Banking & Finance

1. ICICI Bank partners with NPCI to launch RuPay credit cards called "ICICI Bank Coral RuPay Credit Card"

ICICI Bank announced its partnership with National Payments Corporation of India (NPCI) to launch a range of credit cards on RuPay, the indigenous payments network. To begin with, the ICICI Bank RuPay Credit Card is available in the Coral variant of the Bank's Gemstone series, which will be followed by Rubyx and Sapphiro variants soon.

2. RBI issues guidelines for digital lending, effective immediately

According to the guidelines, all loan disbursals/repayments are to be executed only between the bank accounts of the borrower and the regulated entity (RE). REs need to ensure that the disbursal is not made to a third-party account, including the accounts of loan service providers (LSPs) and their digital lending apps (DLAs).

3. GST wing of CBIC conducts tax inspections against insurance companies

The Goods and Services Tax wing of the Central Board of Indirect Taxes and Customs (CBIC) has carried out tax searches and inspections against several insurance companies. The list of companies the tax sleuths have visited includes several of the major life and non-life insurers.

4. SBI sells largest AT-1 tranche at lowest rate for any bank so far this year

India's largest lender State Bank of India issued additional tier-1 (AT1) bonds worth a total of Rs 6,872 crore at a cut-off of 7.75 per cent, the lowest rate set for such debt issuances by any bank so far in the current financial year. The bank had notified an amount of Rs 7,000 crore to be raised through a single tranche of AT1 bonds in order to augment capital.

5. Bank of India becomes first Public Sector Bank to go live on new Direct Tax Collection System Tin 2.0

Bank of India has become the first public sector bank to go live on Income Tax Department's new Direct Tax Collection System Tin 2.0. With this technological integration of BOI on TIN 2.0 platform, taxpayers will now get a single platform for their tax payment as well as e-filing of tax returns. Tax Information Network, TIN 2.0 is the official portal of Income tax.

6. WAAREE partners with SBI for financing Consumers & Channel Partners

WAAREE, India's largest Solar Panel manufacturer, has entered into an Agreement with SBI for availing unsecured financing for solar projects through Surya Shakti Solar Finance Scheme and providing working capital for Channel Partners under EDFS (Electronic dealer finance scheme).

7. IRDAI allots insurance broking license to Lord's Mark Insurance

Lord's Mark Insurance Broking Private Limited, Lord's Mark Industries' insurance branch, has been granted a direct insurance broking license by the Insurance Regulatory and Development Authority of India (IRDAI) to market life and general insurance products.

8. Axis Bank, Square Yards launch Open Doors for hassle-free home buying

Axis Bank and Square Yards have announced the launch of 'Open Doors', a co-branded Home Buyer Ecosystem. This platform will ensure that the complete journey from searching to buying one's dream home becomes a hassle-free, efficient, and delightful experience for customers. 9. PhonePe tokenises 1.4 cr debit, credit cards in line with RBI mandate

The largest fintech platform in India, PhonePe, said that 14 million debit and credit cards have been tokenized on the platform which is in line with the mandatory card tokenization of the RBI which is a move to reduce the risk of fraud and safeguard customers card details. The deadline for tokenizing debit & credit cards has been extended by the RBI till September 30, 2022

10. FinMin to allow RRBs to raise funds via IPO, rights issue

The Finance Ministry has issued draft guidelines for Regional Rural Banks (RRBs) to raise resources from capital market, paving the way for raising funds via rights issue, private placement with select investors such as large banks and insurance companies, and initial public offerings (IPO). Currently, there are 43 RRBs sponsored by 12 Scheduled Commercial Banks with 21,892 branch

11. Yes Bank partners with NLDSL to develop use-cases on ULIP

Yes Bank announced that it has partnered with NICDC Logistics Data Services Limited (NLDSL) in order to develop use-cases to support corporate users in augmenting their supply chain on the Unified Logistics Interface Platform (ULIP) under government's new logistics policy.

The government will integrate around 17 digital systems from the seven ministries on ULIP. Prashant Kumar, Managing Director and CEO, YES Bank.



