Banking & Finance

1. ADB approves USD 125 million loan for water supply, sanitation projects in Uttarakhand

The Asian Development Bank (ADB) has approved a loan of USD 125 million (around Rs 938 crore) for water supply and sanitation projects in Uttarakhand.

The funds will be utilised to improve access to quality water supply and sanitation services in the Himalayan state.

Under this project, 136 kilometres of water pipe system will be constructed. Uttarakhand CM:-Pushkar Singh Dhami; Governor:- Gurmit Singh.

2. RBI imposes Rs2 cr penalty on two Payment System Operators for regulatory violation

The RBI fined Tata Communications Payment Solutions (TCPSL) Rs 2 crore and Appnit Technologies Pvt Ltd (ATPL) Rs 54.93 lakh for failing to comply with orders given under the Payment and Settlement Systems Act, 2007. (PSS Act).

These were offences of the type specified in Section 26(6) of the PSS Act, notices were sent to the entities.

3. Airtel Payments Bank names Pinak Chakraborty as new Chief Information Officer

Airtel Payments Bank has appointed Pinak Chakraborty as its new Chief Information Officer. He will be leading Airtel Payments Bank's overall technology strategy & be responsible for digital innovation and transformation of products and services.

Prior to joining the Bank, he was heading product engineering for PayMaya, a fintech based out of the Philippines. Airtel payment bank: - MD & CEO: - Anubrata Biswas; COO : - Ganesh Ananthanarayanan.

4. RBI imposes Rs. 1 crore penalty on Union Bank of India

The RBI has imposed a monetary penalty of Rs.1 cr on the Union Bank of India for violating certain provisions related to the sale of stressed assets and reporting of frauds.

This action is based on the deficiencies in regulatory compliance & is not intended to pronounce upon the validity of any transaction or agreement entered into by the bank with its customers.

5. RBI new norms likely to increase NBFCs bad loans by one-third

The RBI's clarification on non-performing advances (NPAs) accounting is likely to increase NPAs by around one-third for non-banking finance companies as per domestic rating agency India Ratings and Research

impact on provisioning could be modest, given NBFCs are using Indian Accounting Standards & generally for higher rated NBFCs, provision policy is more conservative

6. IDFC FIRST Bank debuts India's first standalone metal debit card

IDFC FIRST Bank announced the launch of FIRST Private Infinite, the country's first-ever standalone metal debit card, in partnership with Visa.

FIRST Private Infinite is a lifetime free card designed specifically for customers who are part of the Bank's FIRST Private program, a premium savings and wealth offering. CEO: V. Vaidyanathan Headquarters: Mumbai

7. PNB launches android app for differently-abled employees

Punjab National Bank (PNB) has launched PNB Pride-CRMD module tool, an android-based application for differently-abled employees, to monitor and effectively follow up with the special mention account (SMA) borrowers.

SMA accounts are stressed loans recognized early, enabling banks to initiate timely remedial actions, and preventing such borrowers from slipping to NPA. NPA:- Non performing Assets.



8. ICICI Bank offers instant overdraft facility to sellers registered on Flipkart

ICICI Bank has partnered with Flipkart to offer an instant and completely digital overdraft (OD) facility of up to '25 L to individual sellers & businesses registered on the e-commerce platform.

Enabled by API integration, the partnership helps sellers to avail an OD from the Bank instantly in a process from application to sanction to disbursement, that is entirely digital.

9. In pact with NPCI, CUB launches 'On-the-Go' wearable keychain for debit card customers

City Union Bank (CUB), in collaboration with National Payments Corporation of India (NPCI) and its manufacturing partner Seshaasai, has announced the launch of RuPay On-the-Go contactless wearable keychain for its debit card customers.

Currently, the keychain will be linked to the operative account of the customers. N Kamakodi, MD & CEO, City Union Bank.

10. RBI Monetary Policy: Repo rate unchanged at 4% for the 9th consecutive time

The Reserve Bank of India's (RBI) Monetary Policy Committee (MPC) kept the repo rate unchanged at 4 per cent for the ninth consecutive time while maintaining an 'accommodative stance' as long as necessary.

The reverse repo rate too was kept unchanged at 3.35 percent.

The Marginal Standing Facility (MSF) rate and bank rate also remained unchanged at 4.25 percent.

11. Number of ATMs in country at over 2.13 lakh, says Finance Ministry

The number of ATMs across the country stood at over 2.13 lakh by the end of September this year, and over 47 per cent of these are in rural and semi-urban areas.

According to the RBI data, scheduled commercial banks have installed 2,13,145 ATMs (automated teller machines) up to September 2021. In addition to this, 27,837 White Label ATMs (WLA) were also installed.

12. UPI-based payment products to be launched for feature phone users: RBI

The RBI governor Shaktikanta Das announced that UPI-based payment products will be launched for feature phone users. Also enhanced the transaction limit to Rs. 5L from Rs. 2 L for UPI payments for RBI's Retail Direct scheme & IPO offering applications. RBI's Retail Direct scheme facilitates investment by individuals into government securities by opening gilt securities.

13. Paytm Payments Bank receives Scheduled Bank status from RBI

Paytm Payments Bank Limited , an associate entity of Paytm, has received Scheduled Bank status from RBI and has been included in the 2nd Schedule to the Reserve Bank of India Act, 1934.

As per RBI Act 1934, banks satisfying the central bank that its affairs are not being conducted in a manner detrimental to the interests of its depositors are included in the 2nd schedule. Satish Kumar Gupta, MD & CEO of Paytm Payments Bank Ltd.

14. RBI grants approval to LIC to up stake in IndusInd Bank to nearly 10%

Private bank IndusInd Bank announced that the RBI has given approval to Life Insurance Corporation to increase stake in the bank to nearly 10%. The RBI approval is subject to compliance with the direction on 'Prior Approval for Acquisition of Shares and Voting Private Sector Banks' as well as regulations of the Sebi and any guidelines or regulations. LIC holds 4.95% of the total issued and paid-up capital of the bank.

15. SEBI extended the deadline till April 1, 2022 for implementing the risk management framework for mutual funds.

SEBI extended the deadline till April 1 next year for implementing the risk management framework for mutual funds as well as the two-tier structure for benchmarking of certain categories of schemes. Meanwhile, the watchdog has come out with guidelines on the usage of



pool accounts by mutual funds as well as norms for investment in the Bills Re Discounting Scheme (BRDS). The implementation was to come into force from January 1, 2022.

16. RBI enforces 20-digit LEI for cross-border deals above Rs 50 crore

The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) made Legal Entity Identifier (LEI) mandatory for cross-border transactions for capital or current account transactions of Rs 50 crore and above, from October 1 next year.

The LEI is a 20-digit number used to uniquely identify parties to financial transactions worldwide to improve the quality and accuracy of financial data systems.

17. Karnataka Bank bags two DigiDhan award from MeitY

Karnataka Bank has been conferred with two DigiDhan awards instituted by the Union Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology. The bank received these awards for achieving the target with the highest percentage in BHIM-UPI transactions under the private sector bank category consecutively for two years ' 2019-20 and 2020-21.

18. India Post Payments Bank enables recurring payments via NPCI Bharat Bill Pay platform

IPPB and NPCI Bharat BillPay announced the facilitation of doorstep cash-based assisted bill payments across India. The platform will enable bill payments, utility, and other recurring services for non-IPPB customers as well. The service is expected to benefit millions of unbanked and underserved customers in remote locations with access to doorstep payment solutions. Bharat Bill Pay is a wholly-owned subsidiary of National Payments Corporation of India.

19. Bank of Baroda launches bob World Wave, a wearable payment solution

Bank of Baroda (BOB) has joined hands with National Payments Corporations of India (NPCI) to launch bob World Wave, a wearable line of products for payments, integrated with a complete health ecosystem.

A bob World Wave wearable device will allow customers to monitor their Sp02, body temperature, heart rate and blood pressure.

20. LIC launches Dhan Rekha plan

The Life Insurance Corporation of India has launched a new non-linked, non-participating, individual savings life insurance plan called Dhan Rekha, it offers special premium rates for female lives.

