They are saying that the platforms' inaction regarding strong age verification, content blocking, and responsible limits on usage amounts to a dereliction of responsibility, much like other industries are responsible for the effects of their products. On the other hand, platforms and their allies tend to cite the importance of parental control and personal agency, claiming that it is hard to create a direct causal relationship between platform usage and particular mental health effects. Yet, the scale of the problem and the powerful anecdotal and nascent empirical evidence encourage an appraisal of the issue at a more systematic level. In the end, it's not a matter of blaming one thing, but rather finding a collective paradigm of responsibility involving increased government oversight, an inherent change in corporate values towards users' welfare, and enhanced digital literacy and critical thinking education among young people themselves.