12. PFC successfully resolves CIRP of India's largest stressed transmission asset

Power Finance Corporation Ltd. has successfully resolved the country's largest stressed asset in the power transmission sector of Southeast U. P. Power Transmission Company Limited. This is a landmark resolution through the Corporate Insolvency Resolution Process (CIRP) under the IBC (2016), which has resulted in lenders recovering in excess of 100% of the principal amount.

13. HDFC Bank launches 'Aao Bus Karein' campaign to promote greener commuting habits

Through this campaign, HDFC Bank will run 4 Electric Vehicle AC buses across Mumbai to encourage commuters to leave their cars at home in favour of public transport. The E-buses will run on specific routes to connect commuters to key corporate parks and will ply day-long to ensure ease of mobility and convenience for commuters.

HDFC Bank announced a tie-up with Mumbai's BEST Bus Service to launch this initiative.

14. RBI directs Mahindra Finance to stop outsourcing its recovery activity through agents The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) barred Mahindra & Mahindra Financial Services from carrying out recovery or repossession activity through third-party until further notice. However, the company is allowed to carry out the activity through its own employees. RBI's ban comes after certain material supervisory concerns observed in the company. Mahindra Group's CEO and MD Anish Shah.

15. Gujarat gets over Rs 2.8K-crore loan from World Bank for health care

The World Bank has approved a USD 350 million (over Rs 2,832 crore) loan to Gujarat for spending towards public healthcare services, focussed specially on adolescent girls and disease surveillance. The loan will be utilised through the state government's Systems Reform Endeavours For Transformed Health Achievement In Gujarat (SRESTHA-G) Programme.





Economy

1. India's GDP in first quarter of current fiscal grows at 13.5 percent, fastest in a year

According to the provisional estimates by the Ministry of Statistics & Programme Implementation, the Gross Domestic Product (GDP) of the country for the April-June quarter of the current financial year grew at 13.5 per cent.

Agriculture, Forestry & Fishing sector rose 4.5%. The manufacturing sector grew 4.8% and the Construction sector appreciated by 16.8%.

2. August GST revenue collection up 28% YoY at Rs 1.44 lakh cr

The gross GST revenue collected in the month of August 2022 stood at Rs 1,43,612 crore, up 28% on a year-on-year basis, the Finance Ministry said in a statement With this, the monthly GST revenues have exceeded Rs 1.4 lakh crore for six months in a row.In July, the GST collection was Rs 1.49 lakh crore, the second-highest level since its introduction in July 2017.

3. India becomes fifth largest Economy of world with IMF's growth forecast of more than 7% this year

India has surpassed the United Kingdom to become the world's 5th biggest economy. In a tweet, Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman said, the International Monetary Fund's own forecasts show India overtaking the UK in terms on an annual basis this year. This has put India, the Asian powerhouse, just behind the US, China, Japan and Germany.

4. Finance ministry to assess PSB performance and credit disbursement

According to data from the Reserve Bank of India (RBI), the asset quality of the banking system has improved, with the gross non-performing asset (NPA) ratio falling from 7.4 per cent in March 2021 to a six-year low of 5.9 per cent in March 2022. Additionally, the net bad loan ratio decreased from 2.4 per cent in March 2021 to 1.7 per cent in March 2022.

5. Fitch cuts India's GDP growth forecast to 7% for FY23

Global ratings agency Fitch cut India's gross domestic product (GDP) growth forecast for 2022-23 to 7% from the earlier 7.8% due to the impact of the global economic slowdown, elevated inflation and tighter monetary policy. Growth is expected to slow to 6.7% in 2023-24 from the previous estimate of 7.4%, the agency said in its latest report.

6. CBDT issues Revised Guidelines for compounding of offences under the Income-tax Act, 1961 Specific upper limits have been introduced for the compounding fee covering defaults across several provisions of the Act. Additional compounding charges in the nature of penal interest @ 2% per month up to 3 months and 3% per month beyond 3 months have been reduced to 1% and 2% respectively.

7. S&P retains FY23 growth forecast at 7.3%; OECD at 6.9%

S&P Global Ratings retained India's economic growth projection at 7.3% in the current fiscal with downside risks and said inflation is likely to remain above the Reserve Bank of India's upper tolerance threshold of 6% till the end of 2022.

