The IBPS RRB Officer Syllabus 2025 is divided into two stages: Preliminary Exam and Mains Exam, followed by an Interview round. The syllabus includes topics from Reasoning Ability, Quantitative Aptitude, General Awareness, English Language, Hindi Language, and Computer Knowledge. A thorough understanding of the syllabus is essential for effective preparation.

Reasoning Ability	Puzzles (Seating Arrangement: Circular, Direction-based, Miscellaneous), Number Series, Odd Man Out, Coding-Decoding, Blood Relations, Analogy, Syllogism, Alphabet Test, Ranking & Time, Causes & Effects, Direction Sense, Figure Series, Word Formation, Statement & Assumption, Assertion & Reasoning, Statement & Conclusion, Statement & Arguments, Statements & Action Courses.