The plan is also allowed for the third gender adding that all benefits under the plan are fully guaranteed. The minimum sum assured under this plan is '2 lakh. There is no limit for maximum sum assured.

21. Bank of Baroda signs MoU with Centrum Housing Finance

Bank of Baroda has signed a MoU with Centrum Housing Finance (CHFL) for sourcing and financing housing loan borrowers under co-lending model.

With this tie-up the bank will be able to penetrate deep into markets in Tier 2 and Tier 3 cities at competitive rates.

Bank of Baroda would be able to garner housing loan business to the extent of '1,000 crore in one financial Year.

22. Axis, Swift tie up to digitise trade banking

Axis Bank is integrating different digitisation initiatives by government bodies and service providers to extend an end-to-end service to business clients.

The bank's B2B (business-to-business) digitisation efforts are being supported by Swift ' a cooperative of global banks that acts as an intermediary between banks and sets standards.

23. ADB approves \$112 million loan for Assam Skill University

The Asian Development Bank (ADB) has approved \$112 million loan for Assam to strengthen skill education & training through establishment of Assam Skill University (ASU).



It will also support the design and delivery of industry-aligned and flexible skills education & training programs, including cutting-edge digital skills programs, career development programs & services.

24. Cabinet approves incentive scheme to promote RuPay Debit Cards, low-value BHIM-UPI transactions

The Union Cabinet approved an incentive scheme worth '1,300 crore to promote RuPay Debit Cards and low-value (up to '2,000) BHIM-UPI transactions (person to merchants-P2M) in the country.

The scheme has been formulated in compliance with the Budget announcements (FY 2021-22) by the Government to further boost digital transactions in the country.

25. Pilgrims to Kartarpur gurdwara can carry up to Rs 11,000: RBI

The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) permitted Indians as well as OCI card holders going on pilgrimage to Gurdwara Darbar Sahib in Kartarpur, Pakistan through the Kartarpur Sahib Corridor to carry up to Rs 11,000 in rupees or US dollars, lower than the usual limit of Rs 25,000.

The 4 km-long corridor provides visa free access to Indian Sikh pilgrims to visit the Darbar Sahib. The Kartarpur corridor was reopened last month.

26. RBI imposes penalty on PNB, ICICI Bank

The Reserve Bank of India has imposed a penalty of Rs 1.8 crore on Punjab National Bank and Rs 30 lakh on ICICI Bank for deficiencies in regulatory compliance.

In both cases, penalties were based on deficiencies in regulatory compliance and were not intended to pronounce upon the validity of any transaction or agreement entered into by the banks with their customers.

27. ADB cuts India's GDP growth forecast for 2021-22 to 9.7%

The Asian Development Bank (ADB) has revised India's GDP growth forecast for 2021-22 downwards to 9.7 per cent from 10 per cent projected in September 2021. It has cited supply chain issues as the major reason for the downgrade.

The bank has retained GDP growth forecast for 2022-23 at 7.5 per cent as it expects domestic demand to normalise.

28. ICICI Prudential Life is first insurer to sign UN pact on ESG issues

ICICI Prudential Life Insurance has become the first Indian insurance company to commit to environment, social and governance (ESG) issues by being a signatory to the United Nations supported Principles for Responsible Investment (UNPRI).

The company is now integrating ESG factors into its investment management framework.

29. RBI authorises RBL Bank to collect indirect taxes

RBL Bank has been authorized by the Reserve Bank of India (RBI), based on recommendation from the Controller General of Accounts, Ministry of Finance and Government of India, to collect indirect taxes on behalf of the Central Board of Indirect Taxes and Customs (CBIC). The bank had recently been authorised to collect direct taxes on behalf of the Central Board of Direct Tax

30. IFSCA sets up panel for creating framework for transfer of stressed loan

International Financial Services Centres Authority (IFSCA) sets up committee for creating framework for transfer of stressed loans from domestic lenders to financial institutions in IFSC. Former executive director of RBI G Padmanabhan would be chairing committee along with representative from law firm & other market with expertise in banking & legal issues.

31. NSDL e-Governance Infrastructure rebranded as Protean eGov Technologies

India's one of the leading IT-enabled solutions companies, NSDL e-Governance Infrastructure Ltd, has rebranded as 'Protean eGov Technologies Ltd.' Protean eGov's new brand reflects the company's aim of being a global leader in ICT and e-Government reform and transformation. Suresh Sethi, MD and CEO, Protean eGov Technologies Ltd.



32. SBI acquires minority stake in JSW Cement for Rs 100 crore

The State Bank of India (SBI) has acquired a minority stake in JSW Cement Limited, part of USD 13 billion JSW Group. The PSU Banking behemoth has invested Rs 100 crore in the company via compulsorily convertible preference shares (CCPS). The SBI transaction with JSW Cement comes close on the heels of the Rs 1,500 cr investments made by two global private equity investors. This capital infusion will support JSW Cement's capacity expansion from current 14 MTPA.

33. Bank of Baroda achieves top position in Digital Payments for 2020-21

Bank of Baroda (BOB) has announced it has won the top position in overall digital transactions amongst large banks for FY20-21.

The bank showed the exceptional growth of digital payment transactions achievement and was felicitated by the Ministry of Electronics & Information Technology (MeitY), Govt. of India at the Digital Payments Utsav. Hasmukh Adhia (Chairman); Sanjiv Chadha (MD & CEO of BOB).

34. Mastercard, Google Pay offer tokenisation for card-based payments

Mastercard and Google announced the rollout of tokenisation for Google Pay users, who will be able to make hassle-free transactions using their Mastercard credit and debit cards. Through tokenisation, Mastercard cardholders will be able to make payments through a secure digital token without having to share their credit / debit card details such as card number, expiry date.

35. CSB Bank has been empanelled as Agency Bank by the RBI

CSB Bank has been empanelled as 'Agency Bank' by the Reserve Bank of India.

This appointment will allow CSB Bank to undertake general banking business of the central and state governments which may be entrusted by the RBI.

It will also enable bank to handle a broad range of transactions related to government business, such as, TDS, GST, stamp duty, registration, etc.

36. RBI imposes penalty on One Mobikwik Systems, Spice Money

The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) has imposed a penalty of '1 crore each on payment system operators One Mobikwik Systems Private Ltd. and Spice Money Ltd. for deficiencies in regulatory compliance. The two entities had not complied with the directions issued by the Reserve Bank on net-worth requirement for Bharat Bill Payment Operating Units (BBPOUs).

37. Corporate-promoted NBFCs can have 15% stake in banks, with increase in cap

Corporate houses, which are not allowed to own a bank, can now pick up 15 per cent stake in commercial banks through their non-banking financial companies (NBFCs).

38. IndusInd Bank partners with NPCI to offer cross-border payments via UPI

IndusInd Bank has partnered with the National Payments Corporation of India (NPCI) for offering real-time cross-border remittances to India using UPI IDs, for its Money Transfer Operator (MTO) partners.

IndusInd Bank has become the first Indian bank to go live on UPI for Cross Border Payments/NRI Remittances.

39. IndusInd Bank announces launch of 'green fixed deposits'

IndusInd Bank has announced the launch of 'green fixed deposits', whereby the deposit proceeds will be used to finance projects and firms supporting the UN's Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs).

A green deposit is a fixed-term deposit for investors looking to invest their surplus cash reserves in environmentally friendly projects. These deposits will be offered to both retail & corporate customers.

40. Axis Bank is second largest in PoS machines

Axis Bank has become the second-largest merchant-acquiring bank in the country, leapfrogging two spaces during 2021 by installing over two lakh card-swipe machines during the year.



This is part of the bank's 'Axis One' strategy where it approaches the customers offering its entire gamut of products instead of a standalone service.

41. Vayana Network And Federal Bank Bag The 'Most Effective Bank-Fintech Partnership' At IBSi-Global Fintech Innovation Awards 2021

Vayana Network, one of India's largest trade finance platform, and Federal Bank, a leading Private Sector Bank have been awarded the 'Most Effective Bank-Fintech Partnership: Agile and Adaptable' at the IBSi-Global Fintech Innovation Awards 2021.