The Organisation for Economic Co-operation and Development (OECD) too stuck to its projection of 6.9% growth in India's GDP for FY23. OECD, Headquarters: Paris, France. ; S&P Global Ratings HQs: New York, United States.

8. Govt commits Rs. 7,385 crore under Fund of Funds for Startup India Investment for 88 Alternative Investment Funds (AIFs)

Fund of Funds for Startups, launched under Startup India initiative in 2016 by the Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi has committed Rs. 7,385 crore to 88 Alternative Investment Funds as of 24th September 2022. These AIFs in turn have invested Rs. 11,206 crore in 720 startups. FFS has been playing a monumental role in mobilizing domestic capital in Indian startup ecosystem. FFS was announced with a corpus of Rs. 10,000 crore.

9. Cabinet approves 4% DA hike for Central Govt employees

Union Cabinet approved 4% additional instalment of Dearness Allowance and Dearness Relief to Central Government employees and pensioners with effect from July 1, 2022.

The move will benefit about 41.85 lakh Central Government employees and 69.76 lakh pensioners. The combined impact on the exchequer on account of both DA & DR would be Rs 12,852.5 crore per annum.



National

1. INS Vikrant, India's First Home-Built Aircraft Carrier, Commissioned

INS Vikrant, India's first home-built aircraft carrier, was formally commissioned after completing almost a year of sea trials. The 45,000-tonne warship has been built at a cost of ' 20,000 crore. PM Modi also unveiled the new Naval Ensign. The Navy had earlier said the new insignia will be befitting the rich Indian maritime heritage.

2. Reliance Industries to build world's largest carbon fibre plants.

Reliance Industries chairman Mukesh Ambani, in the 45th AGM on Monday, announced to build India's first and one of the world's largest Carbon Fibre plants at Hazira, Gujarat. The plants will have a capacity of 20,000 MTPA based on Acrylonitrile feedstock. Overall, in the Oil to Chemical segment (O2C), Ambani Ambani announced an investment of '75,000 crore

The government has decided to rename the historic Rajpath and Central Vista lawns in the national capital as 'Kartavya Path'. Rajpath was known as Kingsway during British Rule.Earlier, the name of the road on which PM's residence is located was changed from Race Course Road to Lok Kalyan Marg.

7. Seat belts mandatory for all passengers in car, violators to be fined: Gadkari announces new rule after Mistry's death

Union minister Nitin Gadkari said that from now on wearing seat belts would be mandatory for all passengers in a car, including those on rear seats, and flouting the rule will attract penalty. The announcement was made only two days after former Tata Sons chairman Cyrus Mistry died in a car accident near Mumbai

8. NITI Aayog, WRI launches e-FAST - India's first national electric freight platform

NITI Aayog, in collaboration with World Resources Institute (WRI), India, launched the country's first national electric freight platform ' e-FAST India (Electric Freight Accelerator for Sustainable Transport ' India). The platform also aims to raise awareness on freight electrification bolstered by on-ground demonstration pilots and evidence-based research.

9. Election Commission Declares 253 RUPPs As Inactive, Bars Them From Availing Benefits Of The Symbol Order, 1968

The Election Commission of India led by Chief Election Commissioner, Shri Rajiv Kumar and Election Commissioner Shri Anup Chandra Pandey further delisted 86 non-existent RUPPs and declared an additional 253 as 'Inactive RUPPs'. This action against 339 non-compliant RUPPs takes the tally to 537 defaulting RUPPs since May 25, 2022.

10. Munoth Industries to commission India's 1st lithium-ion cell factory in Andhra Pradesh Chennai-based Munoth Industries Ltd (MIL), promoted by Munoth group, is set to commission what it calls India's first full-fledged lithium-ion cell manufacturing unit at Electronic Manufacturing Cluster 2 [EMC 2], located at Tirupati in Andhra Pradesh.Presently, India is completely importing lithium-ion cells from China, South Korea, Vietnam, and Hong Kong.



