His preparation pattern

Phase 1: Build Nov 2024 – Jan 2025 High-volume testing for 2024 Tier 2. Peak of 26 tests in a single month - one every 1.2 days.	Phase 2: Maintain Mar – Aug 2025 Consistent practice between 2024 & 2025 exams. Never paused, never lost momentum.	Phase 3: Peak Oct 2025 – Jan 2026 Intensity peaked again. 17 tests in December alone - the highest month of the final cycle.

What every SSC aspirant can take from this

He never stopped.

Across 14 months and two exam cycles, there was no long gap. Even between exams he kept giving mocks.

What you should do: Never take long breaks from taking tests.

He doubled intensity at the right time.

Mock frequency doubled before each exam window. He knew exactly when to push.

What you should do: Push harder in the final 2–3 months before your exam.

His floor never collapsed.

Even in his worst month, his average percentile was 95% - top 5% of all test-takers on a bad run.

What you should do: Focus on consistency, not occasional highs.

He built strength across every section.

29 times at 100th percentile in Quant. But 10 times each in English and Reasoning too. No section was left weak.

What you should do: Don't rely on one section to carry your score.

Why this matters

This level of consistency is not accidental. It is built through structured, repeated practice.

The same Oliveboard mocks, live tests, and analytics he used are available to you today. He did not have special access. He just showed up - 124 times.

If you want AIR-level preparation, start where AIR 1 trained.
