

## IBPS RRB GBO Syllabus

The IBPS RRB GBO examination is for working professionals who want to advance their careers as General Banking Officers (GBO) in Regional Rural Banks. Aspirants must have at least 2 years of work experience in a bank or financial institution to be eligible for this exam.

Candidates applying for the RRB GBO posts will have to clear a single online examination to move on to the interview round. Those selected in the interview will join the respective RRB as GBOs.

To succeed in the exam, aspirants should have a strong understanding of the following subjects Reasoning, Computer Knowledge, Financial Awareness, English Language, Hindi Language, Quantitative Aptitude, and Data Interpretation.