11. USAID and UNICEF launches Doordarshan and YouTube series titled 'Door Se Namaste' in New Delhi

The US Agency for International Development and UNICEF today launched the Doordarshan and YouTube series titled Door Se Namaste at function held in New Delhi. Door Se Namaste is a new television series which promotes healthy behaviours in a post-pandemic world.

12. Scheme for Special Assistance to States for Capital Investment for 2022-23

13. Amazon setting up its first solar project in India

Amazon announced the setting up of its first solar farm in India. The e-commerce major will be setting up three solar power projects with a capacity of 420 megawatt (MW) in Rajasthan. These would include a 210 MW project to be developed by ReNew Power, a 100 MW project to be developed by Amp Energy India, and a 110 MW project to be developed by Brookfield Renewable Partners

14. Op 'Megha Chakra': CBI conducts searches in 21 states/UT against child abuse material The Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI) carried out searches in 21 states/Union Territory in relation to the circulation and sharing of Child Sexual Abuse Material (CSAM).

CBI launched the operation - code-named 'Megha Chakra' - following inputs from Interpol headquarters, Crime against Children unit in Singapore. Subodh Kumar Jaiswal current CBI director.

15. Uttar Pradesh tops GeM chart with GMV of more than Rs 24,000 crore

The Uttar Pradesh government has emerged as the top buyer on the Government e-Marketplace portal with a gross merchandise value (GMV) of more than Rs 24,000 crore. 1. FIFA U-17 Women's World Cup 2022: VAR To Make Debut In Age-Group Showpiece In India The upcoming FIFA U-17 Women's World Cup in India will see the Video Assistant Referee (VAR) technology making its debut in the age-group showpiece.

The U-17 Women's World Cup in India will be the third FIFA women's tournament to utilise VAR following the U-20 Women's World Cup Costa Rica 2022 and the FIFA Women's World Cup France 2019. 2. Home Minister Shri Amit Shah launched 36th National Games Anthem and mascot in Ahmedabad

The curtain raiser event of 36th National Games was held at the EKA Arena TransStadia in Ahmedabad. The 36th National Games, whose theme is Celebrating Unity Through Sports, are being held after a gap of seven years and will take place from September 29 to October 12. The Games were last held in Kerala in 2015.

3. Aaron Finch: Australia white-ball captain to retire from one-day internationals

Australia white-ball captain Aaron Finch will retire from one-day international (ODI) cricket after Sunday's match against New Zealand.

Finch has led Australia's ODI and Twenty20 teams since 2018.

The 35-year-old opening batter has played 145 ODIs and scored 5,401 runs at an average of 39.13. He led Australia to their first T20 World Cup title in 2021.

4. In Football, India beat Nepal 4-0 to clinch SAFF U-17 Championship Title in Colombo In football, India clinched the SAFF under-17 Championship title, defeating Nepal 4-0 in the final in Colombo. India captain Vanlalpeka Guite was named the Most Valuable Player of the Tournament, while goalkeeper Sahil won the Best Goalkeeper awards.

5. Vinesh Phogat wins bronze in World Wrestling Championships in Serbia

Vinesh Phogat has become the first Indian woman wrestler to win two medals at the World Championships after clinching a bronze in 53 kilogram category in Belgrade, Serbia. The Commonwealth Games 2022 gold medalist defeated reigning European champion Emma Malmgren of Sweden. This is her second bronze medal at the Championships after the 2019 event.

6. Fruhvirtova defeats Linette in 2022 WTA Chennai Open final

Czech teenager Linda Fruhvirtova fought back to beat No.3 seed, Magda Linette of Poland 4-6, 6-3, 6-4 and win the Chennai Open WTA 250 title. This was her 17-year-old's first Tour title. In the doubles, the top-seed Canadian-Brazilian pair of Gabriela Dabrowski and Luisa Stefani hammered Anna Blinkova (Russia) and Natela Dzalamidze (Georgia) 6-1, 6-2 to claim the title.

7. India to host maiden MotoGP race in 2023; to be labelled as 'Grand Prix of Bharat'

MotoGP commercial rights owner Dorna and Noida-based race promoters Fairstreet Sports signed a MoU to host the premier two-wheel racing event in India for the next seven years.