The award was conferred for automating and simplifying Supply Chain Finance.

42. Banks' gross NPAs may rise to 9.5% in September 2022: RBI report

The gross non-performing asset (GNPA) ratio of scheduled commercial banks is likely to increase to 9.5 % in September 2022 from 6.9 % in September 2021 in a severe stress scenario.

In the report, the central bank noted that the scheduled commercial banks would, however, have sufficient capital, both at the aggregate & individual levels, even under stress conditions.

43. Western Union, NPCI International Payments Limited (NIPL) ink MoU to enable Inbound Bank Account Payouts in India

Western Union, a global leader in cross-border, cross-currency money movement & payments, & NPCI International Payments Ltd, the International arm of National Payment Corporation of India, have signed a MoU to enable real-time bank account payouts in India.

It will help the customers in India to receive international money transfers in real time into their bank accounts.

44. SBI Card, Paytm Join Hands For Card Tokenisation To Protect Cardholders' Data

SBI Cards and Payment Services has tied up with Paytm for card tokenisation to protect data of the cardholders.

SBI Card has collaborated with Paytm to enable cardholders to tokenise their cards on devices and make payments through Paytm.

This card tokenisation facility is available only on Android NFC (near field communication) devices.

Economy

1. GST collection for November 2021 reported at Rs 1.31 lakh crore; second highest since roll out

Goods and Services Tax (GST) collections grew 25% year-on-year to Rs 1,31,526 crore in November, surpassing October's Rs 1.30 lakh crore mop-up.

Tax collections from import of goods also contributed to the numbers, which were 43% higher, while revenues from domestic transactions, including import of services, were 20% higher compared to November 2020.

2. WhatsApp gets NPCI nod for doubling payments user base

Facebook-owned messaging platform WhatsApp has been granted permission to double its user base for the payments service to 40 million by the National Payments Corporation of India (NPCI).

WhatsApp has a total user base of 400 million and the development will help the platform compete better with entrenched rivals like Google Pay and Phone Pe. ICICI Bank, Axis Bank, HDFC Bank& SBI acting as WhatsApp's payment service provider.

3. India's GDP to grow 9.1% in 2022: Goldman Sachs

Wall Street brokerage Goldman Sachs has estimated India's GDP growth at 9.1 percent in 2022.

After India's economy contracted by a sharp 7 percent in 2020, Goldman Sachs pegged the economy to grow at 8 percent in 2021 and 9.1 percent in 2022.

It earlier estimated India's economic growth to 11.1 percent in fiscal year to March 31, 2022.

4. Grofers rebrands as Blinkit

E-grocery unicorn, Grofers has rebranded itself as Blinkit.

The rebranding comes just months after Grofers pivoted to 10-minute groceries earlier in August 2021 and initially launched the service across the top 12 Indian cities.

Grofers had recently attained unicorn status or \$1billion in valuation.

5. Wholesale inflation surges to 14.23% in November, highest in current series

Producers' inflation based on the Wholesale Price Index (WPI) reached an all-time high in the current series at 14.2 per cent in November. This is the eighth successive month of double digits WPI (mainly due to hardening of prices of mineral oils, basic metals, crude petroleum and natural gas).

Wholesale Price-based Index (WPI) inflation base year is 2011-12.

6. LogiXtics: Unified Logistics Interface Platform hackathon launched to crowdsource ideas to benefit logistics industry

The Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade (DPIIT) has launched the Unified Logistics Interface Platform's (ULIP) hackathon ' 'LogiXtics' to crowdsource more ideas which will benefit the logistics industry. The ULIP Hackathon was launched by Amitabh Kant, CEO, NITI Aayog.

7. Govt's advance tax collection rises 54% to Rs 4.60 lakh crore in FY22

According to the finance ministry, advance tax collection increased by 53.50 percent to Rs 4.60 lakh crore so far this fiscal year, indicating a recovery in the economy. Direct tax collections for 2021-22, as of December 16, show that net collections are at Rs 9.45 lakh crore compared to Rs 5.88 lakh crore over the year-ago period, representing an increase of 60.8 percent.

8. NHAI toll revenue to jump to Rs 1.40 lakh cr in 3 yrs

Union Minister Nitin Gadkari predicted toll revenue of the NHAI will soar to Rs 1.40 lakh crore per annum in the next three years from Rs 40,000 crore per annum currently. Addressing an



event here, the Road Transport and Highways Minister said that there is a huge opportunity for investors in India's infrastructure sector as the traffic density is rising every year.

9. SEBI's total income down 15% to Rs 813 crore in 2019-20

Capital markets regulator SEBI's total income declined by 15 per cent to Rs 813 crore in 2019-20 mainly due to a drop in earnings from fees and subscription.

According to the annual accounts of SEBI made public, the total expenditure of the regulator rose to Rs 588.14 crore for the year ended on March 31, 2020, from Rs 492.34 crore in the previous fiscal. However, other income rose to Rs 18.15 crore from Rs 17.44 crore.





National

1. India will have nine nuclear reactors by 2024

The nation will have nine nuclear reactors by 2024 and a new nuclear project, the first in northern India, will come up 150 kms away from Delhi in Gorakhpur of Haryana, the government informed the Rajya Sabha.

By 2024, India will have nine nuclear reactors plus 12 new additional ones which were approved during the Covid times with a capacity of 9000 MW.

2. UP: I&B Minister Anurag Thakur inaugurates Earth Station of Doordarshan Kendra in Gorakhpur along with three FM stations

Information and Broadcasting Minister Anurag Singh Thakur and Uttar Pradesh Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath inaugurated Earth Station of Doordarshan Kendra in Gorakhpur. 4. Government Okays 100% Stake Sale In Central Electronics Limited

The "winning bid of Rs 210,00,60000" was placed by Nandal Finance and Leasing Private Limited Ashwini Vaishnaw - Union Minister Meity

5. UP becomes 1st state in the country to fully vaccinate over 5 crore people

UttarPradesh has become the 1st state in the country to fully vaccinate over 5 crore people were One-third of the state's eligible population is now fully vaccinated. The most populous state has also administered over 75% of its eligible population with the first dose of the Covid vaccine. Uttar Pradesh Governor - Anandiben Patel

6. Himachal Pradesh becomes first state in country to vaccinate its entire eligible population

Himachal Pradesh has become the first state to fully vaccinate 100 per cent of its adult population against COVID-19. As many as 53,86,393 eligible adults have been administered the second dose, he said, adding Himachal Pradesh was also the first state to achieve the 100 per cent first dose vaccination of adult population by the end of August. 7. PM Modi launches projects worth Rs 18,000 cr in Dehradun

The server design can be used for manufacturing classical standalone commercial server.

Ghosal had defeated V Crouin of France 3-0 in the semifinal after crushing L Serme& M Gamal by the same scoreline in the quarterfinals & pre-quarterfinals respectively.

He beat Miguel Rodriguez 11-7, 11-8, 13-11 in final.

2. India's Ananya Bansal wins Silver at Asia Youth Paralympic Games in Bahrain

India's Ananya Bansal won the country's first silver medal in shotput in the F-20 category at the Asia Youth Paralympic Games in Manama, Bahrain yesterday.

Ananya Bansal is an athlete with an intellectual impairment. Deepa Malik, the President of the Paralympic Committee of India lauded Ananya for her performance in the showpiece event.

3. India vs NZ: New Zealand's Ajaz Patel creates history; Becomes 3rd bowler in Test cricket to claim all 10 wickets in an innings

New Zealand spinner Ajaz Patel achieved the rarest of rare feats as he took all 10 wickets to fall in India's first innings in Mumbai. Ajaz Patel became only the third player in the history of Test cricket to do so. He joins England's Jim Laker and former Indian captain Anil Kumble to dismiss 10 opposition players in an innings Ajaz ended with figures of 10 wickets for 119 runs in 47.5 overs.

