harmful for human health.

5. IIT Hyderabad develops low-cost, eco-friendly solar cells

Scientists at IIT Hyderabad have developed low-cost, environment-friendly solar cells by employing an off-the-shelf dye used to make Kumkum/vermilion in India. A dye-sensitized solar cell is based on New Fuchsin dye with an aqueous electrolyte.

1. Rajghat coal plant to be turned into solar park

The Delhi govt. announced that a solar park — of 5,000 KW capacity — will come up in place of the defunct Rajghat thermal power plant. Acc. to Delhi Power Minister Satyendar Jain , a waste-to-energy plant will replace the coal-fired power plant.

2. NASA's PUNCH mission has selected Indian Scientist Dipankar Banerjee as its co-investigator

Dipankar Banerjee has been selected by NASA (National Aeronautics and Space Administration) for its PUNCH mission. PUNCH is an acronym for "Polarimeter to Unify the Corona and Heliosphere'. The objective is to understand the transition of particles from the Sun's outer corona to the solar wind that fills interplanetary space.

1. India's first elephant rehabilitation centre in the works at Kerala's Kottoor

The Kerala govt. is working to set up the country's 1st elephant rehabilitation centre in Kottoor, an ecotourism village near the state capital Thiruvananthapuram. The 1st phase of the Rs 105 crore-project was launched last month by CM Pinarayi Vijayan.

2. Six Indian metros are hotspots of air pollutant nitrogen oxide: Greenpeace

Acc. to the analysis by Greenpeace India, Delhi, Bengaluru, Mumbai, Kolkata, Chennai and Hyderabad are the hotspots of the country's worst air pollutant Nitrogen Oxide (NOx). The cities have high vehicular population and diesel consumption.

3. IIT Kharagpur researchers develop process to manage wet municipal solid waste

Researchers from IIT Kharagpur has adopted a process called Hydro-Thermal Carbonization for the Indian conditions which can effectively manage mixed MSW with high moisture content. The mixed MSW can be converted into biofuel, soil amendment & absorbents.