The Buddh International Circuit, which will be hosting the MotoGP race, was once home to the Formula 1 Indian Grand Prix, held for three consecutive years from 2011 till 2013.

1. Deaths by suicide at their highest rate in 2021:NCRB report 2021

Last year, 1.64 lakh persons died by suicide, an increase of 7.2% from 2020 when 1.53 lakh persons had killed themselves.

In 2021, the rate of suicide ' the number of death due to suicides per one lakh population ' stood at 12. These findings are from Accidental Deaths & Suicides in India (ADSI) and Crime in India (CII) reports for 2021.

Maharashtra has reported the highest number of deaths by suicide (22,207).

2. Cybercrime against women up 28% since 2019, Karnataka's share highest: NCRB

The number of cybercrime incidents in 2021 has gone up by 18.4% since 2019, but the number of such cases against women has risen at a significantly steeper 28%, data released by the National Crime Records Bureau showed.

Karnataka had the highest share with 2,243 cases in 2021, followed by Maharashtra with 1,697, and Uttar Pradesh with 958 cases.

3. Crime against kids- a third still under POCSO: NCRB data

The latest report released by the National Crime Records Bureau (NCRB) shows that 1,49,404 cases of crime against children were registered in 2021 of which 53,874 ' 36.05 per cent ' were under the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act (POCSO).

The largest number of cases registered under POCSO in 2021 was in UP (7,129) followed by Maharashtra (6,200).

4. LIC out of top 10 most valued firms, replaced by Bajaj Finance, Adani Transmission

LIC lost its spot on the list of India's 10 most valued companies by market capitalisation to Bajaj Finance and Adani Transmission.

LIC now ranks eleventh. The top 10 most valued firms of India now are Reliance Industries, Tata Consultancy Services, HDFC Bank, Infosys, Hindustan Unilever, ICICI Bank, State Bank of India, HDFC, Bajaj Finance, and Adani Transmission.

Bajaj Finance and Adani Transmission both have a market cap of Rs 4.4 trillion each.

5. UPI clocks 657 crore transactions in August, totalling Rs 10.73 lakh crore

The value of UPI-based digital payments in August 2022 crossed Rs 10.73 lakh crore, which is marginally higher than Rs 10.63 lakh crore clocked in July month of the same year, according to the latest data from the National Payments Corporation of India (NCPI).

The number of Aadhaar-based 'AePS' transactions declined to 10.56 crore in August from 11 crores in July. The term AePS stands for Aadhaar Enabled Payments Systems.

6. Half of health care facilities globally lack basic hygiene services ' WHO, UNICEF

Half of health care facilities worldwide lack basic hygiene services with water & soap or alcohol-based hand rub where patients receive care and at toilets in these facilities, according to the latest Joint Monitoring Programme(JMP) report by WHO & UNICEF.

In the Least Developed Countries, only 53% of health care facilities have access on-premises to a protected water sources

7. Andhra Pradesh, Odisha Attract Maximum Industrial Investment In 2022

According to the Department for Promotion of Industries and Internal Trade (DPIIT) report, both states account for 45 per cent of the entire investment inflow in the country in 2022. 

The day also aims at spreading awareness on the social, economic, and political developments made in the Southern region. **8. International Day of Democracy | 15 September**

International Day of Democracy is celebrated every year on 15 September under a specific theme. The day is observed globally to mark the importance of democracy and create awareness among people about democratic rights. 18. World Tourism Day | 27 September

The World Tourism Organisation (UNWTO) started the World Tourism Day in 1979. The celebrations for the same officially began in 1980. It is celebrated on 27 September every year because the date marks the anniversary of the adoption of the Statutes of UNWTO. The official celebration of the 42nd year event in 2022 is scheduled to be held in Bali, Indonesia. The theme for 2022 is 'Rethinking Tourism'

19. International Day for Universal Access to Information | 28 September

The UNESCO, on 17 November 2015, declared that International Day for Universal Access to Information will be observed on September 28, every year. Several organizations and governmental bodies adhered to the declaration by UNESCO. Further, the UN General Assembly also decided to declare September 28 as the International Day for Universal Access of Information (IDUAI).