5. Viktor Axelsen, Tai Tzu Ying named BWF Male and Female Player of the Year

Denmark's Viktor Axelsen and Chinese Taipei's Tai Tzu Ying were named male and female player of the year respectively by the Badminton World Federation (BWF).

9. UK, Canada and Australia announce diplomatic boycott of 2022 Beijing Winter Olympics after US

United Kingdom, Canada and Australia have joined the US-led diplomatic boycott of the 2022 Winter Olympics in Beijing over concerns about human rights in China.

New Zealand has confirmed it will not send officials to Beijing mostly because of the coronavirus pandemic, but it also voiced concern over human rights issues in China.

10. Norway's Magnus Carlsen wins FIDE World Chess Championship

Reigning world chess champion **Magnus Carlsen** of Norway defended his title and won the FIDE World Championship in Dubai.

He beat Ian Nepomniachtchi of Russia, securing the one point he needed to cross the seven point threshold to win the global tournament held at Dubai's Expo 2020 this month in the United Arab Emirates.

Carlsen clinched his fifth world championship title. Carlsen wins 60% of the 2 million-euro prize offered by the championship.

11. Olympian Arvind Singh wins gold in Asian Rowing C'ship at Ban Chang, Thailand.

India's Arvind Singh won the gold in the Lightweight Men's Single Sculls at the Asian Rowing Championship beating his opponents with a time of 7:55.942s.

India ended the championship on a strong note, winning two gold and four silver medals. In lightweight men's double sculls, Ashish Phugat and Sukhjinder Singh won a silver with a timing of 7:12.568s

12. Chandeep Singh wins India's first ever medal at Para World Taekwondo Championships

Para-Athlete Chandeep Singh has bagged Silver medal at Para World Taekwondo Championships and became first Para Athlete from J&K to achieve such a great place at World level.

He won the medal in the Men's plus 80 kg event at the 9th Para World Taekwondo Championships held at Istanbul in Turkey from 9th to 12th December 2021.

13. Max Verstappen of Netherlands wins Abu Dhabi GP, beats Lewis Hamilton to become new F1 world champion

Red Bull's Max Verstappen took his first Formula One title, denying rival Lewis Hamilton a record eighth, with a last-lap overtake to win a season-ending Abu Dhabi Grand Prix at the Yas Marina Circuit.

Hamilton's Mercedes team secured the constructors' championship for an unprecedented eighth successive year.

14. VVS Laxman takes over as NCA chief

Former India batter VVS Laxman began his stint as the new head of the National Cricket Academy. VVS Laxman has replaced Rahul Dravid, who left the top job at NCA to join the senior national men's cricket team as its head coach.

He was also directly involved with the Indian developmental teams which include India A, India Under-19, India Under-23 teams.

15. AIBA rebrands itself as IBA, eyes boxing's reinstatement in 2028 LA Olympics with reforms

The International Boxing Association has changed its acronym from AIBA to IBA, promising to adopt a set of governance reforms so as to keep the sport's inclusion at the 2028 Olympics.



Boxing, weightlifting and modern pentathlon were all left off the initial list of sports for the 2028 Los Angeles Games and were asked to make changes by the International Olympic Committee.

16. BCCI Announces The Formation Of Differently-Abled Cricket Committee

Disability cricketers have welcomed the decision of the Board of Control for Cricket in India (BCCI) to form a Differently Abled Committee for the differently abled cricketers.

Australia opener David Warner and West Indies all-rounder Hayley Matthews were voted the ICC Players of the Month for November.

Warner, nominated for the ICC Men's Player of the Month award alongside Pakistan's Abid Ali and New Zealand's Tim Southee, emerged victorious with the most votes, following his crucial role in Australia's triumph in the ICC Men's T20 World Cup 2021

18. India's HansiniMathan Rajan beats Tokyo Olympics' youngest athlete to win ITTF title

India's HansiniMathan Rajan defeated Syria's Hend Zaza, the youngest athlete of this year's Tokyo Olympics, to win the girls singles event at the 2021 ITTF Hopes and Challenge table tennis tournament in Amman. Playing in the U-12 category, the reigning cadet national champion outplayed Zaza. Parth Prabhakar was India's entry in the boys singles event which was won by Iran.

19. BWF World Championships 2021 Final : Kidambi Srikanth bags historic silver, goes down fighting to Loh Kean Yew

India's shuttler Kidambi Srikanth scripted history, as he became the first male player from the nation to win a silver medal beating Singapore's Loh Kean Yew in BWF World Championships at Carolina Marin Stadium in Huelva, Spain.

It was the first final of the division for both nations, and Singapore becomes the fifth nation to win gold in the men's singles at the Worlds. Lakshya Sen, from India, bagged a bronze medal.

20. Beijing Winter Olympics: Harjinder Singh appointed as India's Chef de Mission

The Indian Olympic Association of India (IOA) has appointed Ice Hockey Association of India's general secretary, Harjinder Singh, as the Chef de Mission of the country's contingent for the upcoming 2022 Winter Olympics in Beijing.

Singh was the Chef de Mission of the Indian contingent for the 23rd Winter Olympic Games too, which was held in Pyeongchang, South Korea in 2018.

21. Anahat Singh becomes first Indian girl to win Jr Squash Open in US

13-year-old Delhi girl Anahat Singh became the first Indian to win the prestigious US Junior Squash Open at the Arlen Spectre Centre in Philadelphia.

Anahat won the title in the Under-15 category, beating Jayda Marei from Egypt 11-9, 11-5, 8-11, 11-5. Earlier, in the semifinals, she had beaten US national champion Dixon Hill 11-8, 11-9, 11-5.

22. Asian Champions Trophy: India beat Pakistan 4-3 to win bronze, Korea lift title

India beat Pakistan 4-3 in a pulsating third-fourth place contest to clinch the bronze medal at the Asian Champions Trophy men's hockey tournament. It was India's second win over Pakistan in the tournament after having beaten them 3-1 in the round-robin stages. The Indian team took the lead in the very first minute through vice-captain Harmanpreet Singh before Sumit (45th), South Korea emerged as the champions after beating Japan 4-2.



23. James Anderson becomes the first batter in history to stay not-out in a Test inning **100** times

On the third day of play in the pink-ball Test at the Adelaide Oval, Anderson created a unique record with the bat. In fact, he became the first player to achieve this feat in the history of the sport.

After staying unbeaten on the crease as England were bowled out for a meager 236 runs, Anderson became the first batter to stay not-out in a Test inning 100 times. Courtney Wash is second on the list having stayed unbeaten 61 times.

24. World Anti-Doping Agency (WADA) has restored the accreditation of the National Dope Testing Laboratory (NDTL)

World Anti-Doping Agency (WADA) has restored the accreditation of the National Dope Testing Laboratory (NDTL), which was suspended in 2019 because of its failure to comply with global standards. The NDTL can resume testing with immediate effect. India is currently third in the WADA's global list of dope violators, led by Russia.

25. Aanchal Thakur becomes first Indian to win two international skiing medals with bronze at Montenegro

Indian skier Anchal Thakur won her second international medal in alpine skiing at the FIS Alpine Ski Competition in Kolasin in Montenegro, keeping alive her hopes of qualifying for the next year's Winter Olympics in Beijing.

Aanchal won third place in the giant slalom section of the FIS Alpine Ski Competition. Montenegro is a Balkan country ;Capital: Podgorica; Currency: Euro.

26. Bangladesh win SAFF U 19 Women's Championship

Bangladesh Under-19 Women's team defeated India by 1-0 to lift the SAFF U-19 Women's Football Championship in Dhaka.

Taylor hence will play his final appearance in the second Test against Bangladesh, where will will equal Daniel Vettori's record of 112 tests for New Zealand. He will be part of the one-day international series in Australia. He is the first cricketer to play more than 100 matches for New Zealand in all 3 formats.

29. SA Wicketkeeper-Batter Quinton de Kock Announces Sudden Retirement From Tests

South Africa's wicketkeeper-batter Quinton de Kock announced his retirement from Test cricket with immediate effect late.

