

UPSC CSE Dogri Paper Syllabus 2024

The UPSC Dogri syllabus for 2024 will evaluate candidates on reading comprehension, précis writing, translation skills, and knowledge of Dogri grammar and literary concepts. Key focus areas will include grasping main ideas, summarizing texts concisely, translating accurately between Dogri and English, properly applying grammar rules, and demonstrating understanding of Dogri literary devices, themes, and genres. Regular reading of Dogri newspapers, books, and magazines will build strong comprehension and vocabulary.

Dogri is an official Indian language with a rich literary tradition including original works and translations. The UPSC Dogri literature syllabus evaluates comprehension, written expression, translation abilities, grammar knowledge, and understanding of Dogri poetry, drama, and other genres. Strong proficiency in literary Dogri is vital to succeed in this UPSC optional exam.

The UPSC Dogri literature optional comprises two Devanagari script papers assessing proficiency in the language and literary knowledge. Candidates fluent in speaking, reading, and writing Dogri, either natively or through study, are suited for this 500 marks exam. Thorough preparation of the literature, poetry, drama, and grammar covered is key to succeed.