20. World Rabies Day 2022 | 28 September

World Rabies Day is marked annually to raise awareness about rabies and its prevention. In addition to this, the day also highlights the process of defeating this lethal disease to eradicate it completely. shipping sector. The first World Maritime Day was celebrated on 17 March 1978 to celebrate the establishment of the IMO Convention. The theme for world maritime day 2022 is 'New technologies for greener shipping'.

23. International Translation Day | 30 September

The International Translation day came into being after the United Nations General Assembly passed a resolution on May 24, 2017. The resolution was signed by eleven countries after recognising the importance of the role of language professionals and September 30 was chosen to pay tribute to them as it also coincides with the feast of the Bible translator, St. Jerome. According to WHO, 41, 91,000 women have died due to cervical cancer in India since 2019.

2. Indian Railways set up 'Meghdoot' machines at Mumbai stations

Indian Railways have set up 'Meghdoot' machines at Dadar, Thane and other stations of Mumbai Division. Maithri Aquatech's MEGHDOOT ' AWG(Atmospheric Water Generator) uses innovative technology to convert water vapour in the air into fresh and clean drinking water.

Meghdoot machines are research-driven and it does not need source water.

3. NASA captures 1st direct image of exoplanet outside our solar system

For the first time, astronomers have used NASA's James Webb Space Telescope to take a direct image of a planet outside our solar system. The exoplanet called 'HIP 65426 b' is a gas giant, meaning it has no rocky surface and could not be habitable. The exoplanet is about 6 to 12 times the mass of Jupiter, and these observations could help narrow that down even further.

4. India's first-ever "Night Sky Sanctuary" to be set up in Ladakh

In a unique and first-of-its-kind initiative, the Department of Science & Technology (DST), Govt of India, has undertaken to set up India's first-ever "Night Sky Sanctuary" in Ladakh as a part of Changthang Wildlife Sanctuary. It will boost Astro tourism in India and will be one of the world's highest-located sites for optical, infra-red, and gamma-ray telescopes.

5. Kinetic to launch Luna in electric avatar, expands capacity with new plant

Luna, the country's first eponymous brand that gave wings to urban India in the 1970s, is making a comeback in an electric avatar. Luna joins the other popular two-wheeler brands of the licence era-the Chetak and the Lambretta -which are making a return in the modern electric version, even as they retain part of their retro design.

6. Govt launches diabetes drug Sitagliptin, its combinations at Rs 60 per pack

The government launched diabetes drug Sitagliptin and its combinations at rates as low as Rs 60 per pack of ten, which will be sold at generic pharmacy stores, Janaushadhi Kendras. The Pharmaceuticals & Medical Devices Bureau of India (PMBI) has included new variants of Sitagliptin and its combination across its Jan Aushdhi Kendras PMBI Chief Executive Officer - Ravi Dadhich

1. Indian Navy to get a new ensign; 4th change since 1950

The Indian Navy will get a new ensign ' the flag that is hoisted atop all Naval warships, ground stations and naval air bases.

It would be unveiled by Prime Minister Narendra Modi on September 2 when the first indigenous aircraft carrier Vikrant is commissioned at the Cochin Shipyard Limited Kochi, Kerala.

The one adopted in 2014 is the current ensign of the Navy.

He was born in a family of weaker section of society in a riverine village Tujarpur in the Nagra block of Saran district in Bihar.


4. KN Singh, the Chief Justice of India with the shortest tenure, passes away

Maharaja Hari Singh JI was instrumental in accession of J&K with the republic of India on 26 October in 1947.



1. Tata Motors acquires full stake of the JV - Tata Marcopolo Motors

Tata Motors and Brazil's Marcopolo SA came together in 2006 to form a JV to manufacture low-floor airconditioned and non air-conditioned buses in India. This JV was well known as Tata Motors Marcopolo Ltd. (TMML), in which Tata Motors had a 51 percent holding of the company and Marcopolo SA had 49 percent holding in the JV.

From August 29th 2022 TMML has become a wholly-owned subsidiary of Tata Motors.

2. National Nutrition Week 2022: 1st to 7th September

Each year, India celebrates National Nutrition Week (NNW) from September 1 to September 7.