His announcement came just hours after South Africa's 113-run defeat to India in the first Test of the three-match series.

De Kock cited his intentions to spend more time with his growing family for the timing.



Agreements & MoUs

1. IREDA signs pact with BVFCL to provide techno-financial consultancy for RE projects

State-owned Indian Renewable Energy Development Agency (IREDA) has signed a pact with Brahmaputra Valley Fertilizer Corporation Ltd (BVFCL) to provide its techno-financial expertise in developing renewable energy projects and fundraising.

Under the MoU, IREDA will undertake techno-financial due diligence of renewable energy, green hydrogen, green ammonia, etc. for BVFCL.

2. SBI, Adani Capital sign pact for co-lending to farmers

State Bank of India (SBI) has signed an agreement with Adani Capital, the non-banking finance company (NBFC) arm of the Adani Group, for co-lending to farmers for purchase of tractors and farm implement.

RBI had issued guidelines on the co-lending schemes for banks and NBFCs for priority-sector lending, to improve credit flow towards underserved sectors of the economy.

3. Tata Power bags India's largest solar and battery project worth Rs 945 crore from Solar Energy Corp

Tata Power Company said that its wholly owned subsidiary Tata Power Solar Systems has received Letter of Award (LoA) from Solar Energy Corporation of India (SECI).

After the contract, the utility scale EPC order book of Tata Power Solar now stands at around 4.4 GW (DC) capacity with an approximate value of Rs 9,000 crore without GST. SECI project sites are located in Chhattisgarh

4. India, S Korea hold third Strategic Dialogue, discuss partnership in high tech, supply chain resilience

India and South Korea held the third Strategic Dialogue where the two sides discussed indepth critical and high technologies, supply chain resistance, and ways to further enhance the Special Strategic Partnership.

The two sides identified areas of cooperation in Cyber Security and Information Technology, Maritime Security, terrorism, extremism, etc.

5. India Russia sign pact to deepen space cooperation

India and Russia has vowed to deepen collaboration in the space sector, including in the human spaceflight programme, and signed an agreement for cooperation in the building as well as operation of launch vehicles.

The pact was signed during the India-Russia summit held between Prime Minister Narendra Modi and Russian President Vladimir Putin.

6. MoHUA and UNDP sign MoU to strengthen waste management sector in India under Swachh Bharat Mission-Urban 2.0

Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs (MoHUA), Government of India has signed a Memorandum of Understanding with the United Nations Development Programme India to strengthen the waste management sector in India under the overall ambit of Swachh Bharat Mission- Urban 2.0.

Solid waste management has been a key focus of Swachh Bharat Mission-Urban since its launch in 2014.

8. India, ADB sign 150 million dollar loan agreement to provide affordable housing for urban poor in Tamil Nadu

India and Asian Development Bank has signed a 150 million dollar loan agreement to provide affordable housing for urban poor in Tamil Nadu.

The project is aligned with the Government's development priorities and policies on urban sector development, particularly the flagship program Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana, Housing for All.

9. ISRO, Oppo collaborate to strengthen R&D of NavIC messaging service

The Indian Space Research Organisation has signed an agreement with Chinese smart devices maker Oppo's Indian arm to strengthen the research and development of the NavIC messaging service. The messaging service is mainly used for broadcasting safety-of-life alerts in areas with poor or no communication, particularly in the oceans.

Oppo India has its manufacturing unit in Noida and R&D centre in Hyderabad.

10. Ministry of Defence has entered into a MoU with Indian Institute of Teacher Education, Gandhinagar.

Adani Green Energy (AGEL) has inked a pact with state run Solar Energy Corporation of India (SECI) to supply 4667 MW of green energy.

The world's largest ever green power purchase agreement (PPA).

India's dual objective to accelerate India's renewable energy footprint as well as promote domestic manufacturing under the Aatmanirbhar Bharat programme.

13. Karnataka joins hands with UNDP to impart 21st century digital skills and improve opportunities for youth

This is MoneyGram's first mobile wallet partnership in India. MoneyGram:- an American crossborder P2P payments & money transfer company.

Small Industries Development Bank of India (SIDBI) has entered into a memorandum of understanding with the Bengal government to develop its MSME ecosystem.

Schemes

1. National Mission on Edible Oils ' Oil Palm (NMEO-OP) launched with the aim to augment the availability of edible oil in India

During the year 2020-21, India imported 133.5 lakh tonnes of edible oil, out of which the share of palm oil was around 56 %.

The salient features of NMEO-Oil palm include assistance for planting material, inputs for intercropping up to a gestation period of 4 years.

The total approved cost of the NMEO (Oil Palm) Scheme is ' 11,040 crore.

2. NEDFI Announces New Scheme Atmanirbhar Hastshilpkar Scheme for the Artisans under Ministry of Doner

With the objective to develop the petty artisans of the North Eastern Region by providing financial assistance in the form of term loans for income-generating activities for setting up/expansion/modernization/working capital requirement and other activities related to the sector, NEDFi has introduced Atmanirbhar Hastshilpkar Scheme to the grass-root Artisans of the region. North Eastern Development Finance Corporation has its head office at Dispur, Guwahati.

3. Cabinet approves extension of Pradhan Mantri Awaas Yojana-Gramin(PMAY-G) till March 2024

PMAY-G has been granted an extension beyond March 2021 and till March 2024.

The continuation of the scheme ensures the remaining 155.75 lakh households within the overall target of 2.95 crore houses under PMAY-G will be provided assistance for the construction of pucca houses with basic amenities to achieve the objective of 'Housing for All' in rural areas. The total financial implication for the remaining construction is Rs.1,98,581 crore

4. Cabinet approves Ken-Betwa river linking project at cost of Rs 44,605 crore.

A proposal of this effect was approved in the meeting of the Cabinet chaired by PM Modi. A Special Purpose Vehicle (SPV) called Ken-Betwa Link Project Authority (KBLPA) will be set up to implement the project.

Under the Ken-Betwa link project, water will be transferred from Ken to Betwa river through the construction of Daudhan Dam and a canal linking the two rivers.

The project has a deadline of eight years.

5. Civil aviation ministry receives in-principle approval for setting up 21 greenfield airports across India

The civil aviation ministry has received 'in-principle' approval for setting up 21 greenfield airports across the country, the ministry informed the parliament.

Out of these 21 airports, eight airports have been operationalized.

154 Regional Connectivity Scheme (RCS) airports, including 14 water aerodromes and 36 helipads, have been identified for development/upgradation.

6. India inducts 148 athletes, including 20 new, in list of TOPS athletes for 2024 Olympics

A total of 148 athletes, including 20 new inductees, in seven Olympic disciplines and six Paralympic disciplines, have been identified for support under the Target Olympic Podium Scheme at a meeting of the Mission Olympic Cell of the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports. TOP scheme which is an attempt to provide assistance to India's top athletes. This scheme was started in 2014.

7. ABRY scheme: Maharashtra tops chart with maximum number of beneficiaries

As on December 4, 2021, as many as 6,49,560 beneficiaries were recorded in Maharashtra, followed by Tamil Nadu (5,35,615), Gujarat (4,44,741) and Karnataka (3,07,164).



The government had launched ABRY to incentivize employment generation in Employees' Provident Fund Organisation (EPFO) registered establishments during COVID-19 for a period from October 1, 2020 to March 31.

8. Cabinet Approves Incentive Schemes Worth Rs 76,000 Crore For Semiconductors

In a bid to promote semiconductors and display manufacturing ecosystem in India, the Union Cabinet has cleared incentive scheme worth Rs 76,000 crore.

Under this initiative, the government plans to set up over 20 semiconductor design, components manufacturing, and display fabrication (fab) units in India over the six years.

9. CCEA okays extension of all 3 parts of PM Krishi Sinchayee Yojana till 2026

The Cabinet Committee on Economic Affairs has approved extension of all three components of the umbrella scheme of 'Pradhan Mantri Krishi Sinchayee Yojna' till 2025-26 which among things will fund construction of dams such as Renukaji (Himachal Pradesh) and Lahkwar (Uttarakhand) that in turn will significantly improve water supply to capital Delhi and its adjoining areas. The extension has been approved with an outlay of Rs 93,068 cr.