Since 1982, the Indian government has been conducting National Nutrition Week to educate citizens about nutrition and urge them to lead healthy and sustainable lifestyles.

The theme for this year is 'Celebrate a World of Flavors'. NNW first observed in March 1975 by the American Dietetic Association.

3. Cabinet approves signing an MoU between India & Govt of Nepal on biodiversity conservation The Union Cabinet has approved the proposal of the Environment, Forest, and Climate Change Ministry for signing an MoU with the Government of Nepal on biodiversity conservation.

It is aimed at strengthening and enhancing coordination and cooperation in the field of forests, wildlife, environment, biodiversity conservation, and climate change.

Airports Authority of India (AAI) will deploy 1,924 private security agency (PSA) security personnel across 60 airports in place of Central Industrial Security Force (CISF).

AAI also said it has appointed 581 security personnel from Directorate General Resettlement (DGR)sponsored security agencies for non-core posts at 45 airports. Shri Sanjeev Kumar, Chairman, Airports Authority of India (AAI).

198. Eliud Kipchoge breaks the world record at the 2022 Berlin marathon

Kenya's Eliud Kipchoge shattered his own world record on Sunday (25 September), with a time of 2:01:09 to win the Berlin marathon.

Kipchoge's previous best in an official 42.2km race was 2:01:39 set on the same course in 2018. Ethiopia's Tigist Assefa won the women's race in a course record of 2:15:37, the third fastest time in history.

AB-PMJAY completed four years of its implementation on Sept 23, 2022, and Ayushman Bharat Digital Mission on 27 Sept

Belgium-based Ageas Insurance International's stake in the life insurance company is now 74% from the earlier 49%.Federal Bank continues to hold the remaining 26% stake

202. Adani & family top IIFL Wealth Hurun India Rich List

Gautam Adani and family, with an estimated wealth of '10,94,400 crore, has topped the IIFL Wealth Hurun India Rich List 2022, which was released on Wednesday. With 116% growth as compared with the 2021 list, his daily wealth creation velocity is estimated at '1,612 crore.

Mukesh Ambani and family has been named as the second richest in India with wealth of '7,94,700 crore **203. India to get first car that can run on 100% ethanol and electric**

India will get its first flex-fuel vehicle, which can run on ethanol blended petrol and battery next month. The Flex Fuel Strong Hybrid Electric Vehicles (FFV-SHEV) imported from Brazil will be used as a pilot to assess its performance in terms of reduced carbon emissions.

The vehicle will be flagged off by Union road transport and highways minister Nitin Gadkari.

GM Magnus Carlsen (Norway) won the Julius Baer Generation Cup, needing just two games vs. GM Arjun Erigaisi (India)

Carlsen's performance makes him the first player to hit the historic 2900 Tour Rating mark and he has also reached \$180,000 in earnings on the Tour. Rameshbabu Praggnanandhaa stands second with \$106,500. **206. Bandaru Wilsonbabu appointed Indian Ambassador to Madagascar**

Bandaru Wilsonbabu, presently joint secretary in the ministry of external affairs, has been appointed as the next ambassador of India to the Republic of Madagascar.

An Integrated Cryogenic Engine Manufacturing Facility (ICMF) set up by Hindustan Aeronautics Limited that would cater to the entire rocket engine production under one roof for Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO) was inaugurated by President Droupadi Murmu.

On that occasion, the President also laid the foundation stone for the Zonal Institute of Virology (South Zone).

210. NASA's DART Mission Hits Asteroid in First-Ever Planetary Defense Test

NASA's Double Asteroid Redirection Test (DART)- the world's first planetary defense technology demonstration- successfully impacted its asteroid target, the agency's first attempt to move an asteroid in space.

DART targeted the asteroid moonlet Dimorphos, a small body just 530 feet (160 meters) in diameter. It orbits a larger, 2,560-foot (780-meter) asteroid called Didymos. NASA Administrator: Bill Nelson.