10. Govt to launch overdraft facility of Rs. 5,000 for women SHG members under DAY-NRLM

Nagendra Nath Sinha, Secretary, Department of Rural Development, Ministry of Rural Development will launch the overdraft facility of Rs. 5,000 to verified women SHG members under DAY-NRLM. The event will also include a 'Discourse on Rural Financial Inclusion' in which top officials from Banks and State missions will participate.

11. Jan Dhan accounts surpass the 44-cr mark

The total number of beneficiaries under the Centre's financial inclusion scheme, Pradhan Mantri Jan Dhan Yojana (PMJDY), has crossed the 44 crore mark.

The total number of accounts opened under PMJDY stood at 44.05 crore, with a total balance of '1,47,812 crore as on December 8.

Uttar Pradesh tops the list with highest number of accounts followed by Bihar. Since its launch in 2014, the scheme has been steadily expanding its base.

12. Govt approves implementation of PMKSY scheme for 2021-26

The Cabinet approved implementation of Pradhan Mantri Krishi Sinchayee Yojana (PMKSY) for 2021-26. The PMKSY is an umbrella scheme, consisting of two major components being implemented by the Ministry of Jal Shakti, namely, Accelerated Irrigation Benefits. HKKP, in turn, consists of four sub-components.

13. PM Modi transfers '1,000 cr to bank accounts of SHGs

Prime Minister Narendra Modi transferred '1,000 crore to bank accounts of self help groups to benefit around 16 lakh women.

The amount was transferred under the Deendayal Antyodaya Yojana-National Rural Livelihood Mission (DAY-NRLM).

The mission aims to provide women, especially those at the grassroots, with necessary skills, incentives and resources.

14. Private hospitals to be tagged for being breastfeeding-friendly

The Breastfeeding Promotion Network of India(BPNI) in collaboration with Association of Healthcare Providers of India (AHPI) has launched an accreditation programme that will enable hospitals to get a 'breastfeeding-friendly' tag. This programme is called 'Baby Friendly Hospital Initiative (BFHI)'.

15. Telangana tops in implementation of Rurban Mission

Telangana stood first in the implementation of the Shyama Prasad Mukherji Rurban Mission (SPMRM) that was launched 4 years in the past to stimulate native financial growth, improve fundamental companies and create properly deliberate clusters.

Sangareddy and Kamareddy districts stood in the primary two positions among the many 300 clusters.



Tamil Nadu and Gujarat took the second and third positions respectively.

1. Fertiliser major IFFCO ranked number one cooperative among the top **300** cooperatives in the world.

The ranking is based on the ratio of turnover over the gross domestic product (GDP) per capita, as per Indian Farmers Fertiliser Cooperative Limited (IFFCO).

The ranking is as per the 2021 edition of the 10th Annual World Cooperative Monitor (WCM) report published by the International Cooperative Alliance (ICA).

IFFCO has also inched up to 60th position in overall turnover. US Awasthi, MD, IFFCO.

2. India amongst the most unequal countries in the world, says report

As per the 'World Inequality Report 2022', India is among the most unequal countries in the world, with rising poverty and an 'affluent elite.'

The report highlights that the top 10% and top 1% in India hold 57% and 22% of the total national income respectively while the bottom 50% share has gone down to 13%. The share of female labour income share in India is equal to 18%. India and China experienced faster increases in private wealth than wealthy countries.

3. India Ranked Fourth Most Powerful Country In Asia Power Index 2021

India has risen as the fourth most powerful country in Asia, according to a report by Lowy Institute Asia Power Index 2021. It has been ranked fourth among the 26 countries and territories in Indo-Pacific for comprehensive power.

More malaria cases and deaths in 2020 linked to COVID-19 disruptions.

5. Indian SaaS companies are poised to reach \$30 billion in revenue: Report by Bain & Company

Indian Software-as-a-Service (SaaS) companies are poised to reach \$30 billion in revenue, capturing 8% to 9% share of the global SaaS market by 2025, according to a new report by Bain & Company.

The report said that investments in the space increased by 170% over 2020 and are expected to reach \$4.5 billion in 2021.

India has the third-largest SaaS ecosystem globally. India now has 13 SaaS unicorns as compared to one in 2018.

6. World unprepared for future pandemics: Global Health Security Index 2021

Countries across all income levels remain dangerously unprepared to meet future epidemic and pandemic threats according to the index.

USA, which was ranked first in the 2019 index, retained its position atop the rankings, with a score of 75.9, while Australia, Finland, Canada and Thailand rounded out the top five.

India with a score of 42.8 slipped 0.8 points since 2019. Index was created by Nuclear Threat Initiative & Johns Hopkins Center for Health Security

7. India ranks 59 on IMD World Talent Ranking Report 2021 ; Switzerland first

India has slipped 6 places to 59 rank on a global annual list of 63 countries, due to low quality of life and expenditure on education, according to the latest edition of IMD World Talent Ranking, which was topped by Switzerland.



The ranking, which is based on the performance in three main categories -- investment and development, appeal and readiness. India is lagging behind the BRICs nations - China(42nd), Russia (47), South Afria (50).

8. 90% of rural India's e-comm orders paid in cash: Study by CMS Infosystem

In 2020, nearly two-thirds of online sales were paid in cash, up from nearly half three years ago.

This is mainly because e-tailers expanded into the country's rural areas (untapped customers), nearly 90% of the new buyers pay through the 'cash on delivery' (COD) mode, according to a study by CMS Infosystem, one of the largest cash handlers for banks in India. COD is the most used payment method for e-commerce transactions in India.

9. More than 14 crore health IDs created in the country under the Ayushman Bharat Digital Mission: MoHFW

As of mid-December 2021, 14,15,49,620 health IDs have been created in the country under the Ayushman Bharat Digital Mission (ABDM).

The US and China, who occupy the first two ranks, are way ahead, according to the data compiled by Hurun Research Institute.

16. NITI Aayog Releases Fourth Edition Of State Health Index

NITI Aayog released the fourth edition of the State Health Index for 2019'20. The report, titled "The Healthy States, Progressive India", ranks states and Union Territories on their year-onyear incremental performance in health outcomes as well as their overall status.

The index is being compiled and published since 2017.

17. India to become world's 6th largest economy by 2023

Indian economy is all set to become sixth largest economy in the world leaving French and British economy behind, says British Consultancy Cybr report.

The report says that in the year 2022, Indian economy will exceed French economy whereas it will trump British economy in 2023 and the world's economic output will exceed \$100 trillion for the first time in 2022.

18. The Reserve Bank of India releases the 2020-21 iteration of its report on 'Trend and Progress of Banking in India'

The consolidated balance sheet of scheduled commercial banks (SCBs) expanded in size in 2020-21 despite the coronavirus pandemic and the resultant economic recession. Nascent signs of recovery are visible in credit growth in the current fiscal so far. Deposits grew by 10.1% at the end of September 2021 as compared with 11.0% a year ago.

19. ARIIA 2021: IIT Madras Secures Rank 1 As Most Innovative Educational Institute Of India

Indian bio-jet fuel can be produced from used cooking oil, tree-borne oils, short gestation oilseed crops grown off-season by farmers, and waste extracts from edible oil processing units.

2. NASA's Laser Communications Relay Demonstration ' Bringing Optical Speeds to the Final Frontier

NASA's Laser Communications Relay Demonstration (LCRD) will send data to and from ground stations and, eventually, in-space user missions over laser links.

LCRD leverages the work done in the telecommunications industry for the past several decades.

LCRD will showcase the unique capabilities of optical communications. Most NASA missions use radio frequency communications to send data to and from spacecraft

3. Airtel and Capgemini collaborate to develop India-specific enterprise 5G solutions

Bharti Airtel and technology services major Capgemini have announced to collaborate on bringing India-specific, 5G-based enterprise grade solutions to the country.

Its headquarters are in Bengaluru.

6. Airtel deploys Avanseus' AI-based predictive maintenance solution

Bharti Airtel ('Airtel'), India's premier communications solutions provider, and Avanseus, has announced the roll-out of Avanseus' predictive maintenance ('PdM') solution across its operations.

The expansion follows the successful trial and commercial deployment of the solution across Airtel's transport, enterprise, and core networks.

7. WHO approves emergency use listing for Serum Institute of India manufactured Covovax

World Health Organisation (WHO) has issued an emergency use listing for Serum Institute of India's manufactured Covovax. The move will help expand the basket of WHO-validated



vaccines against the SARS-CoV-2 virus. In a statement, WHO said, the decision will give a much-needed boost to ongoing efforts to vaccinate more people in lower-income countries.

8. Haryana launches new Integrated Command and Control Center under Karnal Smart City project

Haryana chief minister Manohar Lal Khattar has opened the new Integrated Command and Control Center (ICCC) under the Karnal Smart Cityproject. The new Command and Control Center will enable the functioning of advanced systems such as adaptive traffic control, automatic number plate recognition, detection of red-light violation and speed-violation

9. IIT Guwahati team develops efficient perovskite solar cells to produce electricity from sunlight

Indian Institute of Technology (IIT) Guwahati researchers have developed hybrid pervksite solar or photovoltaic devices in order to produce electricity from sunlight.

These machines are highly efficient and easy to manufacture. According to officials, hybrid pervksite are easily recyclable too.

10. James Webb telescope, successor of Hubble, set to be most powerful observatory ever sent into space

James Webb Space Telescope, a revolutionary instrument designed to provide mankind with the first-ever glimpse into an infant universe as it existed when the earliest galaxies are believed to have been formed.

Named after James Edwin Webb, the chief of the American space agency during most of the agency's formative decade of the 1960s.

11. China launches new camera satellite with 5m resolution to find resources

The satellite, called "Ziyuan-1 02E" or "five-meter optical satellite 02," was launched by a Long March-4C rocket from the Taiyuan Satellite Launch Centre in north China's Shanxi province.

It weighs about 2.5 kilograms and is equipped with infrared, near-infrared and hyperspectral cameras. The cameras can take full-colour panchromatic images of the Earth.

12. Houston COVID-19 vaccine Corbevax gets DCGI approval for use in India

The Texas Children's Hospital (TCH) and Baylor College of Medicine (BCM) announced that Corbevax, a protein subunit Covid vaccine, has received approval from the Drugs Controller General of India (DCGI) to launch it in India.

The initial construct and production process of the vaccine antigen was developed at TCH's Centre for Vaccine Development. V. G. Somani :- Drugs Controller General of India

13. Inmarsat Launches 'World's Most Sophisticated Communications Satellite'

Global satellite communications company Inmarsat has launched its first next-generation satellite, known as the I-6.

Billed as the most sophisticated commercial communications satellite ever launched, the I-6 F1 is the first of seven new fully-funded Inmarsat satellites to be launched by 2024.

The satellite was launched by Mitsubishi Heavy Industries from Japan.

14. Russia's latest nuclear powered icebreaker to boost India's Arctic plans via Northern Sea Route

Russia has launched a new nuclear powered icebreaker 'Sibir' (Project 22220) that will contribute to the rapidly growing fleet of lethal icebreakers to keep the Northern Sea Route open for year-round shipping through the Arctic enabling wider presence of India in the region.

Arctic region is opening new opportunities for hydrocarbons.

15. China launches five-year plan to become a hub of global robotics innovation

China announced a 5-year roadmap to achieve its goal of becoming a global robotics innovation hub by 2025. It aims to do this by focusing on enhancements in key areas such as control panels & servomotors.

China's Ministry of Industry & Information Technology revealed operating income from the country's robotics industry is expected to grow by around 20% per year by 2025.

16. 6G: Telecom department constitutes academia-driven multiple task forces

Defence

1. Border Security Force marks its 57th Raising Day :- December 1

The BSF is celebrating its 57th Raising Day on December 1.

India's first line of defence, BSF was formed on December 1, 1965, as a unified central agency, for ensuring the security of Indo-Pakistan & Indo-Bangladesh borders and for matters connected therewith.

This year, for the first time, BSF will celebrate its raising day in the border area of Jaisalmer, Rajasthan.

2. Lt Gen Manoj Kuma Mago to head National Defence College

Lt Gen Manoj Kumar Mago has taken over as the Commandant of National Defence College, New Delhi.

Lt Gen Mago, who hails from Ludhiana, was commanding the 10 Corps at Bathinda before being given the assignment at NDC that entails evolving a strategic culture among the country's senior-most officials of the military, the civilian bureaucracy and the Indian Police Service. He was commissioned into the 7th Battalion of the Brigade of Guards in 1984.

3. Centre gives approval for plan to manufacture over 5 lakh AK-203 assault rifles in Amethi

The Central government has approved a plan to produce over five lakh AK-203 assault rifles at Korwa in Uttar Pradesh's Amethi.

Uttar Pradesh is on way to become a defence manufacturing hub of India.

The 7.62 X 39mm caliber AK-203 rifles will replace in-service INSAS Rifle inducted over three decades back. Indo-Russian Rifles Private Ltd will implement this project

4. Joint military exercise between India and Maldives to begin at Kadhdhoo Island

The 11th edition of Exercise EKUVERIN between India and Maldives will be conducted at Kadhdhoo Island, Maldives.

The exercise will enhance synergy & inter-operability between Armed Forces of both the nations in terms of understanding transnational terrorism both on land & at sea, conducting Counter-Terrorism & Counter-Insurgency Operations, etc.

5. Indian Navy launches its new large survey vessel 'Sandhayak' in Kolkata

The Indian Navy launched 'Sandhayak', the first of the four large survey vessels, in Kolkata. The ship was launched by Pushpa Bhatt, spouse of Minister of State for Defence Ajay Bhatt, who was the Chief Guest at the event.

The primary role of these survey ships would be to conduct full-scale coastal & deep-water hydrographic survey of ports, harbours, navigation channels, etc.

6. India, Russia conclude AK-203 deal, renew 10-year pact for military cooperation

India and Russia has concluded a much awaited deal worth '5,100 crore for the joint production of more than 500,000 AK-203 assault rifles at a facility in Uttar Pradesh's Amethi district.

The deal was finalised at a bilateral meeting between defence minister Rajnath Singh and his Russian counterpart Sergey Shoigu. Two countries also renewed their military-technical cooperation arrangement for 2021- 31.

7. Tata Steel Deploys First Biofuel-powered Ship For Imported Raw Material Transportation

Tata Steel has deployed a ship powered by biofuel for transportation of its imported raw material. The initiative is in line with its sustainability objectives & efforts to reduce "scope 3" greenhouse gas emission in ocean trade. "Scope 3" emissions, refer to value chain emissions.

The bulk carrier named Frontier Sky, owned by NYK & operated by Tata NYK Shipping Pte Ltd.



8. Indian Navy's 'Killers' squadron, that sunk Pakistan warships, to get President's Standard

The Indian Navy's 22nd Missile Vessel Squadron, that bombed the Karachi Port and sunk Pakistan Navy's vessels in the 1971 war, received the President's Standard, a rare honour for its distinguished service, from President Ram Nath Kovind.

The Indian Navy was awarded the President's Colours on May 27, 1951 by the then President of India, Dr. Rajendra Prasad.

9. Pune to host joint military exercise with BIMSTEC countries

Pune will host a multilateral and multi-agency exercise for the member countries of BIMSTEC (Bay of Bengal Initiative for Multi Sectoral Technical and Economic Cooperation) between December 20 and 22, which will focus on Humanitarian Assistance and Disaster Relief (HADR) operations.

A curtain raiser event for the HADR exercise titled, PANEX-21, was held in New Delhi. **10. SBI to sign MoU with KendrivaSainik Board**

State Bank of India (SBI) will sign a memorandum of understanding (MoU) with KendriyaSainik Board to support and educate the children of war veterans, ex-servicemen, and war widows.