It has been updated to function as a health and wellness app. After being extensively used to facilitate COVID-19 immunisation, CoWIN will be utilised for India's universal immunisation programme. 216. Uco, Yes Bank tie up with Russian banks for payments

Uco Bank and Yes Bank have put in place arrangements with two Russian counterparts as India seeks to step up trade with the sanctioned nation.

While Uco Bank, which was the agency responsible for rupee trade with Iran, has tied up with Gazprom Bank, Yes Bank and Petersburg Social Commercial Bank (PSCB) also have an agreement in place.

217. World Bank and SIDBI to launch fund against loan default to lenders financing purchase of electric 2 & 3 Wheelers

The government, World Bank and Small Industries Development Bank of India (SIDBI) are set to launch a \$1 billion fund to provide guarantees against loan default to lenders financing the purchase of electric twoand three-wheelers.

The Niti Aayog is the facilitating agency for the project, aimed at facilitating faster and easier financing of electric vehicles.

218. Unilever CEO Alan Jope to retire at end of 2023 after GSK setback

Unilever Plc Chief Executive Officer Alan Jope plans to retire at the end of next year following a tumultuous period where the company botched a potential 50 billion (\$53 billion) deal and irked investors with lackluster growth.

Alan Jope has informed the Board of his intention to retire from the company at the end of 2023, after five years in the role. Unilever Chairman : Nils Andersen.

219. Government launches mobile app, 'Sign Learn' to make Indian Sign Language dictionary more accessible to masses

The government has launched a new mobile app called 'Sign Learn' with an aim to make the Indian Sign Language dictionary more accessible to the masses. The app, which is available for both Android and iPhone, was launched by Minister of State for Social Justice and Empowerment, Pratima Bhoumik.

220. Swedish Defence Maker Saab To Produce Carl-Gustaf M4 Rocket Launchers In India

Swedish defence company Saab has announced its decision to set up a production facility in India for its Carl-Gustaf M4 shoulder-fired weapon system. The M4 is one of the world's most popular pieces of military equipment utilised primarily by the Special Forces (SF).

Carl-Gustaf was first inducted into the Indian Army in 1976.

221. Government appoints Lt General Anil Chauhan (retired) as next Chief of Defence Staff

The Centre has decided to appoint Lt General Anil Chauhan (retd) as the next Chief of Defence Staff (CDS). He is only the second person to hold the post after General Bipin Rawat.

Lt General Anil Chauhan (retd) shall also function as the Secretary to the Government of India, Department of Military Affairs.

He was commissioned into the 11 Gorkha Rifles of the Indian Army in 1981.

222. Centre Appoints Senior Advocate R Venkataramani As Next Attorney General For India

Senior advocate R Venkataramani has been appointed as the new Attorney General of India for a period of three years, by Honarable President of India. He will succeed KK Venugopal after the latter's term ends on September 30.

The Attorney General is the Government of India's first law officer, and has the right of audience in all courts of the country.

R Venkataramani is the 16th Attorney General of India (AG).

223. Cabinet approves India-Bangladesh MoU to withdraw water from Kushiyara river

The Union Cabinet chaired by Prime Minister Narendra Modi, gave its ex-post facto approval for a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) between India and Bangladesh for withdrawal of up to 153 cusecs of water each by both the counties from the river Kushiyara which lies along the border during the dry season.

224. West Zone wins Duleep Trophy 2022, beats South Zone by 294 runs

West Zone thrashed South Zone by 294 runs to win the 2022 Duleep Trophy here, completing the formalities before lunch on the fifth and last day's play.

The six-member Monetary Policy Committee (MPC) voted 5-1 to up the policy repo rate by 50 basis points (bps) to rein in the above target inflation and address concerns around weakening of the

currency.Following the 50 bps hike, the repo rate (the interest rate at which banks borrow funds from RBI to overcome short-term liquidity mismatches) is at 5.90 per cent against 5.40

243. Adani Ports secures '25,000 cr Tajpur port project in West Bengal

The Adani Group will develop a port in India's West Bengal state at a planned investment of more than \$3 billion, as the port-to-power conglomerate continues to bolster its grip over the local infrastructure and logistics sectors. The greenfield project will entail a total investment of '25,000 crore (\$3.1 billion), of which '15,000 crore will go toward port development.