India's largest bank will provide a grant of '1,000 per month to 8,333 war veterans' children. KendriyaSainik Board has Hon'ble Defence Minister as its President. Defence Minister of India:- Rajnath Singh.

11. DRDO & Indian Air Force successfully flight-test indigenous Stand-Off Anti-Tank Missile

DRDO and Indian Air Force (IAF) flight-tested the indigenously designed and developed Helicopter launched Stand-off Anti-tank (SANT) Missile from Pokhran ranges. The missile is equipped with a state-of-the-art MMW seeker which provides high precision strike capability from a safe distance. The weapon can neutralize targets in a range up to 10 km. The SANT missile has been designed and developed by Research Centre Imarat, Hyderabad.

12. BrahMos air version tested, ready for serial production

India flight-tested the air version of supersonic cruise missile BrahMos from a fighter aircraft(Sukhoi 30 MK-I) off Odisha coast paving the way for its serial production.

The 8.4 metre long BrahMos missile, the fastest in the world, can carry conventional warhead up to 300 kg. It can cruise at the supersonic speed of Mach 2.8. BrahMos is an Indo-Russian joint venture.

13. Extended Range Pinaka rocket system successfully test-fired

The Pinaka Extended Range (Pinaka-ER) Multiple Launch Rocket System (MLRS) was tested with rockets built by private sector.

Pinaka MLRS was developed by two DRDO laboratories in Pune ' Armament Research & Development Establishment (ARDE) and High Energy Materials Research Laboratory (HEMRL) ' in partnership with two private sector firms, L&T and Tata Power Company Ltd.

14. India successfully tests long-range Supersonic Missile Assisted Torpedo off Balasore coasts

India successfully test fired a long-range Supersonic Missile Assisted Torpedo (SMART) off Balasore coast in Odisha.

The weapon system is being developed by the Defence Research and Development Organisation (DRDO) for the Indian Navy.

The system has been designed to enhance anti-submarine warfare capability far beyond the conventional range of the torpedo.



15. Defence ministry ropes in IITE Gandhinagar for training of 800 Sainik School teachers.

The Ministry of Defence has entered into a memorandum of understanding with Indian Institute of Teacher Education, Gandhinagar to facilitate training to teachers of Sainik Schools.

The MoU is for the period of 5 years commencing with effect from Jan 2022 under which 800 + teachers of all Sainik Schools will be trained through courses named 'Gurudiksha' & 'Pratibaddhta'. IITE was established in 2010 by the Government of Gujarat & focuses on teacher education.

16. Army Chief General MM Naravane takes charge as Chairman, Chiefs of Staff Committee

The government has appointed General MM Naravane, Chief of Army Staff, as the Chairman of Chiefs of Staff Committee (Chairman, CoSC), the post which fell vacant after the sudden demise of the first Chief of Defence Staff (CDS) General Bipin Rawat in a helicopter crash on December 8.

CDS is the fourth and permanent member of the CoSC. Important issues related to the armed forces are handled by this committee.

17. India Tests SFDR Technology Critical For Development Of Long Range Air-To-Air Missiles

The Defence Research and Development Organisation (DRDO) tested its Solid Fuelled Ducted Ramjet (SFDR) technology for the fourth time with a demonstration flight.

The development of SFDR technology will enable India to make its own long-range air-to-air missile, which could mirror the capabilities of the best missiles in this class, like MBDA's Meteor. MBDA's Meteor, which the Indian Air Force uses on its Rafales.

18. HAL inks '2400 Cr deal with BEL for LCA Tejas Mk1A systems

Hindustan Aeronautics Limited signed a five-year contract, worth '2400 crores, with Bharat Electronics Limited (BEL) for development and supply of 20 types systems for the Light Combat Aircraft (LCA) Tejas Mk1A project of the Indian Air Force in Bengaluru.

LCA Tejas programme is an excellent example of synergies between Indian Defence establishments such as HAL, DRDO.

19. DRDO conducts flight demonstration of Controlled Aerial Delivery System

Aerial Delivery Research & Development Establishment (ADRDE), Agra conducted a flight demonstration of Controlled Aerial Delivery System of 500 kg capacity (CADS-500). ADRDE, Agra is an R&D laboratory of Defence Research & Development Organisation (DRDO) and the flight demonstration is part of celebrating 'Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav', commemorating 75 years of Independence.

20. India successfully test-fired new generation ballistic missile 'Agni-P'

Defence Research and Development Organisation (DRDO) successfully test-fired the new generation nuclear-capable ballistic missile 'Agni Prime' from APJ Abdul Kalam island off the coast of Odisha in Balasore. Capable of eliminating an enemy 5,000 kilometres away India has successfully test-fired the new generation nuclear-capable ballistic missile 'Agni P'.

21. India, France discuss bilateral, regional and defence issues during third annual Defence Dialogue in Delhi

The third Annual Defence Dialogue between India and France took place between Defence Minister Rajnath Singh and his French counterpart Florence Parly in New Delhi.

A wide range of bilateral, regional, defence and defence industrial cooperation issues were discussed in the annual meeting.

22. India Conducts Successful Test Of 'Pralay' Ballistic Missile Off Odisha Coast

India has successfully test fired short-range (350-500 km), surface to surface-guided ballistic missile 'Pralay' off the Odisha coast.



The solid-fuel, battlefield missile developed by DRDO is based on Prithvi Defence Vehicle from the Indian ballistic missile programme.

The missile, launched from the APJ Abdul Kalam Island met all the mission objectives. Its payload capacity of 500-1,000 kg.

23. India deploys first S-400 air defence system in Punjab sector

In a major boost to the country's air defence capabilities, the Indian Air Force (IAF) is deploying the first squadron of the S-400 air defence missile system in the Punjab sector.

The first squadron is being deployed in the Punjab sector.

The batteries of the first squadron would be capable of taking care of aerial threats from both Pakistan and China.

24. DRDO Successfully Conducts Flight Test of Indigenous Expendable Aerial Target 'Abhyas'

The Defence Research and Development Organisation (DRDO) successfully conducted a flight test of indigenously-developed high-speed expendable aerial target (HEAT) 'Abhyas' off the Chandipur coast in Odisha.

During the flight trial, a high subsonic speed trajectory at a very low altitude with high endurance was demonstrated.

25. BoB subsidiary and India Navy launch co-branded credit card

BOB Financial Solutions Ltd, a wholly-owned subsidiary of Bank of Baroda, and Indian Navy have launched a co-branded credit card for navy personnel. The credit card will be equipped with contactless features and will be offered on the RuPay platform.

A navy personnel up to the age of 64 years will be eligible to choose from three variants of the co-branded credit card.

26. INS Khukri, 1st Of The India Built Missile Corvettes, Decommissioned After 32 Years

INS Khukri, the first of the indigenously built missile corvettes, was decommissioned "after 32 years of glorious service".

The corvette was built by the Mazagaon Dock Shipbuilders on August 23, 1989 and had the distinction of being part of both the Western and Eastern Fleets.

The ship solemn ceremony was held at Visakhapatnam.

27. Defence ministry puts restrictions on import of 351 items under staggered timeline

The defence ministry has announced a fresh list of 351 sub-systems and components that will not be allowed to be imported under a staggered timeline beginning December next year.

It is the third list released by the ministry in the last 16 months and it comes as part of the government's overall aim to make India a hub of manufacturing of military platforms and equipment. The new initiative will save foreign exchange equivalent to around Rs 3,000 cr annually.

28. Army sets up quantum computing lab, AI centre at engineering institute in Mhow

The Army, with support from the National Security Council Secretariat (NSCS), has recently established the Quantum Lab at Military College of Telecommunication Engineering, Mhow. Indian Army has also established an Artificial Intelligence (AI) Centre at the same institution with over 140 deployments.

Chief of Army Staff General MM Naravane. The Strategic Policy Group is the first level of the three-tier structure of NSCS.
